This newspaper was found on a reel of microfilm in the Greenwood Historical Society Museum, 120 W 4th street, Eureka, KS 67045.

Published weekly on Saturday by J.H. Morse, usually 4 pages with 3 columns per page, it was mainly advertisements and lots of "non-sense" stories and articles NOT LOCAL, and only rarely had notices of births, marriages or deaths or other local items of substance, but each issue was **SCANNED** specifically for references to births, marriages and deaths, and items believed by this compiler to have some substance for local historians and genealogists were sometimes included.

Entries were hand copied, while moving the film image several times on the reader screen, then typed into a computer database for alphabetizing and printing. Proof reading was NOT done, so some typo errors may exists, but if found, THINK, and the item is there.

Index, FALL RIVER NEWS July 17, 1908 – July 19, 1909

This newspaper was found on a reel of microfilm in the Greenwood Historical Society Museum, 120 W 4th street, Eureka, KS 67045.

Published weekly on Friday, there were three "local editors" listed during this period, J.A. Powell, Addie Green, and J.M. Taylor. The paper varied from four to eight pages, but each with six columns, and compared with others newspapers indexed by this compiler, contains very little local news other than "who is visiting who."

Each issue was **SCANNED** specifically for references to births, marriages and deaths, but items believed by this compiler to have some substance for local historians and genealogists were sometimes included.

Entries were hand copied, while moving the film image several times on the reader screen, then typed into a computer database for alphabetizing and printing. Proof reading was NOT done, so some typo errors may exists, but if found, THINK, and the item is there.

This newspaper was found on a reel of microfilm in the Greenwood Historical Society Museum, 120 W 4th street, Eureka, Kansas 67045.

Published weekly on Friday by John W. Gardner, in a variable format, usually 4 pages, 7 columns per page, but for various periods, up to 8 pages and 6 columns.

Each issue was **SCANNED** specifically for items related to births, marriages, deaths, out-of-state relationships, and service men, and other items believed by this compiler to be of substance for local historians and genealogists. Each index entry consists of four parts:

Name/event reason for being page/column number issue date

As page/column numbers varied and the image had to be moved a number of times on the reader screen, and proof reading was **NOT** done, it is possible some typo's may exist, but if found, THINK, look forward or backward, the item is there.

The terms "died", "obituary" and "biographical obituary" indicate the amount of information to be expected, from "least" to "most".
