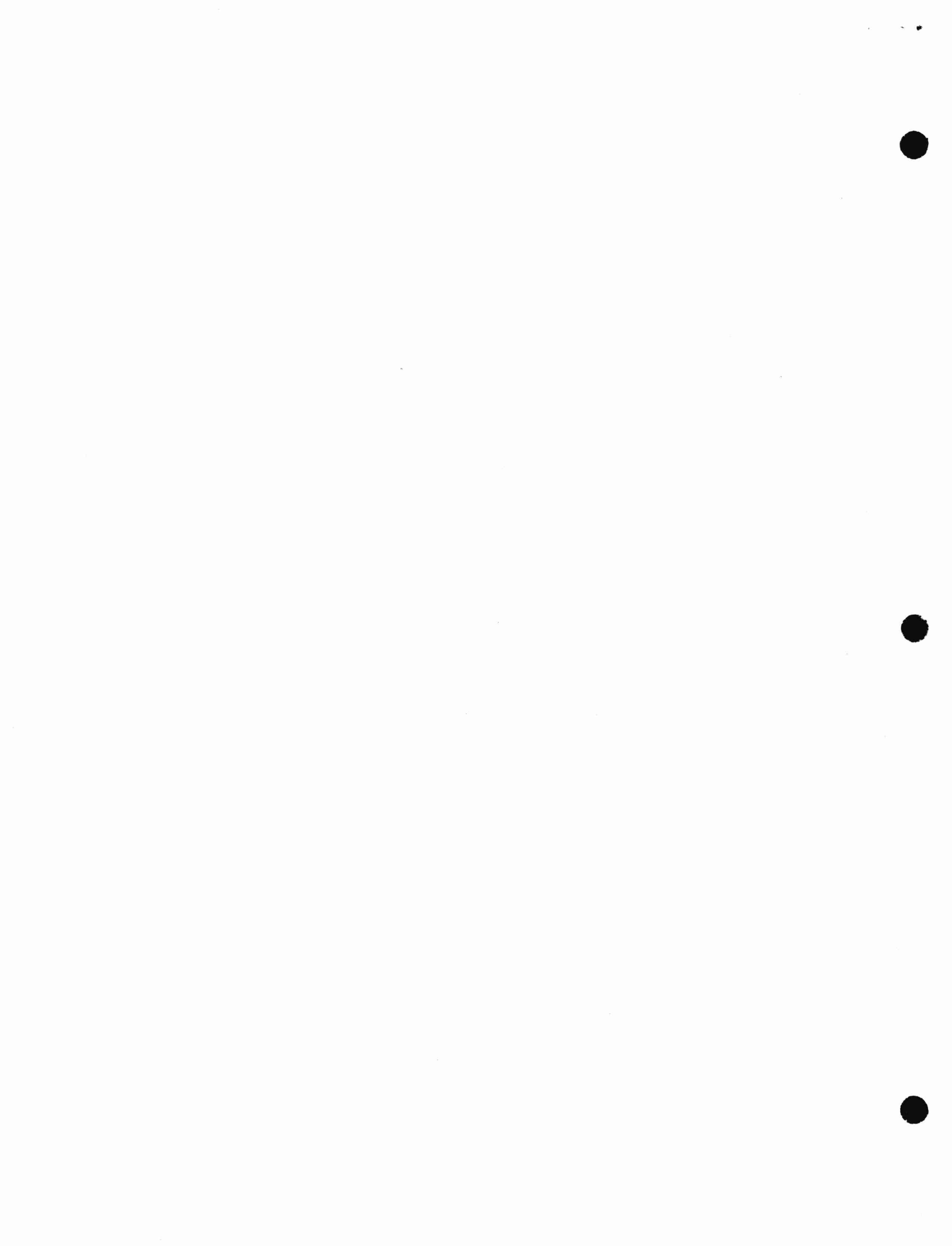

PIONEERS OF OWYHEE COUNTY IDAHO

Cont. from Vol. 29 No. 3

THOMAS, MR. JOHN R., was born in the Island of Anglesea, North Wales, on May 10, 1841. Commenced mining at an early age, and in 1864 emigrated to Nova Scotia, where he was engaged in mining until 1868, when he struck out for California, and for about two years was coal mining on Mount Diablo. In the spring of 1870 he went to Owyhee county, and for several years was foreman of several mining companies on War Eagle mountain. In 1883 he went to Wood river, and returned from there in 1896, accepting the position of foreman of the Florida Mountain Mining Company, which position he still holds. Mr. Thomas has had a vast and varied experience in mining matters, and is looked upon as an authority in mining circles generally. He is a member of the A.O.U.W.

THOMPSON, ELDRIDGE A., was born in Hookset, N.H., February 20, 1833. Came to California in 1857, via the Isthmus of Panama; to Elk City, Idaho, in 1862; to Boise Basin in April, 1863, and to Owyhee in June, 1864, where he has since resided. Mr. Thompson has been chiefly engaged in mining, but clerked at various times for William Hardiman, Du Rell & Moore, Sol Hearst, and others. He owns the Advalorem and Idlewild mines, on War Eagle mountain, both valuable properties. For the past eight years he has held the position of chief clerk at the Idaho hotel, for the proprietor, S.T.N. Smith, and also served as deputy treasurer for the two terms of that office held by Mr. Smith. Mr. Thompson is a valued member of the Masonic fraternity.

TOWNSEND, MR. WILLIAM HENRY, was born at Shoreham, Vermont, on April 12, 1832, and, with his parents, at the age of twelve, emigrated to Winnebago county, Wisconsin, where he remained until February, 1853, when he crossed the plains for California, where he mined at all the prominent mining localities until 1857. Then he engaged in ranching in Mendocino county, California, remaining there until the spring of 1862, when he joined a party bound for Powder river district, and landed in what is now called Owyhee county in June, 1863, camping on the site of

BIOGRAPHIES OF EARLY SETTLERS

Horseshoe Bend -- Hannah I. Hoff, 95, formerly of Horseshoe Bend, who helped found a church, a library and a high school in McCall, died Monday in a Boise hospital. She was born Feb. 3, 1885, in Lacqui, Minn. She taught in several Minnesota schools before she married Theodore Hoff on July 26, 1905. Five years later, they moved to McCall and her husband helped found the Hoff and Brown Co. In 1938 they moved to Horseshoe Bend. She was named Idaho Mother of the Year in 1956. Surviving are two sons, Harvey O. Hoff of Caldwell, and Irvin A. Hoff, of Hilton Head Island, S.C.; three daughters, Helen Frye of Horseshoe Bend, Irma Kling of Floral Park, Florida, and Priscilla Hayes of Green Valley, Arizona; 14 grandchildren, and 23 great-grandchildren.

Blackfoot -- Monday marks the 100th birthday anniversary of Baxter W. Hopkins at Bingham Nursing Home in Blackfoot. For the past 83 years Hopkins has made his home in Idaho, as farmer and stockman, horseman and racing enthusiast, and owner with his brother "Temp" of a wholesale and retail meat business in Blackfoot. That business is still going today, operated by his three sons, Russell G., Marcellus "Tardy", and Lester W. Hopkins.

Baxter Hopkins was born in Dandridge, Tennessee, on February 2, 1870. His father, William Montgomery Hopkins, fought four years with the South in the Civil War. When Baxter was 17, the family moved to Grangeville and established a 160-acre homestead, with 2,000 head of cattle, right next the reservation where one of the Indians was a brother of Chief Joseph. There would sometimes be 40 or 50 Indians camped in the yard and Baxter would hand out ham and bacon.

The pioneer, who is 100 years old Monday, comes from sturdy stock: Grandma Hopkins lived to be 97; Brother Jim, 96; Temp, 94. Sister Margaret reached 88 and Jenny, 92. In addition to his three sons in Blackfoot, Baxter Hopkins has four grandchildren and four great grandchildren.
