Born on the Fourth of July—a century ago

Denton native still enjoys Fourth of July and her own ties to U.S. history

The ties to our nation's history run deep for a Denton native. Not only does she share a birth date with the country but her family was also there to assist with the arrival of one of our country's greatest Presidents.

Frances Lee Friend Marsh, longtime resident of Winfield, Kansas, will celebrate her 100th birthday July 4th. Frances was born July 4, 1898, in Denton to Charles C. and Nancy Lee Friend, the youngest of seven children. Her parents had moved by covered wagon from Kentucky in 1881 to relocate in northeast Kansas.

Both sides of the Friend's families had been among the early settlers of Larue County, Kentucky and lived on land adjoining the Thomas Lincoln homestead on South Fork near Hodgenville, Ky.

Three grandmothers from the families were called to assist at the time of Abraham Lincoln's birth.

And according to a number of accounts, including Carl Sandberg's biography of Lincoln, Aunt Peggy Walters, Grandmother Friend and Grandmother Keith attended the future president's birth.

Shirley Everhart, daughter of Frances Marsh, said that event has always been a source of pride in their family and especially so for her mother around the Fourth of July.

"That part (of our family history) has been

handed down through the years and there has been a lot of genealogical research so we know there is something to it," said Everhart. "Those three grandmothers went over to help the Lincolns and one even nursed Lincoln...another dressed and cared for him and the third stayed to help out."

That tie to the history of the country has always been important for Marsh, her daugh-

ter said she has always been very patriotic.

"The Fourth of July has always been very important," said Everhart. "When she was born, she was the youngest of the children they were already 21 years old and (she) was down...They went out on the wagon to a Four

of July celebration and when they came back my mother had been born. The Fourth of July has always been a big event in our family."

Marsh's father who was 53 years old when Frances was born, was a Civil War veteran who chose to serve on the Union side after seeing a slave sold at auction in Hodgenville and separated from his family. Frances is one of only a few living children of Civil War veterans.

"The timing is unusual," said Everhart.

She said when she tells people she is the granddaughter of a Civil War veteran and her mother is the daughter, they think she is off by a generation but because both Marsh and Everhart were born later in their parent's lives the span to the other great story involving Lincoln is shorter than most families.

The Friend family moved from Denton to Emporia about 1910 so their children could receive an education. Frances' older sister went on to become supervisor of elementary education for the Lawrence School system in the 1920's - an usual accomplishment for a woman at that time.

Frances, who had become an accomplished pianist received an associate degree in music from Emporia Normal (later to be called Emporia State University). She shared her musical talents in many ways giving piano recitals at Beach Auditorium at Emporia Normal, playing at family gatherings accompanying her brother who sang tenor, and playing at church. During WWI, she accompanied her

music professor by traveling to surrounding communities by train to help raise money for war bonds. She has likened the experience as being similar to the USO of W.W.II. Through the years, her interest in music has been shared in many ways and she played the piano for the enjoyment of others until this past year. Her treasury of old piano music has been an important part of her life. While in college, Frances became a member of Sigma Sigma Sigma Sorority, which recently recognized her longevity at their national convention in Virginia. She is a longtime member of Eastern Star receiving a 75 year pin a few years ago from the Winfield chapter. Her longtime membership in the First Baptist Church in Emporia and later Winfield has probably been the most important involvement in her life. She has shared her music at church, taught Sunday School, we head of the junior department for many years, has been involved in women's society, and has been a longtime and devoted member of her women's Sunday School class. She has also been a member of PEO, Priscilla Club and Music Club.

Following World War I, Frances met Arthur Garnet Marsh also of Emporia who was returning from service as a Marine in France. They were married on October 4, 1921, and lived in Leavenworth and Ft. Scott before moving to Winfield in June, 1929, to open Marsh's Shoe Store at 911 Main, a business which was in operation by the family for fifty years closing in May, 1979. They have commented that during 1929 many shoe stores

were for sale, and they selected the store in Winfield to purchase sight unseen in part because of the cultural influence of the community which had been highlighted in a magazine article about Winfield in the 1920's. They always felt it was the right decision and have enjoyed being a part of the Winfield community.

The Marshes had two daughters, Jane Lee Clift of Winfield and Shirley Jo Everhart of Wellington. There will be five generations present at the family gathering on Saturday including the two daughters and their husbands, seven grandchildren, eleven great grandchildren and one great great grandchild as well as five step great grandchildren and several respective spouses. Mr. Marsh passed away in May, 1979, and Frances moved to Cumbernauld in 1990 where she has enjoyed making many new friends and sharing her music for Vesper Services.

Although she is not able to receive visitors easily at this time, friends who might like to share in her celebration may send a card to her at Cumbernauld Village, 0716 Tweed, Winfield. She will be featured on NBC Today show with Willard Scott birthday segment on Friday morning, July 3. The show airs between 7 and 9 a.m.

"Her birthday and Independence Day have always been important for her," said Everhart. "She has always been patriotic and a flag waver. Someone decorated a cake for her the other day in red, white and blue and someone asked if she got tired of that, but she never does."

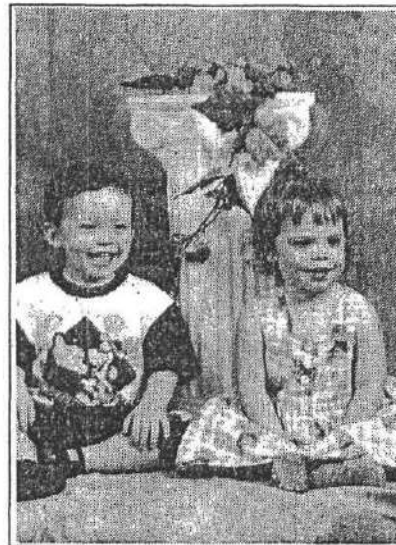
