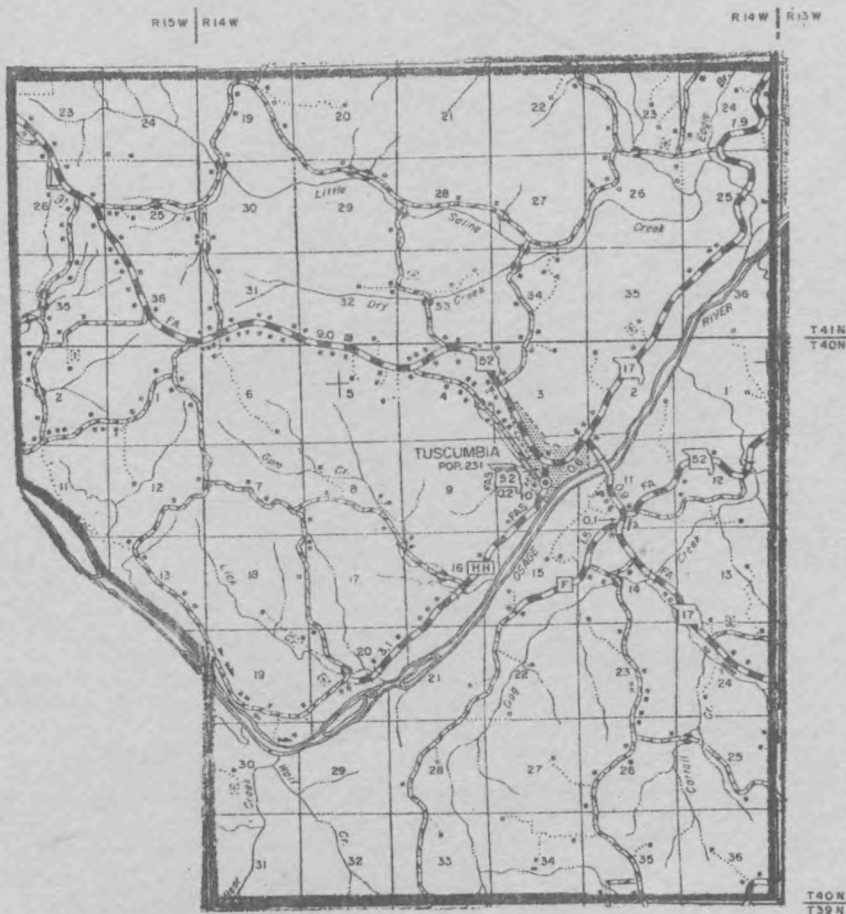

In October of 1971, Carl G. Kelsay of Rocky Mount, Missouri; Stephens M. Barnhouse (now serving in the United States Army); and August F. Barnhouse of Eldon, Missouri, completed the inventory of the headstones in one Miller County cemetery. In spite of cold-cramped fingers and chattering teeth, we three pledged to each other that we would inventory, alphabetize, index, specifically locate, and print inventories of every tombstone in every known cemetery that we could find in Miller County, Missouri.

We are now in our second year of this self-appointed task. During the one thousand plus man-hours we have expended on this task, we have been rained on, snowed on, sleeted on, and hailed on. We have been extremely cold and extremely hot during this, our labor of love. We have enjoyed working in well-kept cemeteries--and we have kept a wary eye out for copperheads in poorly kept ones.

There are a total of seven townships in Miller County. We have thus divided the 137 cemeteries (and over 400 pages of information) into seven books--each book containing one township. The combined seven books contain a listing of over 14,000 headstones. Only 64 cemeteries were already located for us on maps. With the help of many individuals, we have located an additional 73.

In each individual cemetery, surnames are alphabetized. The cemeteries in each township are placed in alphabetic order. The surnames are indexed for easy reference to specific cemeteries. We made every effort to determine the true name of each cemetery. Where diligent effort was to no avail, we named cemeteries by the name attached to the first burial therein or to the predominant families buried therein. Every effort was made to insure the accuracy of the names and dates copied from the headstones. Wire brushes and chalk were used, and return trips to cemeteries to re-check information was not uncommon. We herewith apologize for any mistakes made.

Some cemeteries had already been inventoried by Ilene Sims Yarnell of Versailles, Missouri and by Gwendolyn Gunn Shoemaker of Eldon, Missouri. These were copied and printed with notation made on individual cemeteries.

Carl G. Kelsay was a compiler and alphabetizer. August Barnhouse was compiler, typist and printer. During the long task, a warm and beautiful friendship has flowered.

As each of the seven townships are completed, a copy of that township's cemeteries and headstones is being presented to the Missouri State Historical Society for both use and preservation. The Society has its reference library at Lowry at Hitt Streets, Columbia, Mo.

This is our gift to the present--and to the future. We rejoice at its completion.

Miller County, Missouri

This fenced cemetery is located in Wilson Hollow. Cross the bridge at Tuscumbia on Highway 17. Take Highway 52 toward St. Elizabeth. Just after getting on Highway 52, a county road leads off to the right. Follow this road. .7 mile from the highway, you will pass the Bear Schoolhouse. Proceed another .3 mile to a private road leading south (on your right). Follow this road south and east .6 mile across one creek and 3 branches. You will arrive at a vacated house. The cemetery lies on a hillside approximately .2 mile due south of the house. Roads are for "dry weather" driving only.

BIRDSONG CEMETERY

Section 2, Township 40 North, Range 14 West

Equality Township

Miller County, Missouri

Cross the river at Tuscumbia. Take Highway 52 toward St. Elizabeth. Go about .7 of a mile to a private road on your left which leads to the Calvin Wyrick farm. Park your car in front of the house. Go to your right (north-northeasterly) down a steep hill to a pond. Circle on the far edge of the pond around a deep ditch. Go left 50 to 75 yards and then turn right. The cemetery is about 50 feet in front of you.

This cemetery is quite old. All stones were on the ground and most of those found were covered by heavy foliage. We first inventoried this cemetery on 17 June 1972. A return trip was made by Carl G. Kelsay and August Barnhouse on 20 October 1972, and four more stones were dug from the ground.

CHALLES FAMILY CEMETERY

Section 13 Township 40 North Range 15 West

Equality Township

Miller County, Missouri

This cemetery is located on the Jim Skiles farm, Route 1, Tuscumbia, Missouri. On Highway 52 between El Rancho and Tuscumbia, turn south on the Hall Store road. At the first "Y", bear left. At the second "y", bear right. About 1.1 miles from the second Y is the J. Skiles farm home. A road leads past his garage and through a gate. The cemetery lies on the left hand side of the road just before it makes its descent to the river bottomland.

The cemetery is fenced and the stones are easily read.

DOBSON CEMETERY

Cross the bridge at Tuscumbia, going toward Iberia. Take Route F a distance of 1.5 miles to the end of the improvement. Proceed about 1.75 miles farther on Route F. The cemetery lies at the left side of the road, in heavy brush and weeds. A stone enclosure surrounds the Richardson grave and is easily seen from the road. Only two stones are standing. There are many field stones.

This cemetery was inventoried on 4 March 1972 by Carl Kelsay of Rocky Mount, Missouri and by Stephens Monroe Barnhouse and August F. Barnhouse of Eldon, Missouri.

This area is known as the Flatwoods Community where Harmon Kelsay owned and operated an orchard of considerable size. The graves are on land which was formerly a part of his orchard.

Only three headstones or grave markers are visible.

Harmon Kelsay Born 18 August 1850 Died 1 Jan 1903 "Father at Rest"

Nancy Kelsay Born 1855 Died 1928 (She was born Nancy Louise Swanson the 14 Feb 1855 and died in Kansas City, Missouri in the last part of November or the early part of December 1928 at the home of her daughter. Her remains were returned to the orchard farm for burial.)

Family rumor indicates that Arthur Kelsay and Clara Kelsay, both children of Harmon and Nancy Kelsay are buried here in unmarked graves. It is further rumored that a child of Roy "Roe" and Blanche (Vernon) Kelsay is buried here in an unmarked grave.

The above inscriptions were inventoried in the fall of 1968 by Carl G. Kelsay (a distant relative).
