

# USING LAND AND PROPERTY RECORDS FOR GENEALOGICAL RESEARCH IN THE UNITED STATES

Using land and property records in the United States genealogical research can help solve many, many, problems. These records should not be used as one's only source, but should be considered one of the most helpful and important sources.

The very earliest land records in an area, the ones issued by various government bodies or persons, can place an individual in a certain place at a certain time. This can be of great importance, especially if later records, kept locally, are destroyed in some manner These first ones, however, do not usually contain much genealogical information.

If you wish a copy of these earliest land records, and I do enjoy having them, I suggest you write to the State Library or State Archive in the state of interest and inquire as to how you may obtain a copy. In some states it is possible to obtain a copy by knowing the name of the individual obtaining the land; in other areas it is necessary to know the legal description of the land. This description will be given when the land is recorded in the county where it is located.

The land and property records of most value to the researcher of genealogy, are those created when land, or property, was transferred between individuals. These records are located in county offices (In the New England states, they may be in town record offices). They comprise the greatest body of material in the courthouses of this country for one subject.

Land has been of great importance in this country, and the availability of it accounts for much of the early immigration to this country, and the movement of the population within this country.

The existence and survival of the great mass of land and property records, often in time and place where few other records exist, is not due only to the great volume of land sales. Land records, of all county records, have been most zealously guarded and preserved.

If a record depository were destroyed, people did not always rush back to re-register their marriage, or replace other records, but they did want to safe guard their land ownership and their right to dispose of it as they wished. They could only assure this by legally establishing their right to it by making certain a record existed.

The records thus made are almost always well indexed and are available to the public. In most instances they are also available by

correspondence. (Remember the old genealogical adage, do not request too much at any one time by correspondence) Many county office workers do not have time to carry through on large, complex, requests.

When using land and property indexes, make notes of all persons of the surnames of interest to your research. Note all possible spellings. Check both the grantor and grantee index. Sometimes property will be listed in one, and not the other. We can all make mistakes or miss something, and indexers are no exception.

It will save time and effort if you prepare a form ahead of time with spaces for items you should note. A form to extract land information should include at least the following:

Date of the transaction, and date of the land registration
Names of all Buyers and Sellers
Names of the Witnesses
Description of the land as given, include all landmarks,
neighbors, sixe, previous history, etc.
Cost of the property (Compare to other property at the time)

Search the time period from the earliest possible date for your family, and until way after you know they left the area. Sometimes the next owner received a deed, but did not record it until they, in turn, sold the property. Land was sometimes passed down in the family without being recorded until it was sold outside the family. Cases have been found when over one hundred years passed without a record appearing.

If you know your people were in the area, it may even be necessary to check page by page, in they they were left out of the index. It may also be possible that the land was recorded in another county or state

Lines of official jurisdiction were not always clear, and land in one state may have been granted by another state. Some state and county lines were in dispute for years. It could also be that a person acquired title from another county or state because the cost was less, or the 'other' courthouse was easier to reach.

Even with these possibilities, land records are still one of the easiest and best of all genealogical records to obtain.

The first deed for an individual in an area may show the previous place of residence and indicate when they first arrived in an area. The last deed in an area for an individual may tell where their new residence is, or will be.

The first deed to a child may indicate the time of coming of age, or of marriage.

It is not rare to find that a person did not leave a will, or have a probate, but had disposed of all property -- land, animals, household goods, etc. -- by the use of a deed. This was also done at times when a person was moving on to a new area and could not transport their belongings with them.

The given name of a wife is often shown in land records when the land is sold, even if it is not on the record when land is purchased. Dower Rights of a wife, often a part of a deed, may indicate if the land was received by her as a heritage, and the death date of either the husband or wife may be in the record, or indicated.

Lan received for a small amount, in comparrison to the going price of land, or for 'love and affection' may also indicate family relationships.

Church membership may be determined by a deed. Is land given for a church or a cemetery?

Sometimes all the children are required to release land they received through inheritance, with, or without the existence of any other probate papers.

Girls are sometimes named in the will or probate without any indication of their husbands' names. If they are married before the property settlement is made, the husband is also required to sign, and the relationship is indicated. Names of the son's wife may also be found in this way.

This is especially important where there are families with the same surname in an area. If the families are related, and family names are used, it may be difficult to separate the families even if you locate marriage records. Deeds may be a great help in this problem.

The location of the land owned by families of similar surnames in an area may also help to differentiate between families, especially if the land passes down in the family.

By using maps and locating where your people lived, you may also locate the church or cemetery used by the family. People did not usually travel far to a cemetery, or to a church.

To use maps, it is necessary to know that there are two types of land measurement used in this country.

Following the independence of this country, some states retained wwnership of their land, while others gave the land not privately owned to the new country. The states keeping their land consisted of the thirtee original states and the states carved from the original thirteen, plus the now state of Hawaii. These states are known as the 'State Land

States' and are: Connecticut, Delaware, Georgia, Hawaii, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Vermont, and Virginia.

These State Land States use the land measurement usually referred to as 'Metes and Bounds System'. Metes refers to measurement, sometimes including directions, and Bounds refers to the description of the Boundary, and may use direction, rocks, water courses, trees, neighbors, etc. Since the trees, rocks, neighbors, and other described items may no longer be in place, this land may be quite difficult to accurately place today.

The names of the neighbors may be helpful. They were often friends or relatives who had traveled from the old area to the new with your family. (If you have not found where your family was located earlier, having more surnames to work with may help you locate your people in an earlier census or tax list)

Water courses may still have the same name and make it possible to find the general area. Histories of the area may also help.

The remainder of our states are 'Public Land States' and they use the measurement we know here in California. The country was divided using designated lines called 'meridians' and 'base lines'. Land described by this system is quite easily located.

Tax lists, like deeds, can do much more than merely help you place your people in a certain time and place. There may be clues to age, deaths, arrivals and departures from an area.

When does a name appear? Has a son just reached the taxable age, or married. If a person with your surname shows a decrease in his acreage while another adds the same, could it be the son has married and needs his own farm?

If a woman is listed, she is probably a widow, or at least without a husband. Land ownership in name, usually resided with the man even if the woman had inherited it.

Land and property records may be found in a variety of books, some of which I will list later; but, the largest bulk of land records are found in DEED books, and there are usually indexes to them under the headings of 'Grantor' or Direct Index' books, meaning sellers. The buyer's index are usually labeled 'Grantee' or 'Indirect Index'.

These indexes are usually by surname, but not always by strict alphabetical order. Sometimes all surnames beginning with a letter are grouped together in chronological order. Sometimes they are indexed by the first name of the individuals. This makes extracting information on one surname far more difficult.

When checking your surnames, you should know that if there are multiple grantors, or multiple grantees, all the names may not be listed in the index. Sometimes only the first name is listed, followed at times by notations meaning 'and others' or 'and wife'.

Make note of the witnesses to your deeds. It has been written that on an average, a couple usually bought land six times in their life time. On most deeds you will find the signatures of four witnesses. (Especial: in early times) Tradition says the signatures of the first two witnesse may be from the husband's side of the family, and the other two witnesse are from the wife's side.

This is not always the case, but it is a good tool and should be used as such, especially in the Colonial period. As I said before, people did not usually travel to new areas alone.

#### CENSUS AGE SEARCH

Written by Frederick G. Bohme, Chief, Census History Staff, DUSD Bureau of the Census, Washington, D.C. 20233

Each year, over 150,000 people ask the Census Bureau to search its old records from the decennial censuses of population and provide transcrip of the information about themselves or others. Most of these individua do not have birth certificates and want official documents that show their age, hence the term "age search" that is generally applied to this service. Other people need evidence of citizenship or relationship to someone else, or want the transcripts to help them qualify for old-age assistance or disability pensions, get jobs, obtain naturalization papers or passports, establish a claim to an inheritance, or trace ancestry. Following the confidentiality provisions of title 13, U.S. Code, under which the censuses are taken, the Bureau releases information only to the named person, his or her heirs on proof of death, or an authorized representative. No information about other household members is furnished without their express permission.

The Bureau maintains files of individual census records from 1900 through 1970 for transcription purposes, and arrangements are being made for the 1980 records as well. These files are administered by the Personal Census Service Branch, Pittsburg, Kansas 66762, (telephone 316-231-7100), where applications and fees must be sent.

The necessary forms and assistance in completing them are available there, at Department of Commerce district offices, Census Bureau headquarters in Suitland, Maryland, or by calling the Census History Staff at 301/899-7625, or at any of the Bureau's regional and satellite offices in major cities.

A regular transcript now costs \$12.00, takes about six weeks, and includes the search of any two census years. It shows the person's name, age at the time of the census, and relationship to the named head of the household or other reference person, plus (if desired) race, occupation, or state/country of birth. For \$4. more, the applicant may order a "full schedule", in which case the Bureau will transcribe onto a facsimile of the original all of the information shown for the named person, including such items as marital status, mother tongue, year of immigration, and whether naturalized (for the foreign born), education, and parents' birthplaces.

The number of items available varies from census to census. The record will not show parents' names unless they were present in the household, the city where a person was born, or dates of birth, marriage, or death. Additional copies of regular transcripts are #2.00 a piece, and "full schedules," are \$4.00 each.

#### Census Search -- Continued

Persons interested in Population census records from 1790 through 1880, and for 1900 and 1910 (Virtually all the 1890 records were destroyed in a fire in 1921) should first consult their local libraries and genealogical societies for holdings, usually on microfilm.

Institutions that do not have the needed reels may borrow them from other holders or the National Archives and Records Service's regional center in Fort Worth, TX The Archives or its catalogs should be consulted for details.

Washington and Fort Worth, plus the other Archives regional centers, have all the existing 1790 - 1910 schedules on microfilm for public use, and others are available after the 72 year confidentiality rule governing the holdings of census records.

The Bureau publishes two useful books: "Age Search Information" not only explains the age search service in detail, but also tells how and where to find records of adoption, birth, death, marriage, divorce, employment, naturalization, Indian ancestry, military service, etc., and related information from a variety of other sources outside the census, including ways to reach missing persons.

"Twenty Censuses" present the population and housing questions asked in the decennial censuses from 1790 through 1980, most shown as they appeared on the original schedules or questionaires. The enumerators' instructions are reproduced for many of the censuses as well, so that users of the materials may understand exactly what was asked and the circumstances under which certain entries were made. "Age Search Information" and "Twenty Censuses" can be purchased from the Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402, or GPO bookstores in other parts of the country.

The 1890 census includes a special listing of Union Army veterans of the Civil War. It also lists the widows of veterans. These are anly available for states Kentucky through Wyoming, and give the following: name, rank, unit of service, enlistment and discharge dates, nature of any disability.

#### SPECIAL CENSUS SCHEDULES AND ALTERNATIVE RECORDS

The United States Decennial Censuses taken by the Federal Government since 1790, and listed on the two previous pages, are the most used source of information for Genealogical Researchers.

Two of the U.S. Census schedules, in addition to the usual information, contain information on Military Veterans.

The 1840 census lists most of the Revolutionary War Pensioners. This list has been published and indexed. To eliminate possible errors, check this census, do not rely only on the printed version. The printed list I saw had my 3rd great grandfather in the wrong household.

The 1890 census includes an enumeration of the Union Army Veterans of the Civil War. It also lists the widows of deceased Veterans. Regretably, this is available only for the states of Kentucky through Wyoming, as the rest were destroyed. These schedules give the following information: Name, Unit of Service, Rank, Enlistment and discharge dates, and the nature of any disability.

\*\* The 1840 and 1890 military census returns are available from S.L. on microfilm.

Many of the Confederate States also took a special census of the Confederate Veterans in 1907 and later. I do not have a complete list of those states.

The Federal Government compiled Mortality schedules for the census years of 1850, 1860, 1870, 1880, 1890, and 1900. The schedules for this in 1890 and 1900 were destroyed. The Mortality schedules list the persons in each household who have died in the year prior to each census year -- which begins on June 1st. The information includes the name of the deceased, age at death, sex, color, marital status, state of birth, occupation, and the month and year of death.

These are not widely used, but remember, 10% of the people dying between June 1st, 1849 and June 1, 1880, may be found in the Mortality Censuses.

Slave schedules were taken in 1850 and 1860 for the Southern States. Slave owners are enumerated by name, but slaves are listed under the name of their master by sex and age only. (Sale records and probate records may help locate the names of slaves)

Remember, not everyone is found in the census. People may have been moving, died between census years, have been away from home, or were just plain missed. We may also rely too much on available indexes instead of checking the census itself. It has been estimated there is about a 20% error factor in the most used census indexes. This makes whe use of other records even of greater importance.

# Special Census Schedules & Alternative Records -- Continued

Military actions in this country, beginning in very early Colonial times have provided, or caused to be created, a great mass of records. Only a small portion of these are available from the Federal Government although many beginning researchers believe the Federal Government has them all. The greatest bulk of military records, especially the earlier ones, are found in various depositories in the individual states.

A 1984 publication, "The Source," edited by Arlene Eakle and Johni Cerny, has information on pages 255 - 300 on availability of some military information. This not only includes service records and pension records, but also burial records, requests for tombstones, draft records, and other related data.

Thousands of names are in "The Index of Revolutionary War Pension Applications" published in 1976 by the National Genealogical Society of Washington, D.C. (This includes Bounty Land Applicants, and this book is widely available)

The "DAR Patriot Index" books are another source. Many of the men and women listed did not serve in the Continental Line, nor did they receive a pension -- hence many are not listed in the records in Washington, D.C. The latest DAR Index book lists the wives' names alphabetically.

There are many tax lists and alternative records that may be located in the Salt Lake Catalog, or in the book, "The United States Census Compendium" published by the Everton Publishers, Inc. The book by Everton may also help in locating some of the State/Territory Census Records, some of which I will list below.

Evans Collection

The California State University at Sacramento Library has the index to the Evans Collection. The index is by the year. The Collection covers written material from the Colonial Period -up to the Revolutionary War. The collection is located at UC Davis, and U.C. Berkeley. CSUS can get the microfilm on interlibrary loan. It is supposed to be a very complete collection. (Thanks to Linda Leone)

Preserving Newspaper Clippings

Mix two teaspoons of magnesium carbonate and a quart of club soda in a large plastic dish. Sandwich the clippings between two pieces of scree or 'Pellon', a material sold in most fabric stores, and soak for 30 minutes. Mop up the excess liquid with blotting paper and allow to dry overnight on more blotting paper. After using this preservation technique, store the clippings in a well sealed flat plastic bag (preferably mylar). They should keep forever. (From the National Archives)

An alternative to the above is to dissolve a Milk of Magnesia tablet in a quart of Club Soda overnight. Pour into a pan with flattened clipping. Soak one hour. Remove and pat dry. Estimated Life: 200 years. (It is suggested one practice on clippings that are not of value before you actually preserve a valuable clipping. (Root Digger)
