

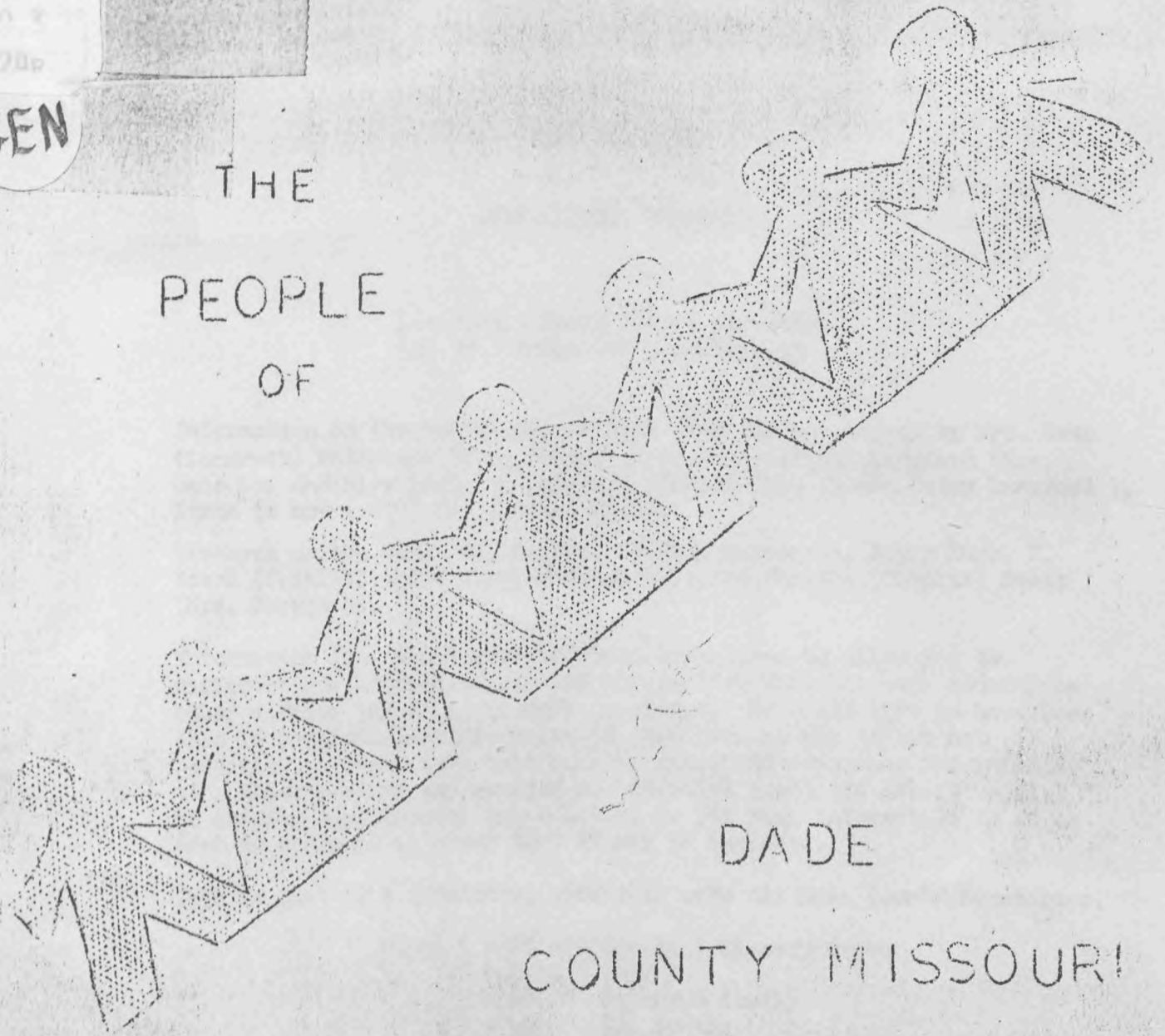

RICE CEMETERY

The Rice Cemetery is located in South Morgan Township - Twp 32 N Range 25 W - Section 35, Dade Co Mo. The acreage of which this cemetery is a part was entered from the U.S. Government in 1844 by Joshua Owens and sold to John C. Kirby in 1846.

In 1846 -- sold by John C. Kirby to Peter Gerhart

In 1851 -- sold by Peter Gerhart to James Moore

In 1858 -- sold by James and Jane Hoore to H.C. Bender and Serena Kirby

In 1860 -- sold by H.C. Bender & Serena Kirby to Selina H. Rice

Dade Co. Mo Deed Book 8, page 730: In 1866 Salina H. Rice sold for \$30.00 1.5 acres to John C. Kirby, R. A. Clark, T. A. Kirby, J. P. Edge, and their heirs and others of the district or neighborhood and others who may hereafter reside in the neighborhood for the use and purpose of a graveyard. So this is where the name of Rice came to be. If it was ever referred to by any other name it is not known to us at present. It was a cemetery long before the above dates however, as the records will show.

Dade Co. Mo. Deed Book 29, p. 118: In 1879, Joseph H. Edge and Nancy McGill Edge deeded 1 and 7/10 acres to John C. Kirby, A. C. Patterson, T. C. Kirby, H. T. Hembree, E. J. Morris, J. P. Edge, Wm. W. "Wick" Morgan, etal. This brought the cemetery to its present size. It is reported the first burial was for Alexander Gerhart, but there is no marker found now to mark the grave. At one time there were several graves moved from the town of Dadeville to this cemetery. The reason: they were "to close in." These graves are marked only with sand stones and no dates. Identity unknown? The earliest burial dates found at this time were for Nancy Davidson, 1831-1845 and a Kirby Infant 1844 - 1844.

This cemetery is not listed in rows as they lay in the cemetery but Mrs. Erna Patterson furnished us with the names of the first grave in each row beginning at the gate. This information you will find on page 205.

The Rice Cemetery Association Inc was formed in Feb and March 1958 by Attorney J.W. Cooley of Greenfield, Mo. The following officers were elected:

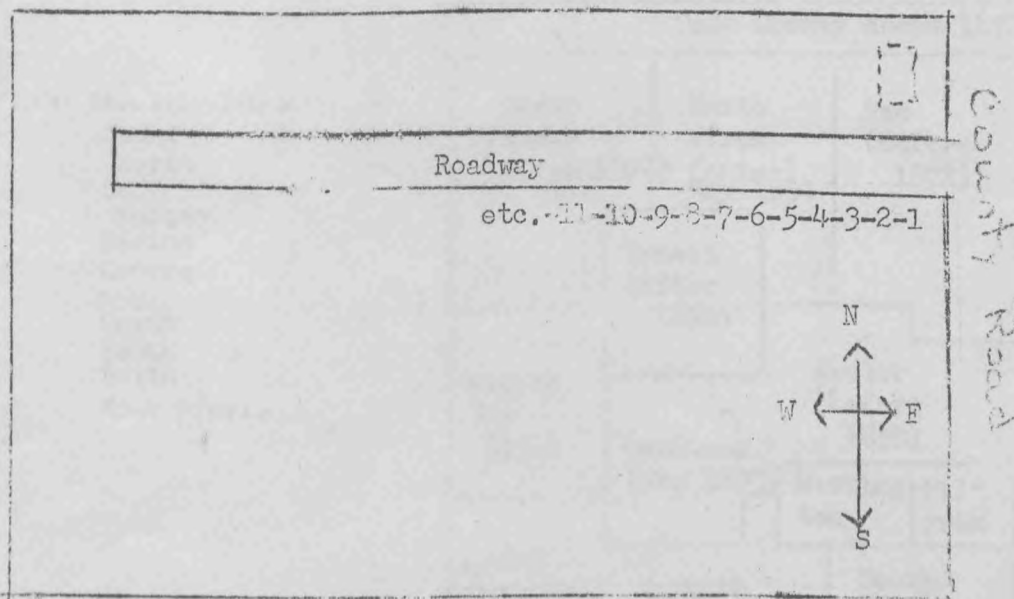

Dade COUNTY TOWNSHIPS

Dade County Missouri was organized in accordance with an Act of General Assembly of the State of Missouri, approved January 29, 1841, and an act supplemental thereto, approved February 15, 1841. The County was formed from what was Greene County. The original county extended nine miles south of its present southern boundary and ten miles north of its present northern boundary. The county was reduced to its present limits March 28, 1846. The Courthouse at Greenfield was destroyed October 6, 1864, along with most of its records.
