I, William Cornett, of Howard County, Mo..... to my beloved wife, Nancy, all my personal and real estate for the sole purpose of raising and schooling my children and as my afflicted son, Jarett can not attend school.....

(History of Linn County, 1882, page 791----Charles James Fore was born in Cumberland county, Virginia, September 16, 1823. His father's name was Silas Fore, and his mother's name Sarah C. (Morse) Fore, the name and ancestry being of French origin. When Charles was one year old, his parents moved to Prince Edward county, and there continued till 1834, when the family numbering seven white members and three slaves came to this State, and stopped in Chariton county, till the elder Fore had found a permanent location. The latter entered a tract of land two and a half miles north of the present site of Linneus. Mr. Fore was married October 13, 1848, to Miss Ann Elizabeth Wills, daughter of Richard Wills, of Kentucky. They have had twelve children, nine of whom survive at this writing.)
