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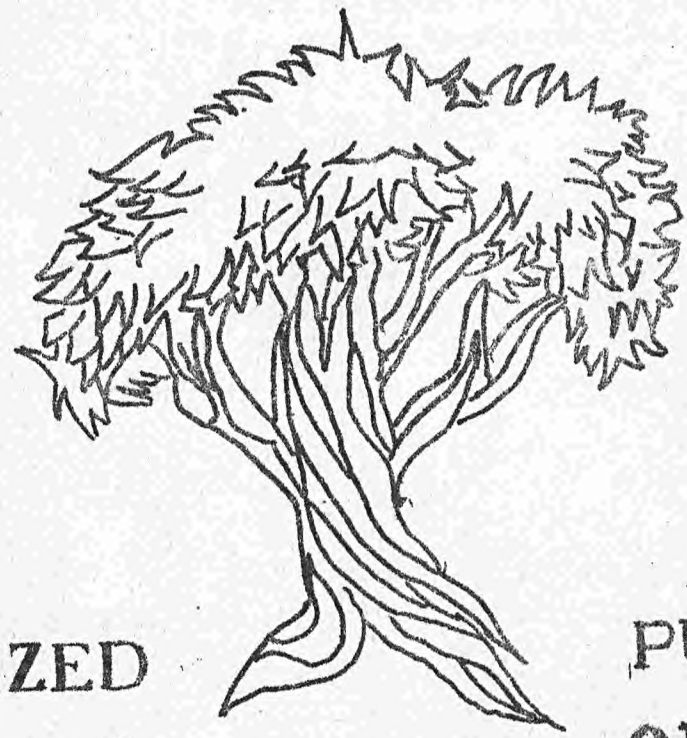

PRESIDENT' MESSAGE:

The Bicentennial year of 1976 has brought about miraculous strides in the field of Genealogy. We are now involved in the "Number one Hobby" of the nation, and research is going on in every corner. Unbelievable sources are showing up, with help and excitement for practically everyone.

The growth of our Society at this time lists 45 members (1976 membership list), with about twelve additional active members who have just not forwarded their dues. On March 22nd, our Lecturer, Mr. Garlan Asbell, from Gencor, Inc. of Salt Lake City, brought out several more persons who mentioned their interest in our organization. Mr. Asbell was originally scheduled to speak on Friday, March 19th, and to our advantage - the Donner Summit hiway from Reno, kept him on the wrong side. We missed his presence at our meeting, but it gave us a real opportunity from the Sutter County Librarian. (She took part of our group on a tour, and showed the material available in the California Room), and the remainder of us spent some time getting acquainted and discussing our organization with new genealogists.

The past year, our Editor, Morrie Shepherd, has enlarged the contents of the "Digger's Digest" considerably. Being retired, and an active "Rockhound", not very interested in genealogy - Morrie accepted the position when it became impossible for 'Teacher-plus' "Buzz Harrison" to continue with the time necessary for a good publication. Morrie has done the majority of the work completely alone - except for the Query Section being handled by Fran Shepherd. At this time, Morrie has already typed up enough stencils for an entire year's "Digest" - and probably more than that. The cost of paper and stencils are controlling our enlarging the "Digest" further. However, decisions may be made to combine some of this material into books, instead of breaking it up in quarterly issues. How does this appeal to you? We would appreciate your thoughts on the matter.

As a money making project, it was decided that we should collect all the Betty Crocker Coupons we can, to turn into cash, for additions to our Library. Your president has contacted a great many people outside our group to help us out, and we hope each of you will concentrate on asking your neighbors and friends - (or relations?) - if they have any unused coupons. The idea was not ours, originally. We noticed in a recent quarterly from Indiana. With 18,000 coupons, they received \$90 in cash. If each member aims for about 1,000 to 1,500 coupons, we should be able to collect about three times the amount of the Indiana Society. (Thanks to you, Indiana, for your idea.) Our supply of books can certainly stand this kind of a boost.

Vice-President Gene Mattocks has taken the responsibility of Program Chairman, with the intention of assigning different members to be in charge of the individual meetings. Arranging the program for a meeting, whether it be with a speaker, or a workshop project, is good experience for many of us and promotes our feeling of working together. Everything looks as though our organization is steadily growing and improving.

I just had a "hot message" from our assistant editor, Buzz Harrison. Although we have seen little of him in the past few months, he wanted us all to know he is very much alive and sailing along, with a promise to get back to see us soon. As an ex-teacher, take my advice -- don't hold your breath.
