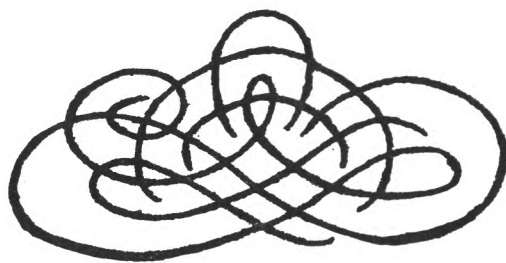

The following are the changes voted on in the Constitution and By-Laws. Make the corrections on your copy.

Article IV Dues--to be corrected by adding on the 4th line following standing of the member: "Membership by mail, dues shall be \$5.00 per year."

Article IV, Sec. 4, shall be deleted.

Article VI, Duties, Sec. 8 (C), is corrected to read: "receive and file all exchanges."

Article VIII Fiscal Year, shall be deleted.

Article 2 amended now reads "The object and purpose of this Society, a non-profit organization, shall be...."
