NORTH BUTTE LODGE #267, PENNINGTON, CALIFORNIA

The following history of this Lodge #267, Independent Order of the Odd Fellows, was given by Glenn D. Kimerer, Noble Grand, on May 6, 1956, at a dedication of a plaque and monument to the memories of the pioneers of this lodge, and of a school building used for the education of the North Butte Children.

On December 1, 1877, a group of men met for the purpose of taking the proper steps toward organizing an Independent Order of Odd Fellows Lodge.

Institution of North Butte Lodge #267, IOOF, Pennington, California, was held at the North Butte Association Hall on December 12, 1877, with the following charter members: W.T. Spilman; W.B. Spilman; Otis Clark: J.D. Spilman; G.W. Fairlee; W.T. Lam; J.F. Gilpatrick; Riley Singletary: and Joe Hardy.

The Institution ceremony was conducted by Brother, F.P. Dam, MWG. He appointed the following Brothers to assist him: J.F. Flaterman, M.C. Clark, and John Sohue. Initiatory degree was given to Charles Hoag, Thomas A. McFarland, and F.F. Clyma.

Officers installed at this time were: W.T. Spilman, Noble Grand; W.A. Wemple, Vice Grand; Otis Clark, Recording Secretary, and W.T. Lam, Treasurer. Appointive Officers were: J.F. Gilpatrick, Right Supporter to Noble Grand; J.D. Spilman, Right Supporter to Vice-Grand; W.B. Spilman, Warder; G.W. Fairlee, Outside Guardian; Thomas A. McFarland, Right Scene Supporter; F.F. Clyma, Left Scene Supporter. Trustees were W.T. Lam, H.B. Spilman, and H.A. Wemple.

Regalia was donated by the Oriental Lodge #45 of Marysville. A set of ivory gavels was given by Sam Hoffman. First representative to the Grand Lodge was Brother, Joe Hardy.

Initiatory degrees were given in the next few months to: G.R. Brown, A.M. McGrew, W. Luther, and Frank Fredericks.

RESEARCH IN GOLD COUNTRY - NEVADA COUNTY. CALIFORNIA

Researchers, in their quest for information on their gold rush ancestor, locate this ancestor in the 1850 census of Yuba County and contact this society for information. If the area where they are located is now a part of Nevada County, the records should be sought in Nevada County, which was formed in 1851. Few records exist in Yuba County for 1849-1850, except for deeds and marriage records.

Nevada City has two very good libraries with information on the early history of Nevada County; the Truckee City Library also has information, plus, of course the Nevada County official records should be consulted. The librarian I contacted in Grass Valley said their information was very limited, in the Grass Valley City Library.

The County Clerk-Recorder of Nevada County has marriage and land records from 1856; some birth and death records from 1873; probate and civil court records from 1880. (This information on records from, "The Handy Book.." by Evertons.) Our society was recently contacted by an individual in this office of Nevada County seeking early records they might obtain for their office. Address: Court House Square, Nevada City, CA 95959.

The Nevada County Library, 211 North Pine Street, Nevada City, CA., 95959, has many books on the history of the area, and on the mining and early pioneers. There is a printed index to the 1880 "History of Nevada County, CA"; and a reproduction of the printed version of the "California Star", Vol. 1, 1847-1848, partially indexed. This "California Star" was an early San Francisco newspaper that published information on much of California.

MAIDEN NAME SEARCH

(In a previous issue of 'Diggers' Digest' a list of ways to find a Maiden name was printed. This list originated with a Mrs. Barbara Hill, and had been expanded in talks by Mrs. Jean Waller, a member of our society. The list printed here has been further expanded, and was contained in a talk presented to a Grass Valley Genealogical Study Group by our member, Mrs. Marguerite S. McCurry)

- 1. Birth Certificate -- Lists the mother's maiden name.
- 2. Your own name or the name of your spouse before marriage.
- 3. Christening Records Always lists one parent, and sometimes both parents with the mother's maiden name. It may give the grand-parents, and/or other relatives standing in at the ceremony. Any sponsor may be a family member.
- 4. Church Records Membership lists, baptismal records
- 5. Marriage Certificate Application may list other family members
- 6. Divorce Record
- 7. Death Certificate Should list both parents with the mother's maiden name. Be sure to check and double-check this record, as I find they are often in error in either the given name or surname of one or both of the parents. This is unintentional; however, people giving the information are often under stress, or just do not know the correct data.
- 8. Cemetery Records Cemetery lots may contain more than one surname among the persons buried there and this could lead to the discovery of the maiden name.
- 9. Mortuary They may have additional information concerning the family that neither the Death Certificate or Cemetery have made available.
- 10. Obituary Often lists the parents, or brothers, or sisters, or even perhaps uncles or aunts that have a different surname that could lead to the name you want.
- 11. News Items Family reunions, Weddings, Anniversaries, or Birth Announcements will often list both maternal and paternal grand-parents.
- 12. Wills Should list all the children and if married, will give the married name.

MAIDEN NAME SEARCH (continued)

- 13. Census Records Lists Head of Household and all others residing at the address, listed as to relationship to the head. (1850 and later) A married daughter, or a brother or sister, may be living with the family. Older people living with the family, or next door, may be the parents.
- 14. County Histories The prepared biographies often list the parents of both the person being written about and the spouse.
- 15. Pension Applications If the wife is listed, it may give her maiden name.
- 16. War Records Histories of wars often go into the back-grounds of some of the fighting men.
- 17. Prepared Genealogies It is wonderful if you can find one already prepared about your family. However, be sure to check that the data is correct.
- 18. Queries Other people are also searching for your people, and they may send a query to a publication and include the information you seek.
- 19. Mortality Schedules May provide a clue to your ancestor.
- 20. Naturalization/Citizenship Papers Lists full names of all persons making application which includes the maiden name of married females.
- 21. Lodge, Club, Organization Memberships Some of these require personal histories to gain entry.
- 22. School, or especially Alumni Associations Alumni lists give the name of the person as known when attending, then adds the married name.
- 23. Passports May give the maiden name as a middle name.
- 24. Social Security Number Application Lists both parents of the applicant, using the mother's maiden name.
- 25. Life Insurance Papers If located in family papers could be helpful.
- 26. Bible Records Should list the bride's maiden name, although they sometimes do not.

MAIDEN NAME SEARCH (continued)

- 27. Land Records They often contain quite a bit of family information, especially the early ones, listing children with spouses at times. If the wife received the land as a dowry, it may give information on both her parents.
- 28. Personal Interviews Interview family members as well as neighbors of the family, or old timers in the town if they are available.
- 29. Given Names Sometimes the middle name of a child is the mother's maiden name (or even a first name could be). Sometimes it is a family surname carried through several generations.
- 30. IGI Lists bride and groom, and when a child is listed, both parents are usually listed.
- 31. Family Registry Index LDS Church Available at LDS Libraries (as is the IGI file). Should list parents of person given.
- NOTE: Be sure to search all spellings of any surname! People did not spell as we do today, and the scribes would spell the way they heard it or thought it should be spelled -- or as a family in the area with a similar name spelled their name.

 Nick names were often picked up as the actual name and can be misleading. Initials or abbreviations can also cause confusion.
