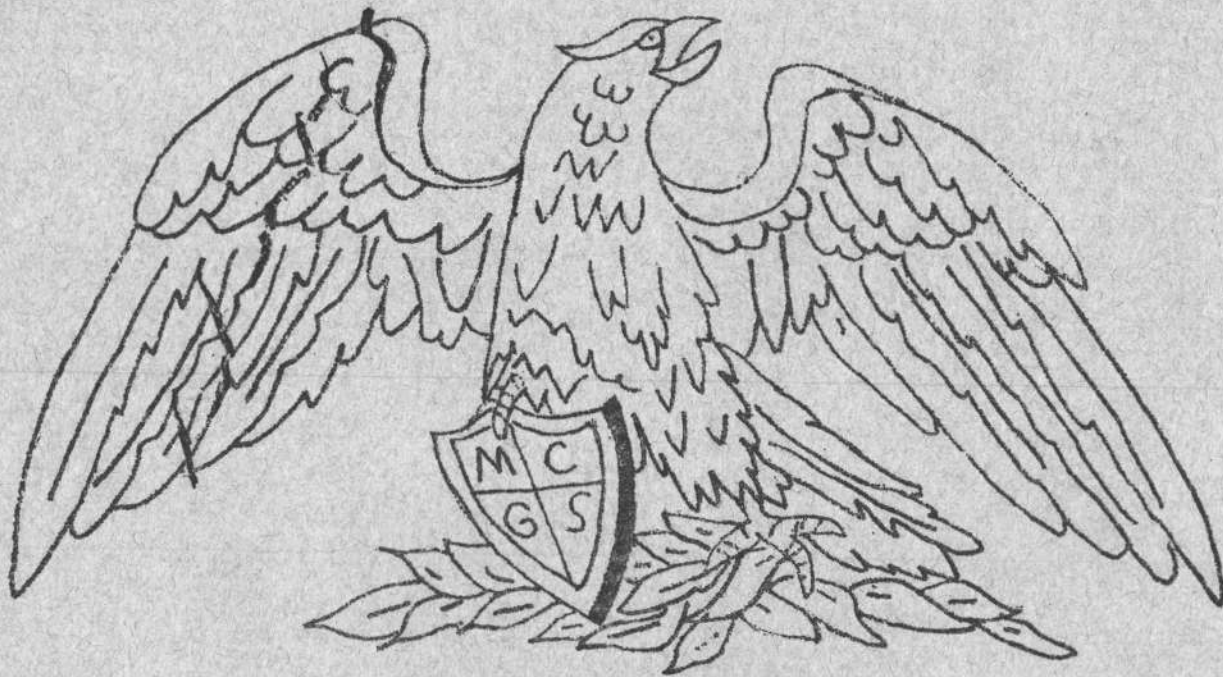

I John Gibson of Christian County and State of Kentucky the 22nd day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine, being of sound mind and disposing memory & knowing that life is uncertain, and that its appointed unto us all once to die, do make this my last Will and Testament in the words and language following  
To Wit

Article 1st. I give and bequeth to my Wife Juda Hogg Gibson should she survive me, all my real and personal estate, (to be at her use and disposal, but not to be abused or wasted) during her natural life.

Article 2nd. At the death of my wife Juda Hogg Gibson, I make the following bequests! ## STONY POINT or WALTER JOHNSON SCHOOL, DIST. #97 1872-1910 Township 35; Range 17E

Stony Point, as #97 was called until the 1927-28 school year, had considerable difficulty getting started. On June 6, 1872, Nathan Bass issued the order of organization. On the 15th of the next month some patrons met in the home of S. S. Drake to elect officers. However, no school was held that winter and no school meeting called the next spring whereupon Mr. Bass, the County Superintendent, called a meeting in the home of E. W. Simpkins, on the 31st of May, 1873, for the election of new officers. School got started that fall. The reason for the delay or reluctance to begin a new district may have been the fact that district #1, Parker, encompassed all of the area to be made into the new "Stoney Point". Conflict of opinion among the patrons and the effort of Parker to become the first city of the area probably were factors in the delay.

The famous fall player, Walter Johnson, claimed a farm in the district as his home and in 1927 the district was renamed in his honor.

On July 1, 1965, Walter Johnson, #97, was disorganized.
