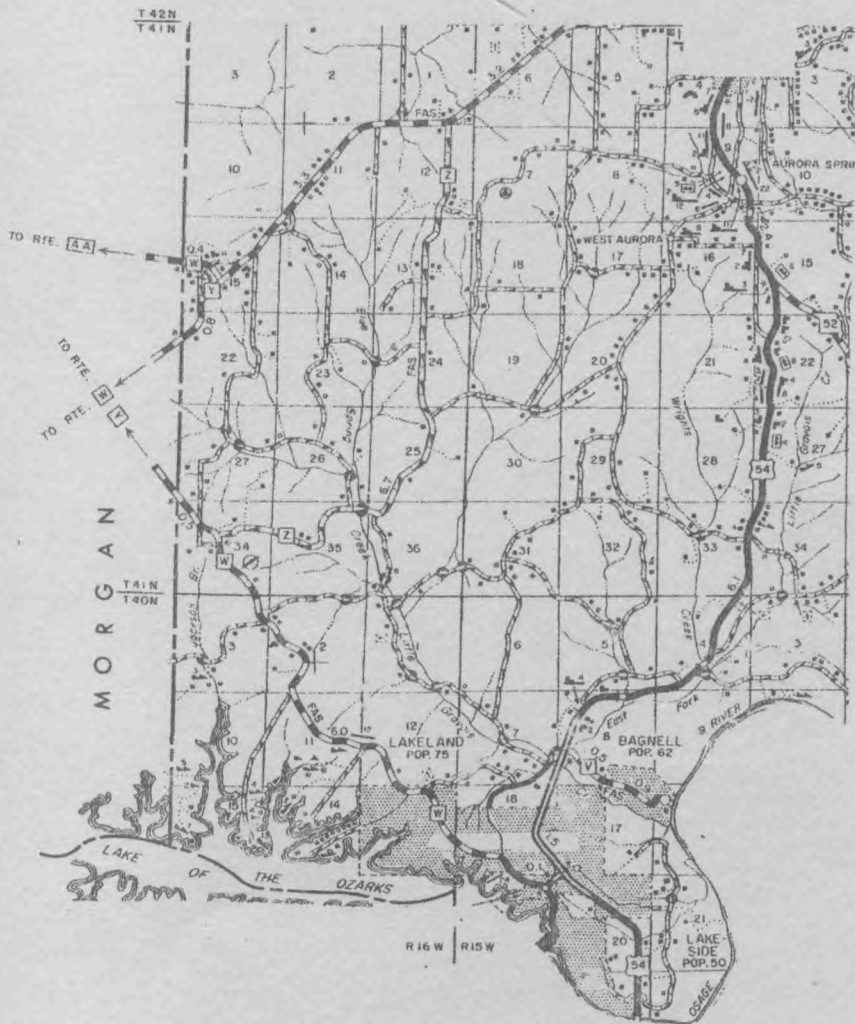

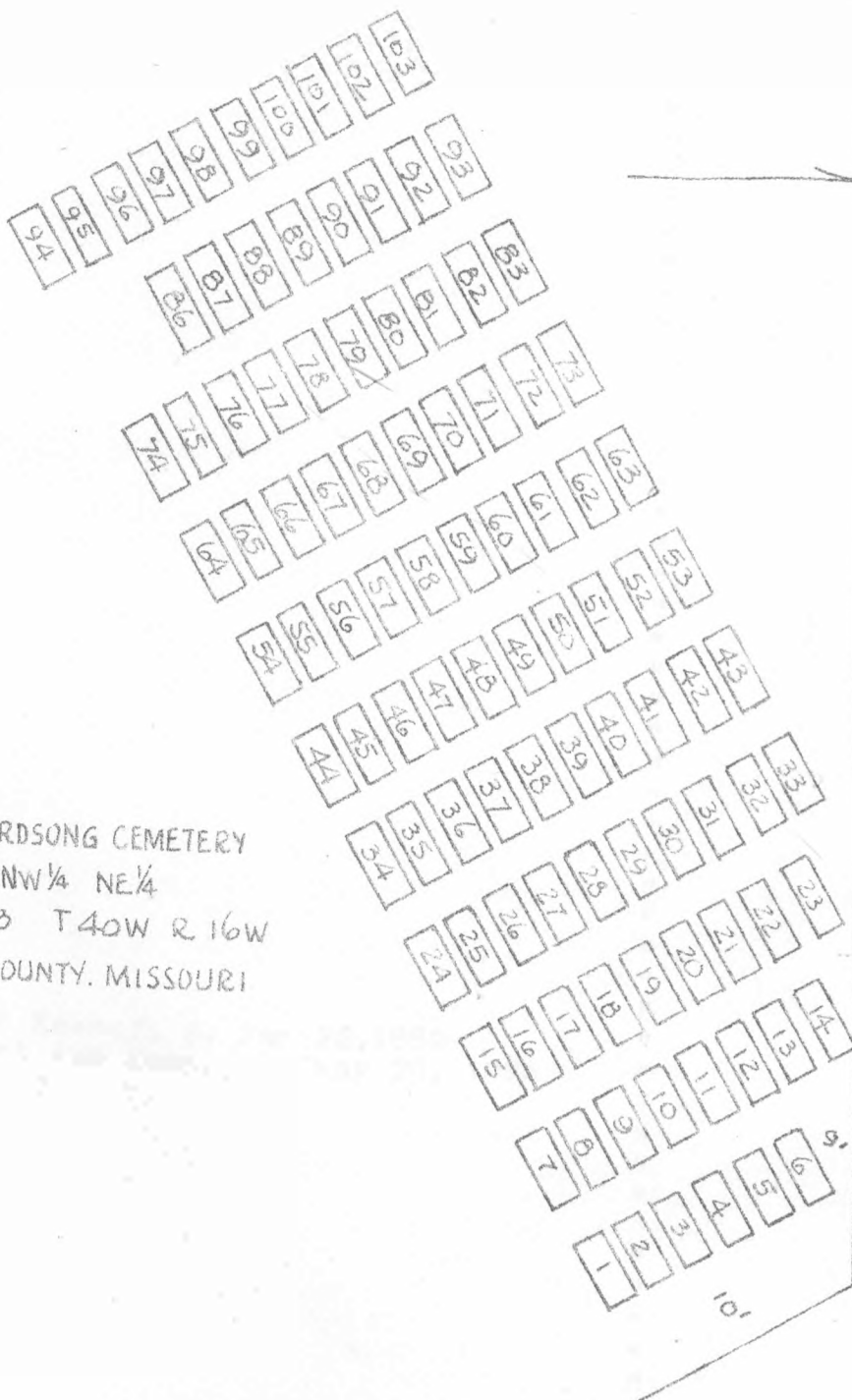

COTTEN, Benjamin Aged 86 years October 1786

DOOLEY CEMETERY

Section 12, Range 16 West, Township 41 North

Miller County, Missouri

This cemetery is located as follows: West from Eldon, Missouri, on Route Y approximately two miles to Route Z; thence left or south on Z to the first road to the left; thence easterly about one-fourth mile.

The cemetery is fenced, and well kept. There is evidence of many stones having been broken. Many of the stones show excellent craftsmanship.

This cemetery was inventoried on several afternoons in early December of 1971 by Stephens Monroe Barnhouse, August F. Barnhouse, and Carl Kelsay. Carl is from Rocky Mount, Missouri. This inventory was alphabetized, indexed, and typed by A. F. Barnhouse, Eldon, Mo.

TIPTON TIMES, January 28, 1892

"Halfway between Rocky Mount and Eldon, in Miller County", said a well known gentleman a few days since, "there once lived a remarkable character by the name of James Dooley."

I recently visited his old place and although the original owner had been dead a long time, there are yet many evidences of his eccentricities that are noticeable and many things that would interest the antiquarians.

Dooley was born in Virginia in 1760, came to this state in 1820, being 60 years old. He went to work cleaning up and making a home. The material in his house, which was all solid oak, would seem to be more appropriate for railroad bridge timbers than for a dwelling house in his day. For instance, the plates were 18" square; the corner posts the same size; the rafters 6" through at the small end; hewed of course. The floor was 2" thick, without a joint, every plank extending the full length of the room.

I was told that all his lumber was sawed out by a whip saw, and only those who have tried it know what labor this requires. A more singular fact about his house is that not a nail was used in its construction, it being put together with wooden pins.

In his back year he had three houses; or rather one house with three rooms, 16' square, one of which was for his saddle horse, one for his dogs, and one for his smokehouse.

This single character owned eight slaves, all women, and they did all the work of every character on the farm. He never worked horses, never owned a wagon. All hauling necessary being done by oxen and carts. Dooley was a man of remarkable physical strength and vigor and lived to the extreme age of 103, dying in 1863. Several years prior to his death, a friend in Tuscumbia, a marble cutter, told him that if he lived to be 100 years old, he would make his tombstone free of charge, and when the old man died, his promise was carried out and here the peculiar characteristics of the old man were remembered. Instead of the usual emblems seen on gravestones, his are ingraven shotgun, shot pouch and powder horn.

His wife and children are all dead but some of his grandchildren live in the eastern part of Miller County and are responsible people.

Between the age of 96 and 99 years, Dooley joined the Baptist Church and it is said that people went for 50 miles around to see him baptized.
