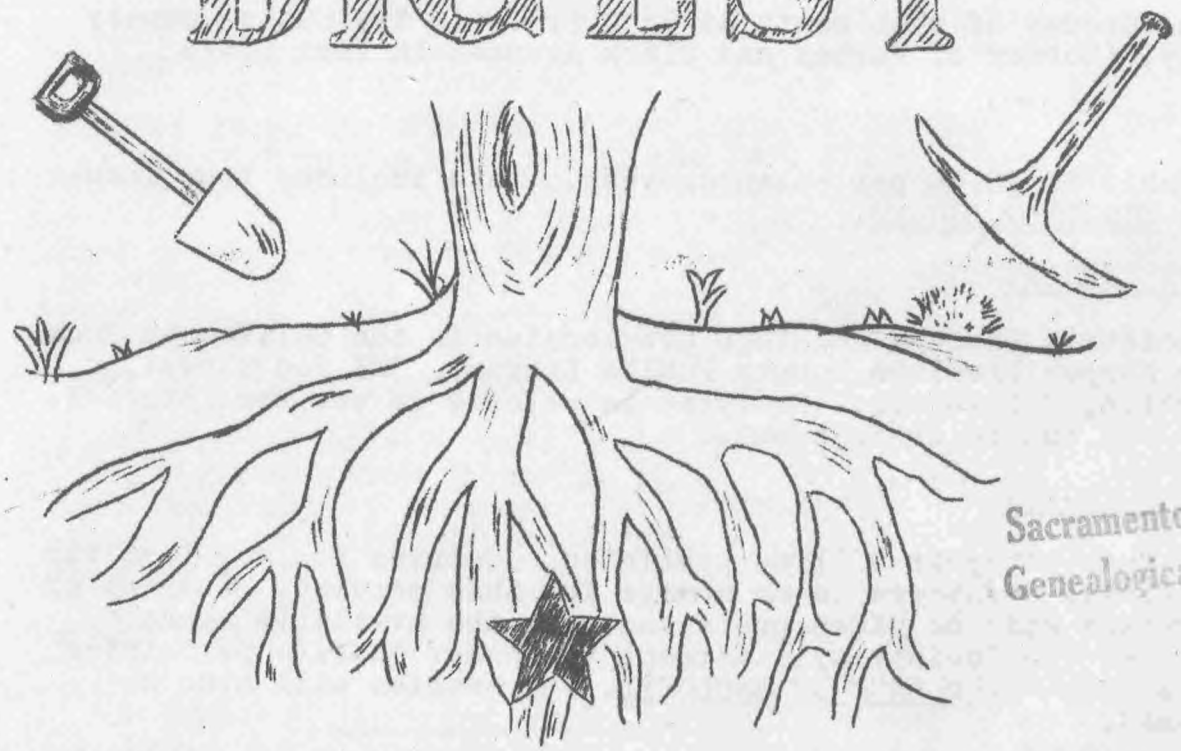

Editor's Notes..... "Military Records"

I wonder how many of us, in searching for a Military Record, be it the service, pension, or bounty land record, send a request for information to the Archives in Washington, D.C., and, if we receive a negative response, conclude that no record exists for our ancestor?

Keep in mind that the individual states probably have many, many, military records from the Colonial Times through part of this century, that the Federal Government has not obtained.

Only a small percentage of the soldiers served in the "Continental Line" during the Revolutionary War. Most served in the State Militias. They were "called up" when the need arose, and were disbanded when that particular emergency passed. This process was repeated over and over again. Many of those in the State Militia service did not live long enough to apply for the pension for Revolutionary service that was available to all who served, following passage of this Act in 1832. Thus, the only record of their service may have remained in the state where they served.

Service in state units was also the norm during the Civil War, especially for the Confederate soldiers. The Federal Government did obtain part of the Confederate records, especially if the soldier was captured and had to take an oath of Allegiance to the Union--but, many more records remained in the South. Check both the Federal Government and the State where the soldier served. It is also necessary, if your ancestor was a Confederate, to check the state where the veteran lived after the war. The Southern States did not pay a pension according to the state they served from; but they paid the pension from the state in which the veteran was living when he applied for the pension.

For example, if you had a Confederate soldier who served in and from Georgia during the Civil War, but afterwards moved to Texas, the pension record is in Texas.

Write to the State Archives for these records. If the Archive in your particular state does not have the record, you will be told the proper address for your request.

I have found pay vouchers for my ancestors Revolutionary War service in the North Carolina Archives and in the South Carolina Archive after receiving word from Washington that no record existed there for these men. I have also received Civil War pension records from Alabama and Texas for men who served in Georgia during the war.

Remember also---some men from the North fought for the Confederates during that war, and the opposite is also true; and, not all the men in the thirteen colonies fought against the British. If you can't locate your man in the Revolutionary War, search for the Loyalist Records for his area.

AFFIDAVIT

To accompany applications to purchase State Lands, as required by Act of Legislature, passed April 27th, 1863

"I do solemnly swear, That I will support, protect, and defend the Constitution and Government of the United States against all enemies, whether domestic or foreign, that I will bear true faith, allegiance, and loyalty, to the said Constitution and Government, any ordinance or law of any State, Convention, or Legislature, or any rule or obligation of any society or association, or any decree or order from any source whatsoever, to the contrary notwithstanding, and that I will support the Constitution of the State of California; and further, that I do this with a full determination, pledge, and purpose, without any mental reservation or evasion whatsoever, and that this oath is not taken for the purpose of acquiring title to, interest in, or possession of any land, in order that such title, interest, or possession, may be transferred to any person or persons to enable such person or persons to evade the provisions of any Law of the State of California, or any regulation of the General Land Office at Washington.
