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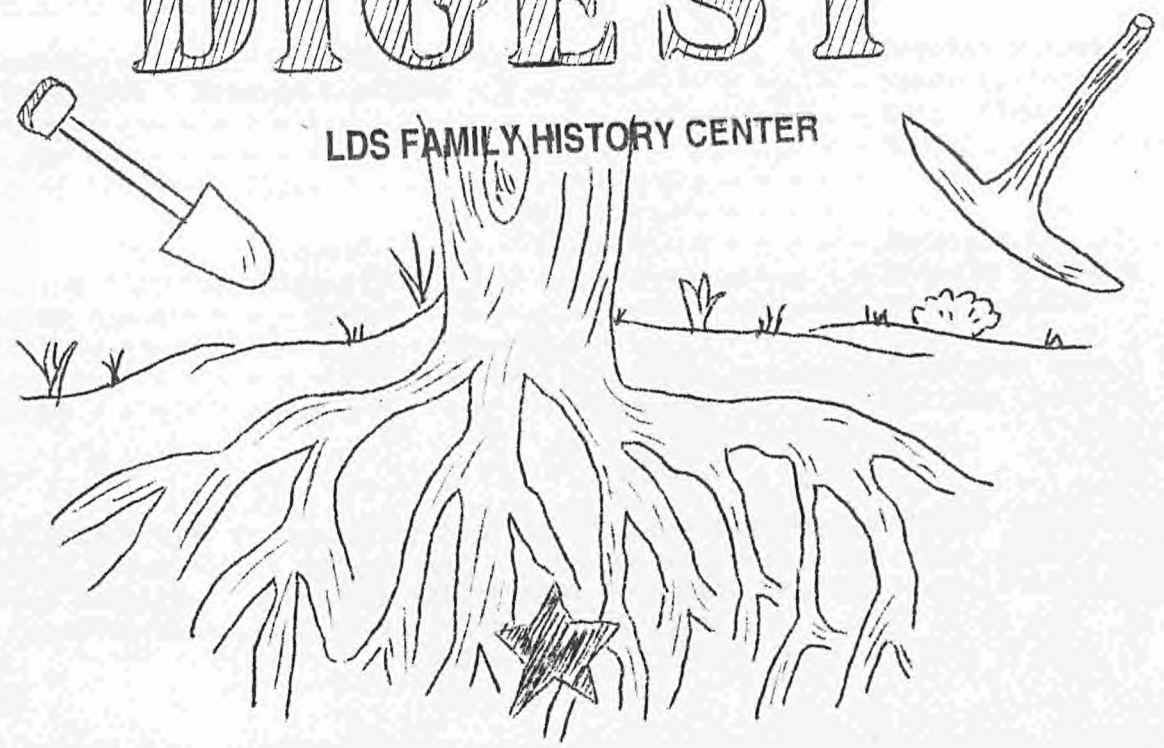

BOOK REVIEWS

A BEDWELL FAMILY

This book was donated by Mr. King to our Society, and we appreciate having it. It was reviewed by one of our members, Mrs. Edith Kimerer. This is a history of Robert Bedwell, Sr., and includes fourteen generations of his descendants from St Giles Parish, Cripplegate, London, England, in 1635, to all of the Fifty United States of America, and many foreign countries in 1982.

The Bedwell name is of English origin. The Bedwells recorded in this book have had family members in America over 320 years, and fourteen generations.

Each generation begins with a brief introduction, and then a personal history is given for each member of that generation. It is well indexed, with fifty pages of index.

Mr. King states that a primary purpose of this Bedwell Family History is to provide a record which will be of interest and value to present and coming generations of Bedwell descendants and others.

BEGINNING GENEALOGY

The most important people in the world are you and your family--both past and present. The more you learn about your family, the more you can understand and appreciate them, even those ancestors who may be the skeleton in your family closet.

When you make a genealogical record of today, realize that you are making records for the future. Others will assume that you have done all you can to be authentic. The burden of proof rests with the compiler. Be accurate!

Begin with yourself. Record your name on a pedigree chart as number one. Prove you were born--individual identification is the name of the game. Do you have a birth certificate. Add the name of your parents and grandparents with the information indicated on your pedigree chart. Can you prove this information. Relationships are established with each name you record and prove.

It is helpful if you learn the accepted method for filling out pedigree and family group sheets. Record the dates with the day first followed by the month and then the year. Capitalize all surnames. Record place names by putting the name of the town first, then the county, followed by the state. Use the sheet "Tips for filling out Pedigree and Family Group Sheets" as a guide.

Your genealogical research should begin with your family and home sources. You want to gather information that you have and that which will verify the information you need. Fill in your sheets with the information you have. Contact your relatives for any information they may have. See "Home Source" sheet for suggestions of items to look for. Find out if anyone else is doing research on your family. Check the Family Registry at a Branch Library of the Genealogical Library of Salt Lake. Check the FGI Files, also found at the Branch Library. Both Mormon and non-Mormons have names filed here. Librarians working in these Branch Libraries are trained to help you with your research. They can also explain how to search the records found in the TIB (Temple Index Bureau) and the Family Group Record Archive (FGRA). The FGRA contains about 7 million names submitted by people between 1942-1969.

Check printed family histories found in local and state libraries, filed in the Library of Congress, The Genealogical Library in Salt Lake City, Genealogical and Historical Society libraries. All these sources are the easiest and cheapest to research for information already compiled.

The most accurate information is usually from primary sources which is written at the time of the event or is first-hand information. These include vital records, church records, family bibles, personal journals, and personal knowledge--anything originating at the time of the event. Other sources must be used if no original can be found. Use every source possible to verify your information and record each source used. Prove your information

TIPS FOR FILLING OUT PEDIGREE & FAMILY GROUP SHEETS

Always capitalize the Surname and put it last.

Use the maiden name of married women.

If a name is only an initial, use it and underline it.

Write out the word "County" only if no city is listed, otherwise list city, county, and then the state. EX: Marysville, Yuba, CA or Yuba County, CA.

Do not abbreviate the name of the city or county. States or countries may be abbreviated.

When recording dates, put the day first, then the month, then the year. Spell or abbreviate the name of the month. EX: 9 Sept 1981

On the pedigree charts, the even numbers are for males and the odd numbers are for the females. The female is always one number higher than her husband. The father is double the number of his son or daughter.

If birth date is not known, use christening date. EX: Chr. 8 May 1831

If death date is not known, use the probate of will date. EX: Pro. 9 Oct 1879

When a divorce occurs, write (div) after the marriage date.

Make a Family Group sheet for every family on your pedigree chart.

The pedigree chart number can be put on the Family Group sheet.

Put the year of birth of the Husband in the right-hand corner of the Family Sheet.

Occupations, if known, can be put in parenthesis after the surname.

List children on the Family Group sheet in the order of birth, oldest first.

When recording children's names on the Family Group sheet, record the last name of the first child; other children's last name can be dittoed, if desired.

If there are too many children for one sheet, list the rest on a second sheet.

Record the name exactly as you find it on a legal document. Record any known differences in the "Explanations" section, or on back of sheet.

"Other marriages" section at the bottom of the family group sheet, refers to other marriages of the children. Use different family group sheet for each marriage of parents.

Put down your sources of information as completely and accurate as possible, so others may verify your information. Document all information possible.
