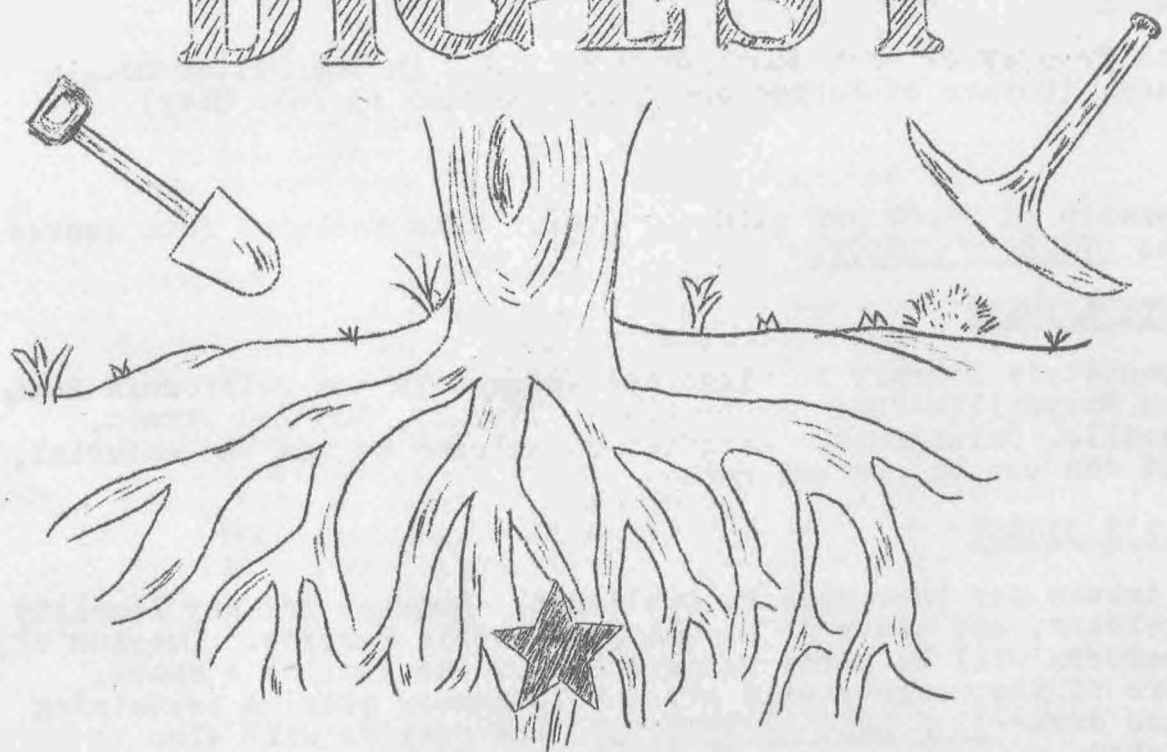

Editor's Notes

I find land records to be a very useful tool for genealogical research. I sometimes find words whose meaning is not too clear to me. The following is a list of words from early land records.

Acquit - pay off, discharge obligation completely
alien - to make over (as property)

appurtenances - an incidental right (as--a right-of-way)

deed poll - a deed made and executed by only one person
depose - to testify to, affirm, assert
device - give or dispose of real estate by will

emoluments - the returns or advantages arising from use
ensuing - take place afterward as a result of some action
extant - currently existing
freeholder - usually an English class distinction, below the
gentry, also one who cultivates his own lands
grantee - one receiving the land
grantor - one passing property on to another
hereditament - heritable (inheritable) property
in lieu - instead
instrument - formal legal document
indenture - document stating terms under which a security is
issued
intersessions - petition or entreaty in favor of another
incumbrance - a claim or mortgage against property
lawfully seized - lawfully in possession or lawfully owned
link - a unit of measurement equal to 7.92 inches
moveable estate - property that can be moved or displaced
(such as furniture, farm tools, etc.)
perches - unit of measure equal to 16.5 feet (also 1 rod)
possessory - of, arising from, or having the nature of possession
quit claim - to release or relinquish a legal claim to
remainder - an interest in property that follows and is dependent
upon the termination of a prior intervening possessory estate
created at the same time by the same instrument
remise - to give, grant or release claim to

IMMIGRATION - FROM WHENCE THEY CAME

With the exception of Native Americans, ours is a country populated by immigrants. Therefore, the most difficult problem faced by many of us doing family research, is locating our ancestor's birthplace. Many of us know the country, and some know the province, but finding the town is important before we can start researching abroad.

There are very few government records where it was necessary to give the birthplace, but you may find this information in the Naturalization Record. Citizenship papers are one of the most difficult records to obtain because they are not stored in one place. Also most people are not familiar with the format and type of information contained in these files.

Most naturalization records date from about 1830, but there are a few earlier ones, even from Colonial times, concerning foreigners who wished to become British subjects. It must also be remembered that not everyone wanted to become a citizen. During the 19th and 20th centuries, only the men usually went through the process. The wives and minor children automatically became citizens when the husband/father did.

Until the early 20th century the privilege of citizenship was not extended to all ethnic groups. A federal law in 1882 prohibited Chinese from becoming citizens. Some Americans were afraid of a massive influx of Orientals. Also, until 1924, American Indians were not considered citizens, but were Wards of the government.

On the other hand, large numbers of foreign nationals automatically became citizens without legal proceedings. This occurred when Hawaii and Puerto Rico were annexed to the United States.

Prior to September 27, 1906, it was possible for a person to be Naturalized by any Federal, State, or local court, in this country. This is why these records may be in any of these court records. On that date in 1906, the Bureau of Immigration and Naturalization was established as part of the Department of Commerce. From then on, all U.S. Courts had to follow certain guidelines regarding Naturalizations. A complete copy of each new file had to be forwarded to the Bureau in Washington, D.C., where a Master File was established. This file is arranged alphabetically by surname and covers the entire country. If you think your ancestor was naturalized after this date, write to the Immigration and Naturalization Department, 425 I. Street NW, Washington D.C. 20536, using the form G-641. These forms are available from any Immigration Office. One in our area is the Immigration and Naturalization Office, 630 Sansome Street, San Francisco. A fee of \$5.00, which is not refundable, must be sent with the form. After sending this form, you may receive the information you need, but, if not, you should get the date and place of naturalization. You may then contact the appropriate office for further details.

Basically there are two files for naturalization.

1. Declaration of Intention
2. Final papers which consists of a Petition, an Oath of Allegiance, and a Certificate of Naturalization.

Immigration --- continued

Check all the information on all documents. The information may differ. One may give the Country of birth, but the other may give the town. Information usually included is place of birth, date of birth, date and port of entry, name of ship, names and addresses of two witnesses and the length of time they have known the applicant, and, sometimes, the names and ages of wife and children. The data varies depending on the clerk who took down the information, and the customs of that particular court.

Forms are more standardized today, the legal process is still basically the same. In general, the Declaration of Intention and the Petition give the most information. The Declaration of Intention is the first paper filed, usually from three to five years before the filing of the Final Papers. In the Declaration of Intention, the applicant formally states his or her desire to become a Citizen of the United States. This document helps establish the length of residence in this country. Remember, the Declaration of Intention does not have to be filed in the same Court, or even the same state, as the Petition. Sometimes the Declaration of Intention was filed at the Port of Entry soon after they arrived. The Petition shows where the Declaration of Intention was recorded. After fulfilling a residency requirement of at least five years, but not necessarily five years after filing the Declaration, the applicant appears in court, accompanied by two witnesses. These two witnesses would verify the time the petitioner lived in the United States. The applicant would file a petition asking the Court to grant him/her citizenship. The Petitioner then takes an Oath of Allegiance, which is recorded as a separate document. The individual would then receive a final paper known as a Certificate of Naturalization as proof that Citizenship was awarded. A copy of the Certificate was placed in the Applicant's file. Normally the Original would be kept by the applicant. Sometimes copies are found in Court records dealing with such matters as property deeds.

If you do not know whether or not your ancestor was naturalized, there are several sources that may provide a clue. The 1820, 1830, 1870, and 1900 censuses have a column dealing with the citizenship status of a person. Some of the State Censuses may be available and show citizenship status. Local Tax Lists, Newspaper obituaries, deeds, and various other personal papers may also help.

If you are fortunate enough to have older relatives to interview, ask whether the ancestor belonged to a Political Party. Remember, the ancestor had to be a citizen to vote. Check with the Registrar of Voters where your ancestor lived.

A person may have filed a Declaration of Intention, and then not followed through on it, so it is still worth checking. The best place to start is the County Courthouse in the vicinity where the immigrant ancestor lived. The Naturalization records before 1906 are among the most poorly kept of Civil records. Papers may be found in a Police Court, Court of Common Pleas, etc. The documents may or may not be arranged in a separate file with an index-- sometimes there is no index at all. Sometimes the Naturalization papers are in Federal Courts. The ones in the Federal Courts have usually been turned over to the nearest Branch office of the

National Archives. Occasionally they are found in a State or Local Historical Library or Society..check the Courthouses and Archives first.

During the 1930's, there was a major effort to index these records as part of the WPA's Historical Record Survey. Most of Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, and Rhode Island had their naturalization records indexed at this time. They were placed in the National Archives in Washington, DC, where they may be searched. There is a plan to transfer these to the National Archives Center at Waltham, Mass. Since this index was made over 40 years ago, there are still other records showing up, so it can not be considered complete. But, it is certainly worth a try if your ancestor was in the States mentioned.

Before September 5, 1972, clerks were not allowed to photocopy the Naturalization records. They could only tell you what was in the record. This has changed, but all clerks are not yet aware that photocopying is allowed.

Naturalization Records often give you the vital link to the Homeland of your Immigrant Ancestor, and, unless they have been destroyed by some disaster, they exist somewhere. It is up to you to find them.

If possible, try to visit the Courthouses in person. You are more familiar with the various spellings of your surname and you possess the persistence to pursue other sources if the first source proves futile.

If you do write, ask for both the Declaration of Intention and the Final Papers, citing them by name; otherwise, some of the documents could be overlooked.

A good reference book is "Locating your Immigrant Ancestry", by James C. Nealgess and Lila Lee Neagles. This book lists every county in the U.S. and their holdings before 1906. Remember these records may not be conclusive but serve as a guide. Questionnaires were sent to the various County Offices and the validity of the response depended on the Clerk contacted.

Val Greenwood's book, "Researcher's Guide to American Genealogy", has a chapter on finding the Home of Your Immigrant Ancestor. Many books are concerned with the Immigrant who came before 1800. Greenwood mentions land entrys as being a good source, especially Homestead entrys, these entrys include a copy of the Naturalization proceedings.

Passport applications also show the original date and port of entry. All passport applications filed with the U.S. State Department from 1791 to 1905 are in the National Archives. However, passports were not required except during the Civil War. A great many people secured them for protection if they wanted to visit their homeland to protect them from being drafted in Military Service in their homeland.

The applications from 1810 to 1905 are bound. There are various card and book indexes for those from 1834 to 1905.

If you have ancestors from England, Scotland, Wales, or Ireland, write for a copy of the News Buttetin, RL 75, published by the British Information Services, 845 Third Ave., New York, NY 10022. This includes the names and addresses of agencies in the United Kingdom which house genealogical material, plus articles about genealogical research in the United Kingdom.

IRISH ROOTS? AIRLINE OFFERS INFORMATION

(The following is extracted from a newspaper article given to me by a member of our society for publication)

Irish Americans with the name of O'Brien, MacCarthy, O'Kelly, Ryan, Burke, Murphy, Sullivan, Reilly, O'Connor, Kennedy, Walsh, or Daly, may receive an Irish Clan Information Pack describing their family's history, free of charge by contacting an office of Aer Lingus, the Airline of Ireland, or Shannon Castle Tours of New York.

This pack has been organized in conjunction with a new program called the Genealogical Travel Service, created by the Shannon Development of Ireland, in order to provide facilities for Americans of Irish extraction to trace the history of their families and to visit places and objects in Ireland associated with their family names.

Tom Haughey, planning and product development manager, believed most Irish Americans have an inherent desire to know more about their connections with Ireland, and many would visit Ireland if they are provided with a genuine lead to discovering their ancestry there. This Genealogical Travel Service has been created to fulfill this need.

A direct mailing program to more than a quarter million Irish-American households in 14 states has commenced. The mailing features a clan history, a guide to tracing American and Irish roots, and a full-color brochure on "Irish Heritage Vacations," built around the "find your roots" theme.

Clan histories of the 12 Irish names listed above have been researched by Hugh W.L. Weir, teacher, author, and journalist. The Association of Irish Professional Genealogists has also been enlisted to carry out research on family histories for Irish Americans visiting Ireland.
