

JAMES SCHOOL DIST. #98 1872-1965

FAWN CREEK TOWNSHIP 35, RANGE 16 E

The order of organization for the James Dist. #98 was issued on June 20, 1872 by County Supt. Mr. Nathan Bass. On the 20th of July patrons met in the home of A. G. Chambers to perfect the organization. One acre of land was set aside located on SE of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8.

School census figures for 1872-73 gave 26 as the number of residents between the ages of 5 and 21. This number had doubled by 1900 and when Coffeyville grew in manufacturing to the point where rural residents began to work in town also, then James district began to increase in population. The first affect of this was to take the east half of its area to form another school district in 1887, and called the new district Sunflower # 107. About 1907 the brick building was built by replacing the wooden original structure—in the 1930's the brick building was stuccoed or cemented.

By 1947 Sunflower District #107 was added back to James by re-organization. The old Sunflower building and contents were sold for \$1,580.00. This formed the nucleus for a new building, which bonds were voted for during the 1948-49 school year. The old James building was sold for \$758.00 on November 29, 1949. A new James school building was built in 1950-1 mile South and 2 mile East on a black top road at a more central location. The next year, 38 pupils were enrolled.

The demand for graded schools and better facilities caused many parents to send children to Dearing School-thus the last year only 18 children were enrolled with 2 teachers.

On the 1st of July 1965, the James District #98 became a part of Unified School District #445. In 1984 as this is being prepared, the old original school building of James is still standing on the corner, and is being used as a residence. The newer James School building is in use as a community building. Thus ends the James District #98, but its memories linger on in many of our minds of the fun times as children we had there while learning to read, write, and spell.

The old James School building was built in 1908. My family-Samuel Kerr, Minnie Bell Kerr, Hollis Kerr, Harold Kerr and myself, Doris Kerr, all moved to a farm purchased from Oscar Jensen in 1910. Four years later, we sold the farm to the W. A. Walborn family. There were Mr. and Mrs. Walborn, their two daughters-Lydia and Salera, and one son-Noah Walborn. In 1919, Noah Walborn and Doris Kerr were married. Later, after the death of Mr. and Mrs. Walborn, my husband and I moved to the farm, where I still live. We had one daughter, Joline. She married Harold Jaggers. They had three children: Lois, Cheryl, and Darrell. After my husband passed away in 1965, they moved to the farm, where we still live. I was ll years old when I started to the old building. Grace Bettisworth was the teacher at that time. The neighbors were Earl Bushnell family, Brinkman and Steven family, Bill Erne, Jensen, Kerr and Carns. Two of the Carns girls-Grace and Franc-live in town. The Heggerman family lived across the road from the old school building. These families are all gone now. I am the only one left of this group. Of course, there are sons and grandchildren who live in the district.

My daughter, Joline, went through all 8 grades of the old building. Some of her teachers were Delores Harell, Elizabeth Hahn, and Ethel Fry. The new building was built in 1850, which we use as a community building. The Rambling Rangers, 4H Club, Community Club, and other meetings are held there. The different clubs are in the process of repairing the building.
