Last Will & Testament of Michael Traxler dec'd.  
(Born 1750, died in 1818)

In the name of God Amen. I Michael Traxler of Dublin Township in Huntingdon County and State of Pennsylvania being weak in Body but of sound mind memory and Judgement blessed the god for the same, but considering the uncertainty of this transitory life do make and Publish this my Last will and Testament in manner and form following to wit, Principally and first of all I commend my Soul into the hands of the god who gave it and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent and Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named, and as to such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life - I give and dispose of the same in the following manner to wit- First it is my will and I do order that my just debts and funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently can be done after my death - Item I give and bequeath to my dear wife Nelly Traxler the house we now live in, ten bushels of wheat, five bushels buckwheat, five bushels Indian corn to be milled for her - one cow and ruff foder for the same, Firewood to be cut and laid at the door, To have one half bushel of Flaxseed sowed and one bushel of potatoes planted yearly if required, and one hundred weight of baken also yearly as long as she remains my widow - And I do give and bequeath to my wife her choice of two of my sheep, bed and bedding, Reel, whell, one walnut chist one puter dish and three puter plates during her natural life and at her death at her disposal - Item, I give and bequeath and do allow my real Estate at the expiration of William McLain lease to be sold at the discretion of my Executors and the proceeds equally divided among my children - and also my Bound child Mary McCartnay unto my son Daniel Traxler to serve him under the same as her indenture will show - and lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint my two sons Peter and Conrad Traxler and John Blair to be executors of this my will hereby revoking all other wills legacies and bequests by me heretofore made and declaring this and no other to be my Last Will and Testament - In Witness whereof I have set my hands and seals this twenty fourth day of April in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and twelve.

OBITUARY IN WOODLAND DEMOCRAT

December 21, 1903

Mrs. Louise C. Goodin, better known as "Grandma" Goodin, died at the residence of her son, S. H. Goodin on Fourth St., at 9:30 o'clock Sunday evening, December 20th. She was confined to her bed about a week. Up to Tuesday, December 15th, she enjoyed fairly good health for one of her advanced age. Pneumonia was the primary cause of her death, but it was complicated with heart trouble before the end came.

The funeral will be held on Tuesday, December 22nd and services will be held in the Christian church at 1 p.m.

The maiden name of the deceased was Louise C. Grant. She was a native of Illinois, where she was born on the 12th of May, 1824. She had therefore attained the ripe old age of 79 years, 7 months, 8 days.

William M. Goodin and Miss Louise C. Grant were married in Pike county, Illinois on the 20th of October, 1847. They came to California in 1864, first locating near Folsom, where they remained two years. They then moved to Yolo county, locating near Cacheville, in 1893 they moved to Woodland where the husband died about 5 years ago.

The deceased came of a distinguished family. Her father, Judge Grant, was a learned lawyer and was elected circuit judge in Missouri for a number of terms without opposition. A brother of the deceased was also elected to a judgeship in Texas and died at Lamar.

Mrs. Goodin leaves 2 children. Mrs. Gordon resides in Sacramento and S. H. Goodin lives in Woodland. One daughter, Mrs. Lizzie McMillan died in Woodland about 11 years ago, and a son, R. F. Goodin died here in 1883. R. M. Grant and a sister, Mrs. Casandra Carrington, resides in Illinois. Two sisters, Mrs. Greer and Mrs. Goodin, died in Illinois.

"Grandma" Goodin was a woman of kindly, genial manner. Her personality was agreeable, her relations with her relatives and friends cordial and her love for her family strong and sincere.

## TIPS FOR FILLING OUR PEDIGREE & FAMILY GROUP SHEETS

1. Always capitalize the Surname and put it last.
2. Use the maiden name of married women.
3. If a name is only an initial, use it and underline it.
4. Write out the word county only if no city is listed, otherwise list city, county, then the state. Example: Marysville, Yuba, CA.
5. Do not abbreviate the name of the city or county. States and countries may be abbreviated.
6. When recording dates, put the date first, then the month, then the year. Spell the name of the month or abbreviate it. Months can be abbreviated but no period is necessary.
7. On the pedigree charts, the even numbers are for males and the odd numbers are for females.
8. When recording children's names on the Family Group sheet, record the last name of the first child, other children's last names can be dittoed.
9. When a divorce occurs, write (div) after the marriage date.
10. If there are too many children for one sheet, list the rest on a second sheet.
11. The pedigree sheet number can be put on the family group sheet.
12. Record the name exactly as you find it on any legal document. Record any known differences in the explanation section.
