### Introduction

Peace Church Cemetery...a comforting name, with a history that doesn't match. This little piece of heaven, enveloped by nature, holds many deep dark secrets and family folklore that can never be proven. A history that seems to become more cloudy as years dim reality. Many stories have been written, each with it's own special flavor.

Just as mysterious are the many graves identified only by fieldstones and marked with an "x" on the map...or not marked at all. Some of the precious tombstones have been broken, removed, disappeared in the mud or haven't withstood the weathering of the past century and a half.

Folklore has it that the first burial was that of a black employee of James Elbert Jones in the mid-1800's. The black man was "a driver on a freighter carrying dry goods to area general stores. He suddenly became ill and died on the road." His work companions found a "peaceful" place to bury him along side the road.

E.P. Dale and his wife moved to the future Jasper County area in 1838, the same year as 27 year old John C. Cox and his new bride. Dale and his wife Frances Shelton Dale, being very religious, made it their goal, to seek out other Christians and begin a series of worship and study meetings in their log house, located 5 miles southwest of the Cox family. In was in the Dale home in 1840 that the Peace Baptist Church was organized. (*Jasper County, The First Two Hundred Years by Marvin L. VanGilder*) They were also among the organizers of the Spring River Baptist Association along with Reverand Greenville Spencer who had built the first church in Jasper County. Freedom Church was located on Jones creek (Fidelity Corner) and Spencer was credited for establishing many pioneer Baptist Churches in the area.

Peace Church was one of four churches that made up the membership of the Spring River Baptist association and was honored to hold the third annual meeting of the association in October 1842.

The time data on when the Peace Church was built has many varied dates. According to Jasper County, The First Two Hundred Years by Marvin L. VanGilder, "Peace (Baptist) Church erected its first building in 1855. It was made of logs but later was replaced by a large frame structure." He also adds..."In 1845, a log school building was erected near Peach Church near Blytheville and Rural (Sherwood). Dolph Shaner's Old Peace Church and Cemetery as Linked With Early Jasper County History" as printed in the Joplin Globe, January 31, 1943 states, "Mrs. Jamison (granddaughter of Thacker Vivion, the county's first white settler) had said her father died in 1852 while hauling logs for the erection of Peace Church."

According to *History of Jasper County* by Joel T. Livingston, "Among the historic old churches of Jasper County was the Peace Church in Galena township, southwest of the Snapp farm. It was organized by the Rev. Greenville Spencer, the same minister who

founded the Freedom Church and like it, was built by the congregation, each man furnishing a certain number of logs. The church building served for a time also as a schoolhouse, when the Enterprise School District was organized. The old church was torn down in 1909 and all that now remains of that once famous church is the old cemetery and the memory of the good that it has done."

Folklore that goes along with the history of Peace Church and Peace Church Cemetery is quoted by an old-timer who tells the tale, "It was a schoolhouse in the woods near Peace Church that burned and the church was 'stolen' and tracked as far as Turkey Creek, but apparently the lumber was never located." Other folklore states, "the logs of the school were moved to the Reverend Johnson's farm southeast of Carl Junction and became part of a barn."

According to Letha A. Moss-Fly's *Through the Years, A History of Peace Church Cemetery 104 Years and Sherwood Cemetery 100 Years*, the first title to the land occupied by Peace Church was "squatter sovereignty. "Robert J. Dale, son of E.P. Dale, entered upon a tract of land northwest of Joplin on March 5, 1856. Upon that tract of land was located Peace Church Cemetery and Peace Church. With the land coming into private ownership, the church organization obtained from Robert Dale a warranty deed conveying to Izaac Raye, clerk for Peace Church, and to his successors forever, the west 20 acres of the southwest quarter, section 28, township 28, range 33. This transaction took place March 15, 1856. The deed was acknowledged before W.H. Maxey, justice of the peace, Jasper County.

Peace Church Cemetery Association of Jasper County, in a letter stated they were responsible for putting up the Pioneer Monument located in Peace Church Cemetery.

The dark side of this once peaceful setting is told in Mary Guccione's, May 26, 1994 Joplin Globe article *Peace Church Cemetery*. Guccione relates the tragic event of William (Billy) (Cockeye)E. Cook, who was convicted and put to death in the San Quinton prison gas chamber in December 1952 for the deaths of the Carl Mosser family which included three children. The bodies were thrown into a mine shaft and discovered two weeks later. Cook's body was laid to rest in an unmarked grave in Peace Church Cemetery.

A record compiled by residents in 1956 lists 800 graves in Peace Church Cemetery, but that does not include the unmarked graves according to *Peace Church Cemetery* by Mary Guccione. Moss-Fly stated, "...there are graves on top of graves in the cemetery."

It is my hope that some of the information gathered in this book will be helpful to the many genealogy seekers, history buffs and those who are just curious.








## CEMETERY MAP


Peace Church Cemetery is a large cemetery. The burials are not in rows, but are scattered about throughout the cemetery. To aid you in finding a particular stone on your visit to Peace Church, I have drawn maps of the cemetery numbering the stones. Due to the size of the cemetery and the number of stones I have split the cemetery into three sections. The first section is the East side of the road running through the cemetery. The second is the West side of the cemetery road and South of a path lined with rocks. The last is also on the West side and North of the path. The latter section is the largest of the three and it appears that the majority of unmarked burials are here.




# East Side
