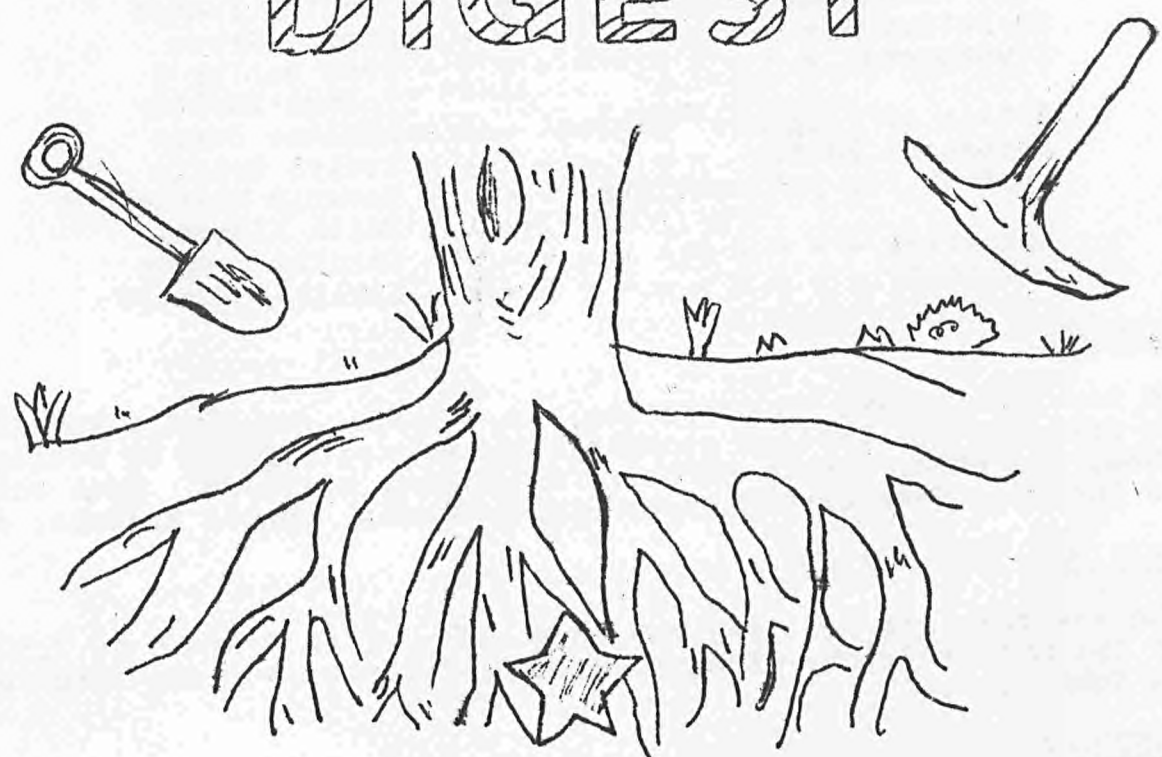

The 1910 Census of the United States may now be seen at the National Regional Archives at San Bruno, California. (1000 Commodore Drive, San Bruno, California 94066; Hours 8AM - 4:30 PM, Monday thru Friday, plus on Wednesdays, it remains open until 8:30 PM with Minimum Service Only)

The 1910 Census does not have a Soundex for all states as did the 1900 Census. There is a Soundex or Microcode (I could see very little difference in the two, they both code the same way) for 21 states.

If you would like to obtain one of the census catalogs, 1790-1880, 1900, or 1910, you may do so, free of charge, by requesting one from ---Publications Sales Brandh (NEPS); National Archives; Washington, D.C. 20408. With your own catalog, you could list ahead of time the censuses you wish to see and thus, save time at the archives. If you wish to purchase any of the rolls of census film, they are now \$17.00 each.

I was interested in Genealogical Research in Germany and recently wrote a letter to the German Consulate General in San Francisco. By return mail I received a xerox copy of a phamplet entitled "How to Find My German Ancestors & Relatives".

This phamplet has seventeen pages and includes; a brief history of Germany, the time period and manner in which various civil & church records have been kept, a map of "Deutschland vor 1918", a list of German Archives with their addresses, and a list of some of the genealogical periodicals and almanacs available.

Editor's Notes - Continued

If you have Presbyterian Ancestors, you may be interested in the letter I recently received from --The Presbyterian Historical Society, 425 Lombard Street, Philadelphia, PA 19147

"In reply to your request for genealogical information, please note the following.

A considerable wealth of materials relevant to family name studies may be found in the collections of the Presbyterian Historical Society. In its vaults the Society now has over 20,000 volumes of official manuscript records from American Presbyterian and Reformed local congregations and higher judicatories across the country. The Society's library contains over 130,000 published materials, many of which present materials of genealogical interest. Many collections of family papers are included in the archives.

Local church records are cataloged solely under local city name, followed by the proper name of the congregation. They are not arranged or cataloged by state or county, and published congregational lists issued by the various Presbyterian denominations are likewise not arranged by state or county, but by presbytery or synod. Therefore, it is not possible to find easily all the local church records held from a particular county or state.

The multitude of family names included in manuscript and published records held by the society are not indexed in any single source. Most local church records are not indexed by volume. In order to conduct a family name search it is essential to know the proper name of the specific congregation or other organization with which the individual was associated. Over the centuries congregations may change their names, locations and sometimes denominational affiliation. Considerable research may be required to trace their present status and the location of their records.

Materials held by the Society are not circulated. Students and scholars are welcome to visit the Society to use collections with few restrictions. The library is open Monday through Friday 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM, closed Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.

Unfortunately, the Society's staff and workload are such that the staff cannot do genealogical research. If it is not possible for you to come to Philadelphia, the following local genealogist, while not related to our staff, performs genealogical research for a fee. Should you wish to engage the services of this or of another researcher, please contact the individual directly. The society is not responsible for private research agreements.

name are listed in chronological order.

The surnames are usually the names used for this alphabetical listing; but, there are exceptions---Iceland, Norway, Wales, and Monmouthshire, England.

Because of the patronymic system, names from the Scandinavian countries appear in the index as follows:

1. Denmark, Sweden, Finland -- surname (Patronymic) first.
2. Iceland and Norway -- given name or Christian name first.

For Wales and Monmouthshire, England, there are two indexes/ One is a given name Index, which includes all entries. The other is a surname index. In this second index, records of births or christenings prior to 1813 are normally filed under the person's patrilineal surnames. (derived from their father's given names) Records from 1813 and later are filed in the surname index under the surnames of the parents. Thus the user has two sets of microfiche available for Wales and Monmouth.

While the names are listed in alphabetical order within the geographical area, the spelling used has often been standardized (using phonics) for filing. All spelling variations of a surname may be filed under the standard spelling assigned--so, look under all possible spelling variations or abbreviations for the name of interest to you. At the end of many fiche is a list of names that may help you locate yours if it is not where you expect to find it.

Included in the information at the top of each Microfiche card is the Geographical area, the date the fiche record was made, and the name of the first person on the card.

The fiche has ten columns on it.

1. The first column gives the name of the individual for which the event was recorded. This name is usually followed by one or more names of people who were also participants in the event. For instance--in a birth or christening record, the names of one or both parents may be given. In a marriage record, the name of the spouse is given.
2. The second column should include either-- M (male), F (female), H (husband), or W (wife), to indicate the sex of the primary person, or the relationship to others named.
3. The third column will contain a letter indicating the event for which the information is given, ie. A (adult christening), B (birth), C (christening), D (death or burial), M (marriage), W (will), N (census), S (Miscellaneous).
4. The fourth column is the date of the event, if known.
5. The fifth column is the place of event, if known.
6. The sixth column give the date of baptism into the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.
7. The seventh column gives the date of endowment and the abbreviation of the Temple where this Ordinance was received.
8. The eighth column is the sealing date and the abbreviation of the temple where it was performed.
9. The ninth column is the batch number.
10. The tenth column is the page or sheet number on the original submitters entry.

After you have located your names of interest and recorded all the information available from the microfiche, you may wish to examine the microfilm of the original source of this information. If this information was submitted by a patron, you

may, by obtaining a film of the input source, be able to contact someone researching your family, and thus combine your efforts with theirs.

An all-digit batch number (ninth column) with the third digit smaller than 4 refers to a name sent in by a member of the Church. This batch number can be traced through the use of the Batch Number Index, to a microfilmed copy of the submitters entry. (Be sure to copy down the page number in the 10th column)

You locate the batch number on the Index. These batch numbers are arranged numerically in columns, with the Patron or film number in the next column. This Patron/film number is the film you order. When this film arrives, you will find there are 99 pages for each Batch number, but if you have copied the number from the 10th column, you should quickly locate the page you need.

The controlled extraction batch numbers can be traced by using Parish and Vital Records Listings arranged by batch number or alphabetically by geographical location. (Found on microfiche at the Gridley Branch Library). This Parish and Vital Records Listings gives the areas, the vital statistics, and the time periods covered in the extraction program.

Batch numbers, other than those referred to as submitted by a member of the church may be recognized by the following:

- A----- These are sealings of couples with place of marriage included in the temple record. "A" batch numbers with sealing dates after 1942 can be traced through the Main Section of the Family Group Record Archives (in addition to Temple Records) Those "A" batch numbers having ordinances dates before 1942 can only be traced through the original temple records.
- M 17---, M 18--- Sealings of couples with date and place of sealings used as date and place of marriage even though the original marriage may have occurred at a different time and place. These can be traced only in original temple records in the Special Collections Room. Restricted to direct-line family members.
- M---- Controlled Extraction --(Marriages)
- P---- Controlled Extraction (Births & Christenings)
- C---- Controlled Extraction (Births and Christenings). The controlled extraction batch numbers can be traced by using the Parish and Vital Records Listings arranged by batch number or alphabetically by geographical location.
- H---- Presiding Bishopric's office membership records of deceased Church members (since 1941). Batch numbers below 2000 refer to the 1973 filming of these records. The Deceased Members File is available on film in the Genealogical Library at Salt Lake. Batch numbers over 2000 refer to the 1974-1975 filming. This last filming is not in the Genealogical Library, but is in the Church Historical Department Library.
- T9-- These are family group records which were taken directly to the Temple by a living person who also appeared on the sheet. Access is limited.

- T99--- Special Handling. This includes royalty and other records specially processed by the Genealogical Department. Most of these records are available in the Family Group Record Archives. Film number 1126128 covers royalty batches T99001 through T990075.
- T000001 - T000009 Manual 110 year file. This refers to names listed on Archive Records that could not be processed because there were no death dates and the persons were presumed living. Trace to TIB index card and Family Group Record.
- T000010 & ff Temple Records Index Bureau (TIB) Conversion. All TIB entries for Central America, Mexico, part of South America, and part of Italy that contained enough identification have been placed in the Computer. These batch numbers can be traced to the index cards in the TIB.
- 694-- Batch numbers with a 694 prefix usually trace to early Branch and Ward Membership Records of the LDS Church. The Batch Number Index may provide the film numbers to the branch or ward record. If the name is not found on the film number listed, check research paper Series F, No 5, pp. 22,23, for additional film numbers.
- 69407-- Early Ward and Branch Records from Scandinavia. Identify the branch and use regular LDS indexes to obtain the film number.
- 69409-- Entries for which the records of completed ordinances had not been returned from the temples although sent before 1969. There may be an Archive Record as parent or child.
- 725-- Batch numbers with this prefix were part of the Controlled Extraction Program taken from the Gibson Marriage Index (mainly Oxfordshire, England; a few from Buckinghamshire and Gloucester, England). Traced through the Batch Number Index or Parish and Vital Records Listings.
- 744-- Controlled Extraction Special Project-Norway. Consult the Batch Number Index for film numbers to original records.
- 745-- Controlled Extraction Project for Vermont and Connecticut (Vital records indexes). These can be traced to original records through the Batch Number Index.
- 754-- Controlled Extraction for New Hampshire (Vital records indexes). These can be traced to original records through the Batch Number Index.
- 766-- A special project of the Genealogical Department. There are only a few 766 numbers in the IGI. See a reference consultant in the Special Collections Room (in Salt Lake) for assistance.
