Sandra Kay Porterfield and Robert A. Johnson were married Nov. 29 at Trinity Episcopal Church.

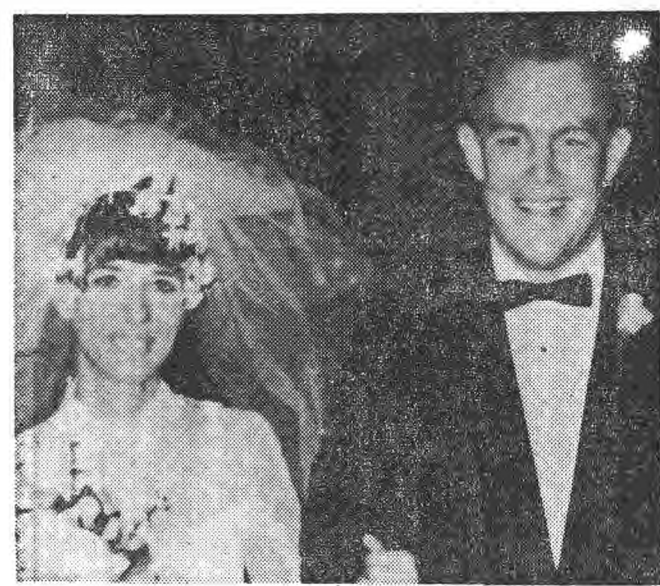
