Was created Master of Arts by that institution in 1870. Was admitted to the bar at Chicago in 1868. Located at Burlingame, Kas., in April 1870. Was appointed that year Judge of the Probate Court of Osage County. In 1872 was elected County Attorney, and filled that office till 1875. In 1873 was elected by Republican State Convention as one of the State Central Committee, of which body he is now secretary.
