OLD BUCKLIN

The Daily News - Bulletin, Brookfield, Missouri

Before and after pictures of a long-neglected cemetery near Bucklin illustrates what can be done when community-wide interest is activated. The one acre tract of land, which makes up the burial ground was deeded to Linn County by Samuel Minick, in 1883 to be used for cemetery purposes. The cemetery has been very little used in the last 50 years and was inaccessible by road until two Bucklin residents, Wade Cantwell and William Frisbie, became interested.

Crawling through the weeds and brush-covered burial place, the two obtained a list of names from tombstones. They mailed form letters asking for contributions for the proposed restoration project.
