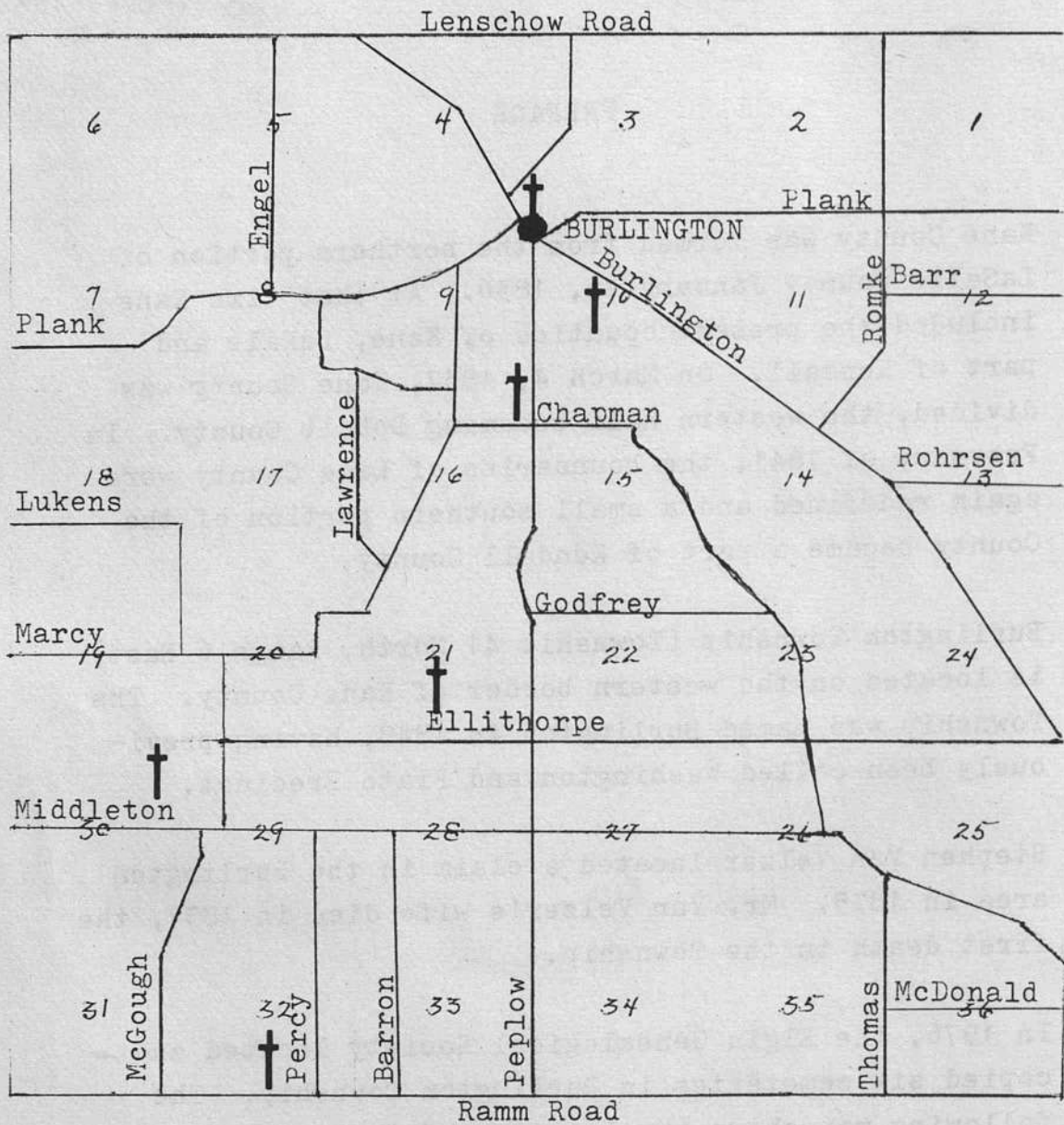
PREFACE

Kane County was formed from the northern portion of LaSalle County January 16, 1836. At that time Kane included the present counties of Kane, DeKalb and part of Kendall. On March 4, 1837, Kane County was divided, the western half becoming DeKalb County. In February of 1841, the boundaries of Kane County were again redefined and a small southern portion of the County became a part of Kendall County.

Burlington Township (Township 41 North, Range 6 East) is located on the western border of Kane County. The Township was named Burlington in 1848, having previously been called Washington and Plato Precinct.

Stephen Van Velzer located a claim in the Burlington area in 1835. Mr. Van Velzer's wife died in 1837, the first death in the Township.

In 1976, the Elgin Genealogical Society located and copied six cemeteries in Burlington Township. The following map shows the location of these cemeteries.
