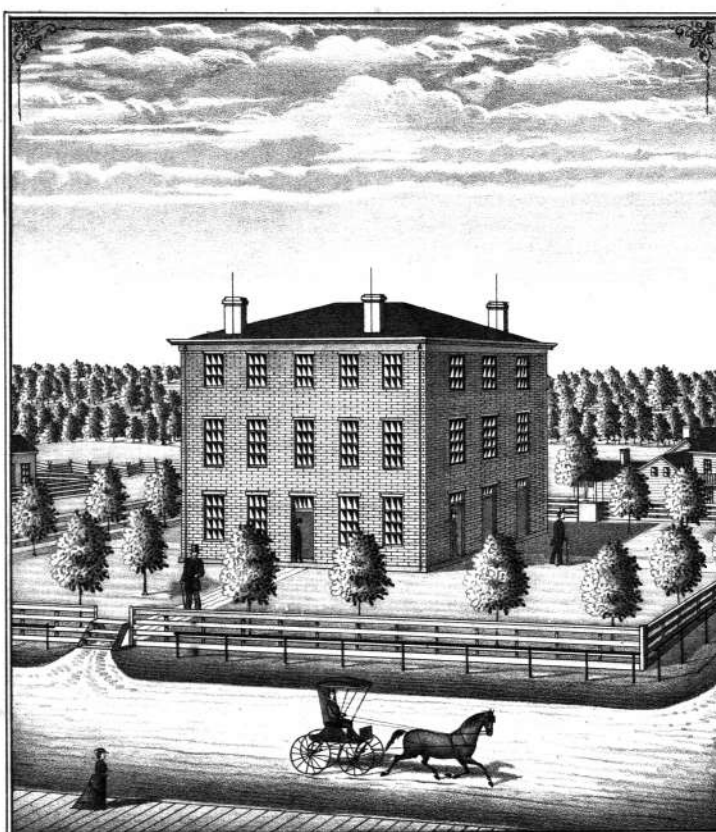
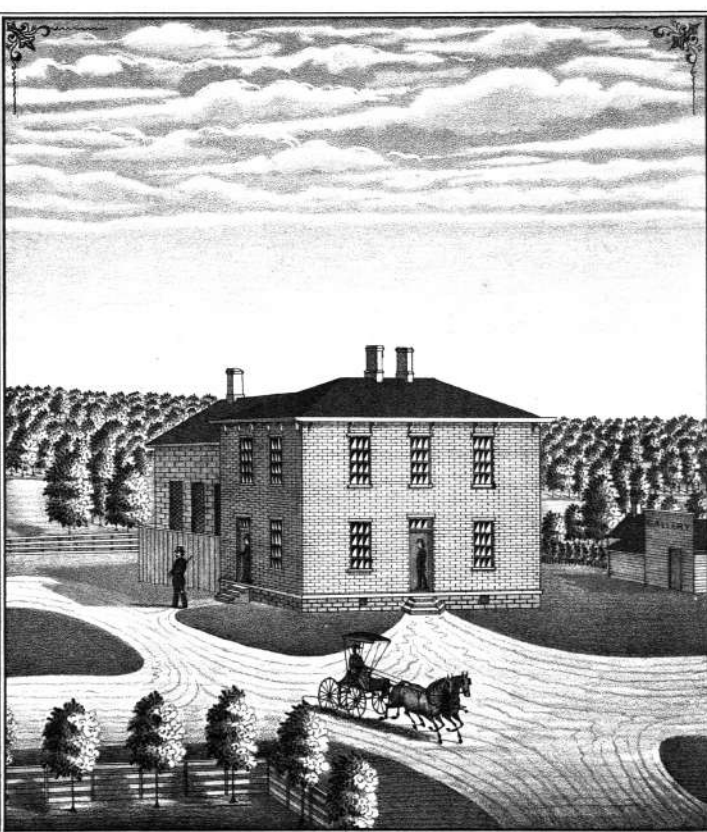




FARM RESIDENCE OF S.R. ALLEN, 5 MILES S.W. OF MOUNT VERNON, LAWRENCE CO. MO.  
 SETTLED ABOUT 1836, FARM CONTAINING 250 ACRES.



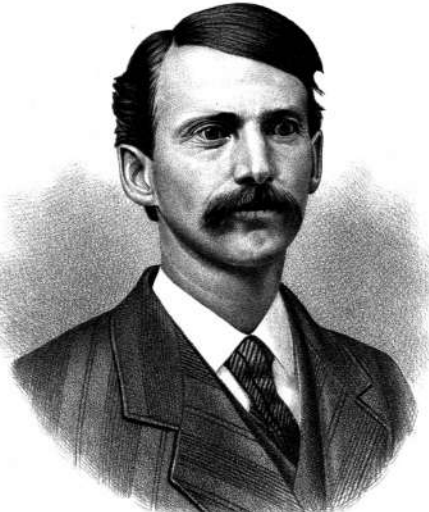
