Born in Lithgow, Scotland, Feb. 24, 1845. Taken to Chicago by his parents in 1850. Educated at Chicago University, from which he graduated in 1867. Was created Master of Arts by that institution in 1870. Was admitted to the bar at Chicago in 1860. Located at Burlingaue, Kas, in April 1870. Was appointed that year Judge of the Probate Court of Osage County. In 1872 was elected Courty Attorney, and filled that office till 1875. In 1873 was elected by Republican State Covention as one of the State Central Committee, of which body he is now secretary.
