She told me that her daughters had watched the Miss Teen America Pageant a couple of years ago and Miss Pennsylvania's name was Harriger, the same as their name! Our Harrigers came from Pennsylvania in the 1850's.

Mrs. Harriger called the pageant headquarters in Texas and they gave her the girl's parents' address in Pennsylvania. Having put off writing, she called the Pennsylvania Harrigers. Two Sisters-in law back there have apparently done a lot of research. They have checked records and hold a yearly family reunion at Harriger Hollow, PA. Family has lived on the "Home Place" for generations.

I am now waiting for the "local" Mrs. Harriger to gather her information and call me back so we can get together.

I was thrilled to find someone with so much information and a "Back Home" contact. I am also pleased that I have some information, photographs, and clippings that the others do not have so I have something to offer them.

I have made several "family-stranger" phone calls. Even those who were not interested in my project were polite and willing to talk to me. So....take a deep breath, gather your courage and dial that phone! It may open some very interesting doors for you.
