Volume I, of Linn County Cemetery Records, compiled in 1957, contained cemetery records from: Bethel, Botts, Calhoun, Dryden, Enterprise, Gooch, Haseville, Hooker, Jenkins, Locust Valley, Mairs, Morris Chapel, Mount Olive, Mundell, Ogle, Parsons Creek, Pierce, Prather, Purdin, Smith, Strawberry, Wesley Chapel, West Liberty, and those without names in the same area.

Volume II, of Linn County Cemetery Records, compiled in 1958, contains descriptions of locations of the graveyards, biography excerpts, history of the county seat of Linn County, at Linneus, Mo., and contains cemetery records, listed in alphabetical order of cemeteries and names, of Bear Branch, Beckett, Bowyer, Fore, Foshier, Liberty Memorial, Linneus, I. O. O. F., at Linneus, Murrain, Moore, Nester, New Boston, Thorne, and United Brethern. These are the oldest cemeteries of Linn County, Mo.

The territory of which Linn County is composed was once a part of Chariton County. This latter county was organized November 16, 1820, and extended to the Iowa State Line. At the session of the General Assembly of the State of Mo. in the winter of 1836-37, an act was passed, organizing the county of Linn from the territory attached to Chariton County, and extending her municipal government over the territory lying north of her to the Iowa Line. The act was approved January 6, 1837, and from that date Linn County has had a corporate existence. In 1837, a part north of Linn County became Sullivan County.

Bowyer

History of Linn County, 1882
Page 386

William and Jesse Bowyer, with the former's family, and young Louis Tyre, came to section two about the first of January, 1832.

The first white child born in the township and in Linn County was Thomas Benton Bowyer, son of William and Martha (Tyre) Bowyer, who was born on Christmas Day, 1833, on section two.

The first white female child born in the township was a daughter of Jesse Bowyer.

Probably the first death in the township was a child of William Bowyer's named Henry, who was six years old, and died in 1837. He was buried in the Bowyer graveyard, the first burying-ground in the county.

- - -

Mrs. Della Luyster, Linneus, Mo., and I visited the old Bowyer farm where the cemetery is located. The farm is now owned by Mr. and Mrs. Robinson. Mrs. Luyster showed me where the old spring is that was poisoned during the Civil War by Bushwackers. Where the slave quarters were is now the house. The old home has long been torn down.

In the cemetery, now in a pasture contains several foot stones. One had the initials: A. J. B.; there were several rocks which had been used as head stones; and there were three tombstones, which read:

Leonard M. Bowyer, died Sept. 12, 1850, aged 1 mo., 17 da.

Martha A. Bowyer, died April 24, 1864, aged 63 yr., 19 da.

Cordelia B. Bowyer, died Sept. 1, 1865, aged 7 mo., 20 da.

Mrs. Luyster said Jesse Bowyer was buried at this cemetery. His brother, William died in Brunswick. He was taken as a prisoner of war during the Civil War. She said he took scarlet fever while at Brunswick and gave a Negro 40 acres of land to care for him.

The cemetery is located west of Linneus.

History of Linn County, 1882, page 791:

Charles James Fore was born in Cumberland County, Va., September 16, 1823. His father's name was Silas Fore, and his mother's name Sarah C. (Morse) Fore, the name and ancestry being of French Origin. When Charles was one year old, his parents moved to Prince Edward County, and there continued till 1834, when the family numbering seven white members and three slaves, came to this state, and stopped in Chariton County, until the elder Fore had found a permanent location. The latter entered a tract of land two and a half miles north of the present site of Linneus, to which he moved his family in the fall of 1834.

History of Linn County, 1882

Page 159

The first death in Linn County was that of James Copeland, who died in 1834; he lived on the west bank of Locust Creek, west of Linneus. The next death of record was that of Jubal Hurt; the administration of his estate in 1838 is among the first of record. A Mr. Weber died in 1839, and was buried in the Linneus graveyard. In December, 1839, John D. Grant, who surveyed the town of Linneus and made the first sale of lots, died, and was succeeded by Robert W. Foster. These are the early deaths noted.

Page 406

Mrs. Elizabeth Holland, wife of John Holland, is claimed to have been the second burial in the Linneus Cemetery, which event occurred in 1841.

Page 412

The Linneus Cemetery--In 1873 the cemetery was in a deplorable condition. The fence was down and briars and brambles grew rank among the graves. Two ladies, Mrs. Thompson and Mrs. McCormick, circulated a subscription paper and obtained funds sufficient to put Linneus's "God's acre" in a decent condition, for which action their memories deserve to be perpetuated.

The Naming of Linneus

Page 191

When the town was first laid off it was Linnville. On the 5th of November, 1839, the County Court ordered "that the county seat for Linn county be called Linnville"; and on the 30th, twenty five days later, it was ordered "that Linnville be the permanent seat of justice of the county of Linn."

The name was changed at the instance of Dr. Lewis F. Linn himself. On the 4th of February, the same court ordered that the permanent seat of justice for Linn county be called Linneus, instead of Linnville. Judge James A. Clark wrote to Dr. Linn that the county seat had been named, as had the county, in his honor, and asked his approval. The doctor replied that he did not wish to dictate to the court in a matter of that character, but that he preferred the name "Linneus" to "Linnville", and when the Judge laid this letter before the court that body immediately made the change referred to.

Page 190

On the 25th of August, 1839, John Holland and wife conveyed to Linn county the town site, by a deed in the following words and figures. The commissioners, after due investigation, had fixed upon the site and agreed to so report if Mr. Holland would donate it to the county, which he readily agreed to do:

"Know all men by these presents, that we, John Holland and Elizabeth Holland, his wife, have donated and given to the county of Linn, in the State of Missouri, for the use and benefit of said county, as a permanent seat of justice*(Some lawyers have the opinion that if the county seat is ever removed from Linneus, the land will revert to the heirs of Col. Holland.) of said county, fifty acres of land, bounded and situated as follows.....

Page 188

The first County Court of Linn County is supposed to have been held on the first Monday in February, 1837, that being the time set by the act of organization.

- - -

In the beautiful and well kept old Linneus Cemetery, in 1958, lie many of the pioneers and founders of Linn County. They labored physically and mentally to lay a good foundation for the future generations.

Many of the stones from the Cemetery have been lost. It is claimed some of the stones have been carried away in the past years and their whereabouts unknown.

In the following pages I have added bits of history to the burials in the City of the Dead as taken from the History of Linn County of 1882 and the History of Linn County, of 1912.

William S. McClanahan was born in Bourbon Co., Ky., five miles from Paris, on the eighteenth day of Dec., 1800. Liberty Church-Old School Baptist. This church is one of the pioneer churches in Linn County. It was first organized at the residence of Anthony Hine, in July, 1843, by Rev. George Baker. Among the original members were John Reed, Reuben Couch, Anthony and Anna Hines, Susan Hines, and Abijah Woods. There were about twenty members in all. The present house of worship was built in the spring of 1875. It stands on the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section ten, township fifty eight, range twenty. It is a frame, 40x30 feet in size, and cost about \$1,000. The first pastor of the congregation was George Baker. Among those who succeeded him were Revs. Willoughby, William Elston, Martin Doty, and Wilson Thompson. Rev. Walter Cash is the present pastor. Connected with the church house is a cemetery, the two occupying a lot of two acres of land, generously deeded to the organization by J. P. Moore, Esq.

The Moore Cemetery is located upon land which Joseph C. Moore received a government "land patent", which he located in government land in Locust Creek township, and consisted of one hundred and sixty acres from the War of 1812.

Joseph was born in Ala., on the first day of May, 1791. He was the son of James Moore, a gentleman who had served as a captain in the war of the Revolution, and moved to Ala. in an early day.

Joseph was first married in Tenn., in about the year 1820, to Miss Jane Pate, dau. of Jeremiah Pate, of Tenn. She died in 1846, and Mr. Moore was again married early in 1848 to Miss Sophia Root, dau. of David Root, of Linn Co. Joseph C. Moore died at his home east of Linneus on the nineteenth day of May, 1873.

The New Boston Cemetery is situated just outside of the town, and has enclosed a half-acre of ground given by L. B. Hudson. It lies on a gentle slope northwest of the town. A dau. of C. E. McKinney was the first body interred within its sacred enclosure, and at this time some thirty-five mounds tell of death's work in the country around.
