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POTPOURRI

Thank you Mr. Heiss for your kind words in your Genealogy of August, 1976, concerning the Heritage Genealogical Society quarterly. We have a few very dedicated workers, as is customary in most societies, and it affords us a great deal of satisfaction to accumulate all the Wilson County information we have in order to help other genealogists. We always hope others are doing the same in the counties in which we are interested.

For quite some time members of our society have been clipping obituaries from Neodesha newspapers and pasting them in notebooks. We have also pasted in other notebooks the queries and answers columns from old Hartford Times which Mrs. Edward Graham, of Cresskill, N. J. brought us. Now, who but Claire Ramsey tackled the job of indexing both sets of notebooks, which makes the material quickly available to researchers. A tremendous job! We are most grateful to Claire. She is the one who has organized us from the beginning, so those with ancestors from Wilson County, Kansas really have her to thank.

The latest additions to book purchases by the society are: Early Pennsylvania Land Records, by Egle, and Vol. III of the Horn Papers. The latter is a boon to those with ancestors in Fayette, Green, and Washington Counties, Pa. It is an atlas which shows the early land owners in those counties, and the dates patented and surveyed. There are inaccuracies, but those can be overlooked in view of the tremendous amount of accurate information.

John Furniss presented his book Hill and Allied Families to the Rankin Library because it includes the family of John Baker Keys, one of the town founders, and grandfather of a local attorney, P. W. Stephens.

We ordered only the 1885 Wilson Co., Kansas State Census on microfilm--not for the entire State, as stated in Vol. 6, No. 1 of our quarterly.

Did you know that Uncle Sam really lived? Uncle Sam was born 13 Sept., 1766, in what is now Arlington, Mass. That would make him 203 years old now. His real name was Samuel Wilson, and he was the seventh of 13 children. When Samuel was almost nine years old his family moved to Mason, N. H. He later became a meat packer, and during the War of 1812 he received a contract from the U. S. to pack meat for the army. The initials "U. S." were carved on all the Wilson barrels. When someone asked who was feeding the army, the reply was: "Why Uncle Sam Wilson", so he became known as Uncle Sam, and the legend started. The U. S. Congress formally recognized Sam Wilson as the progenitor of Uncle Sam, our national symbol, 15 Sept. 1961. The city of Arlington, Mass. erected a statue in his honor. How about that! My Wilson line goes back to that part of the country. Could we be related? I'll have to look into that.

GRAND ARMY MEMORIAL RECORD
HUMPHREY POST NO. 145
NEODESHIA, KANSAS

These records are copied from the above-mentioned book, which was supposed to be used to secure and perpetuate the military history of every Grand Army comrade.

This post was started 9 Jan. 1883, and according to information of Joseph W. Allen, Town Historian, William W. Basore was the last surviving member of the Post when he died 8 March 1939, at May, Kansas at the age of 92.

Information besides that recorded in this article consisted of the record of military service, and the list of their intimates, all of which would probably be available on the Civil War record of each person, which can be obtained by sending GSA Form 6751 to the Military Service records (NNCC), National Archives, GSA, Washington, D. C. 20403. (These forms are available free from them.) If a record is found they will send a copy and a bill for \$2.00. One would certainly want to obtain these records, as the physical description, wife's name, marriage date, and a list of the children are often given. When requesting a copy it is best to ask for that showing the most genealogical information, as they have records classed as "Military, Pension, and Bounty Land".

The list is alphabetized by the first letter of the surname only. The page number given is the page on which the information is recorded in the book from which this information has been copied.
