




PEIRCE CITY HIGH SCHOOL BUILDING

Was born in Giles Co., Middle Tenn., Aug. 6th, 1809. Emigrated to what is now Lawrence Co., Mo., Oct. 1831, and has resided in that county uninterrupted since that time. He, with others, organized the first Sunday-school in Southwest Mo., one mile South of Verona, at "Head of Spring River" School-House in 1839.



James Cherry
Was born in Rowan Co. N. C., Sept. 3d, 1806. Came to Barry
Co., now Lawrence Co., Mo., Nov. 11, 1829. Died June 10, 1874.






