FAMILY OF BARNABAS GABLE

Barnabas Gable was born in 1770 in Pa., and married Elizabeth Cohen on Dec. 18, 1795 in Greene Co., Tenn. His name appears on the muster roll of a company of gunmen under the command of Capt. Daniel Ross in the service of the U. S. commanded by John Coffee from Sept. 24, 1813 to Dec. 24, 1813, during the War of 1812. Each non-commissioned officer, musician and private travelled 114 miles to Huntsville where they were mustered into service. Elizabeth Cohen was born in 1780 in Pa., and died in Greene Co., Tenn. NEW TROUBLE FOR CITY CLERKS -- The last degislature made a new law that requires that all births and deaths must be registered by the city clerk. Provision was made so that the clerk will not have to do this gratis; he will be entitled to collect a fee of 25 cents for births and deaths. This law makes such registration compulsory and a fine of \$50 and sentence of 6 months in jail is tied to it to be attached to doctors, undertakers and others who may neglect their duty in the matter......The law becomes effective the 1st of July, and thereafter all children born can have a certificate of that fact issued that may be kept as proof to be offered in court or elsewhere. ...
