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SUTRO LIBRARY TRIP

Everyone was in a cheerful mood at 7 o'clock Friday morning, July 27th at Sears parking lot when 32 members of the Sutter-Yuba Genealogical Society set out for San Francisco. We were on our way to Sutro Library and after a very pleasant trip, with intermittent coffee and doughnut holes, we arrived at our destination. Having left the valley heat behind, it was a treat to breath in the cool damp fog of San Francisco.

At 10:00 A M the doors were opened and the group was given necessary instructions and directed to the different sources of information in which we may have a particular interest. This proved beneficial to me as it was in a small metal file cabinet partially hidden around some Library furniture that I found my most valuable material. This was in the form of four 4x6 inch cards and I asked the Librarian if I could photocopy them. She told me the copy machine was broken but she would be glad to copy the material and send it to me. On August 3th I received the material I had almost given up on. This proved invaluable to me in completing information I didn't have. For example: I found the birth and death dates of Isaac Buswell Sr., the first of that name in America in 1640. I have searched for ten years and didn't have this important information for my lineage records.

Everyone was busy searching and writing the time went by so fast I think we were surprised and a little disappointed when 3o'clock came and we had to leave our treasures and get back to the bus. After a beautiful ride across the Bridge, this time in the sunshine, we arrived in Berkeley and Spangler's Fish Grotto for dinner. We were seated together in the banquet room but we were allowed to pay in groups of six which pleased our President Jean Waller, as the checks wouldn't then have to be figured in toto. After a delightful dinner we returned to our bus for the return trip home.

A cheerful atmosphere prevailed as we journeyed toward what was to be the bus driver's lament and a unscheduled terminus into a wheat field.. All this as a result of the driver's misjudgment of a detour sign which landed us in a ditch from which he was unable to get out without the help of a friendly farmer and his Cat. After an hour and a half, men running back and forth; digging out buried tires; replacing broken chains; with expert maneuvering of both vehicles (with helpful comments from the ladies) the bus was finally ready to reload.

After the heat of the day had mellowed in the long summer twilight and the silence was shattered by the hilarity of the displaced passengers responding to Jean Waller's rare humor, we returned to the bus and were on our way to Home Sweet Home.
