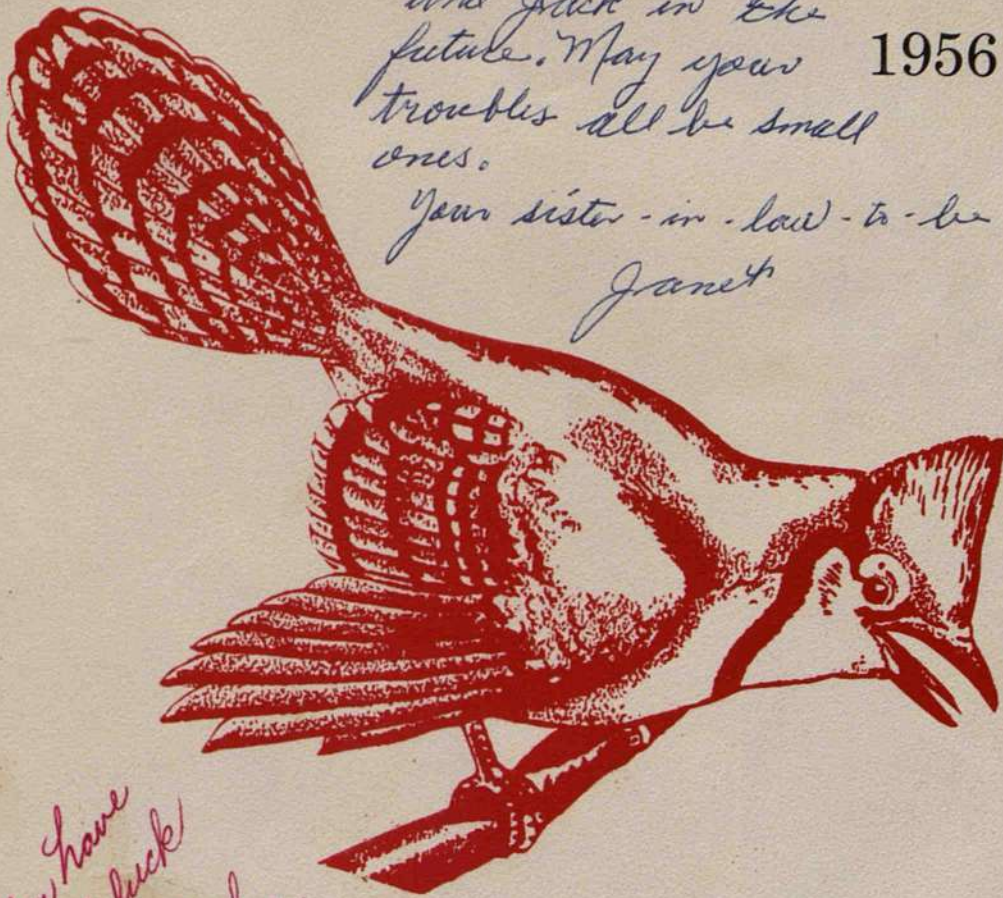

## DEDICATION

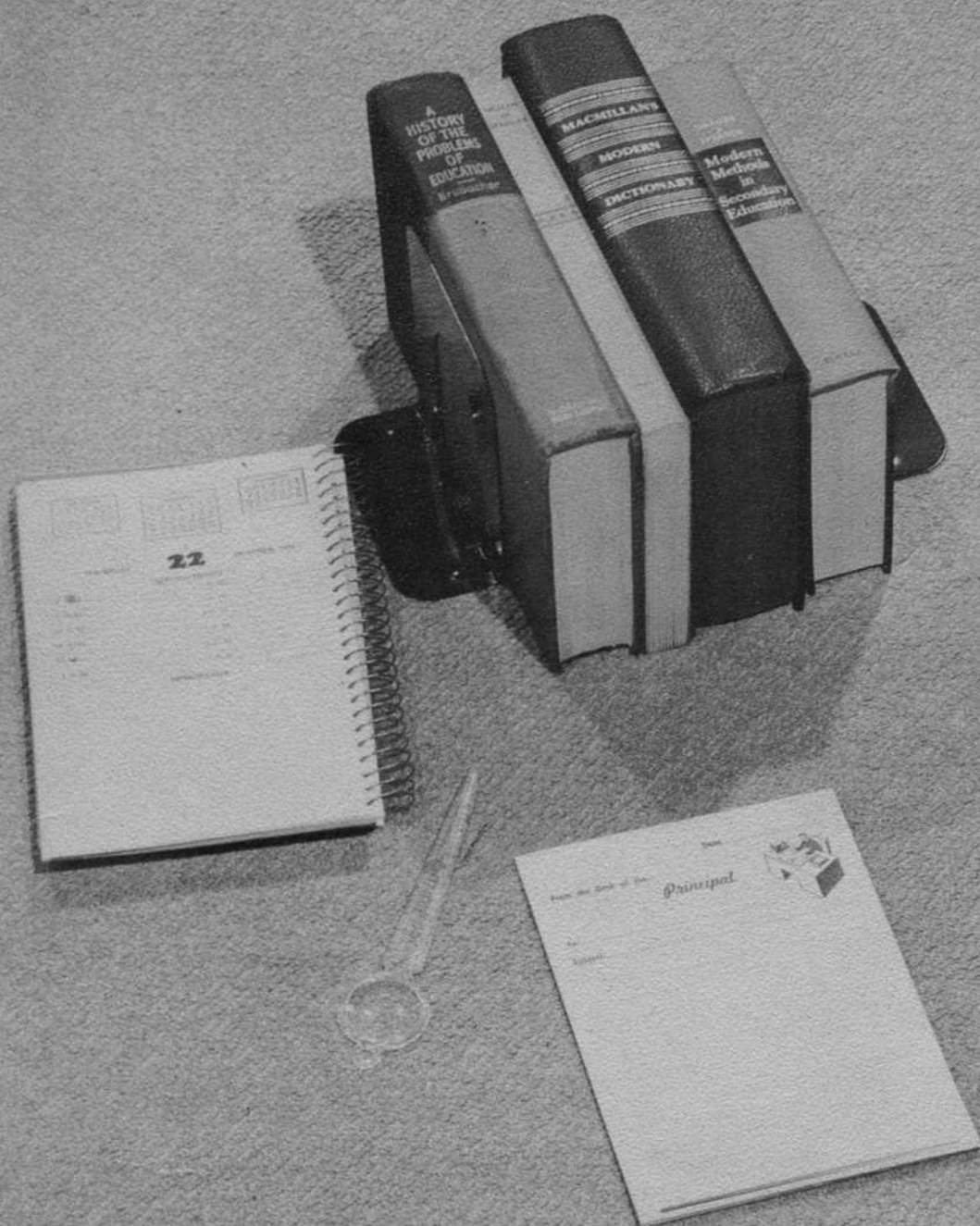
To the memory of Dr. E. C. Petterson, who passed away January 14, this book is affectionately dedicated.

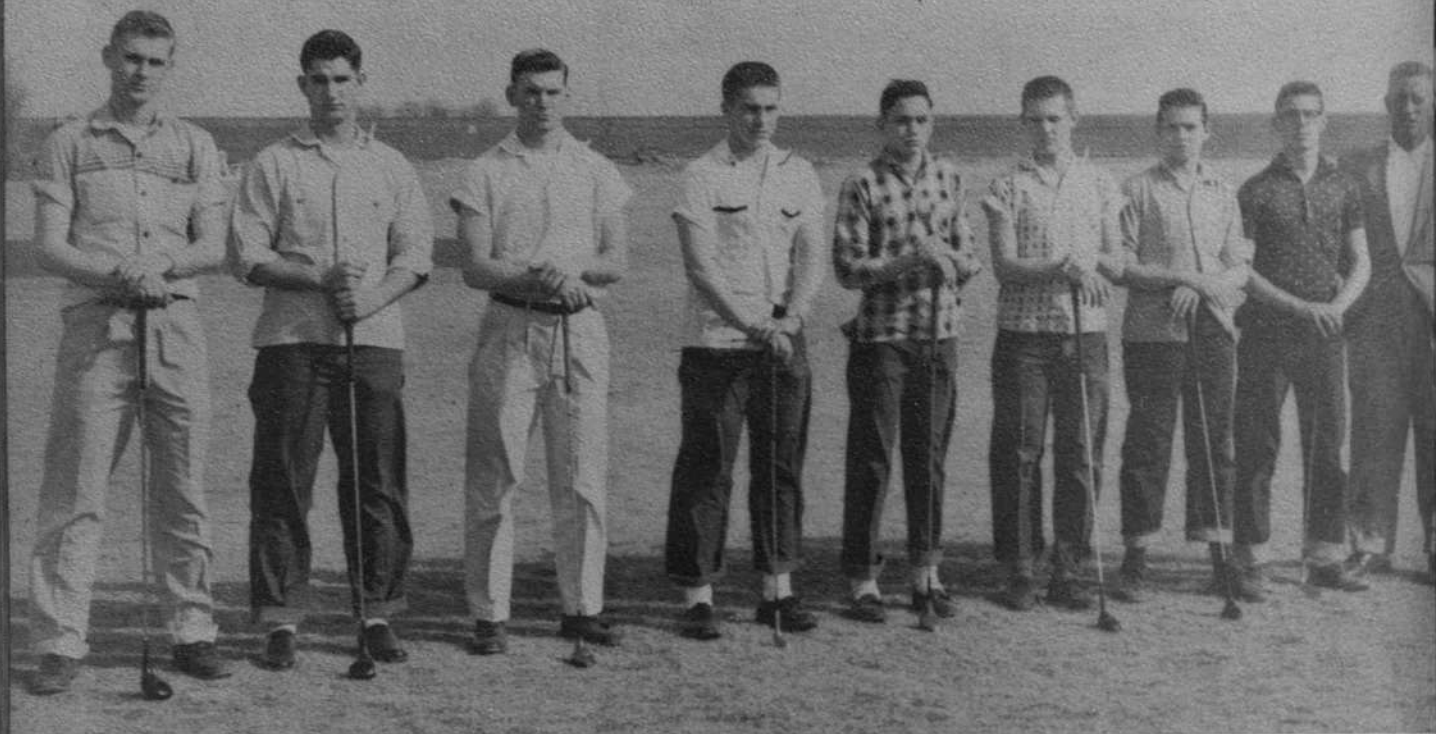
