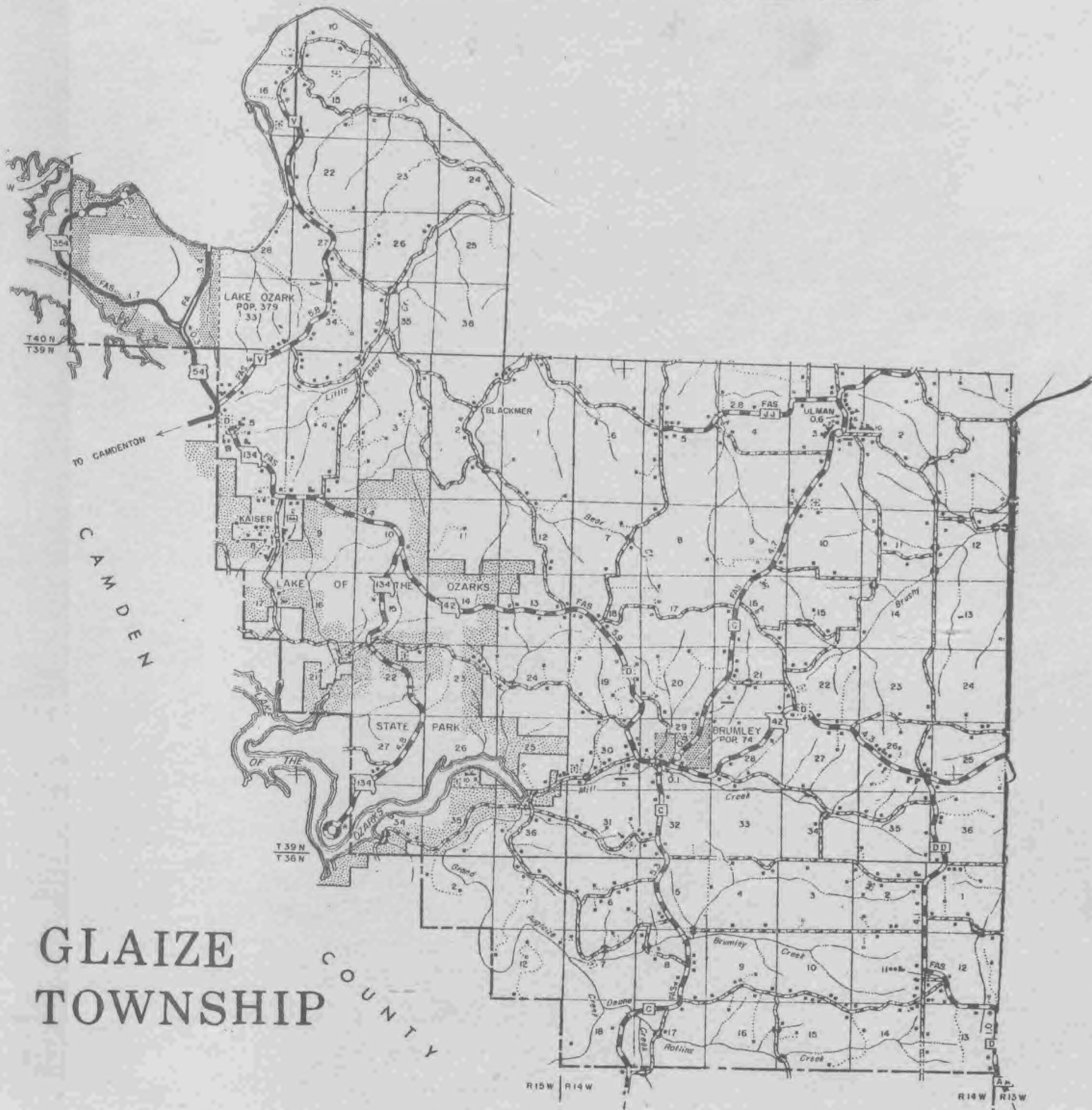

In October of 1971, Carl G. Kelsay of Rocky Mount, Missouri; Stephens M. Barnhouse (now serving in the United States Army); and August F. Barnhouse of Eldon, Missouri, completed the inventory of the headstones in one Miller County cemetery. In spite of cold-cramped fingers and chattering teeth, we three pledged to each other that we would inventory, alphabetize, index, specifically locate, and print inventories of every tombstone in every known cemetery that we could find in Miller County, Missouri.

We are now in our second year of this self-appointed task. During the one thousand plus man-hours we have expended on this task, we have been rained on, snowed on, sleeted on, and hailed on. We have been extremely cold and extremely hot during this, our labor of love. We have enjoyed working in well-kept cemeteries--and we have kept a wary eye out for copperheads in poorly kept ones.

There are a total of seven townships in Miller County. We have thus divided the 137 cemeteries (and over 400 pages of information) into seven books--each book containing one township. The combined seven books contain a listing of over 14,000 headstones. Only 64 cemeteries were already located for us on maps. With the help of many individuals, we have located an additional 73.

In each individual cemetery, surnames are alphabetized. The cemeteries in each township are placed in alphabetic order. The surnames are indexed for easy reference to specific cemeteries. We made every effort to determine the true name of each cemetery. Where diligent effort was to no avail, we named cemeteries by the name attached to the first burial therein or to the predominant families buried therein. Every effort was made to insure the accuracy of the names and dates copied from the headstones. Wire brushes and chalk were used, and return trips to cemeteries to re-check information was not uncommon. We herewith apologize for any mistakes made.

Some cemeteries had already been inventoried by Ilene Sims Yarnell of Versailles, Missouri and by Gwendolyn Gunn Shoemaker of Eldon, Missouri. These were copied and printed with notation made on individual cemeteries.

Carl G. Kelsay was a compiler and alphabetizer. August Barnhouse was compiler, typist and printer. During the long task, a warm and beautiful friendship has flowered.

As each of the seven townships are completed, a copy of that township's cemeteries and headstones is being presented to the Missouri State Historical Society for both use and preservation. The Society has its reference library at Lowry at Hitt Streets, Columbia, Mo.

This is our gift to the present--and to the future. We rejoice at its completion.

Glaize Township

Miller County, Missouri

This cemetery is located west of Brumley, Missouri. Going west on Missouri Highway 42, go past Route C to the first gravel road on the left. Go past the highway maintenance shed. Follow this road to the swinging bridge that crosses Mill Creek. Cross the second swinging bridge over the Grand Auglaize. Go west to the first gravel road to the right that leads to the Lacus Lodge Resort. Go down this road about one hundred yards. The single stone lies on the west side of the road about 15 to 20 feet from the roadside in heavy brush.

Mr. Clint Ash of Route 1, Brumley, Missouri, graciously took us to this site. We would not have found it without his assistance. The inventory was accomplished on 1 August 1972 by Carl G. Kelsay of Rocky Mount, Missouri; Stephens M. Barnhouse on leave from the U. S. Army, Fort Bragg, North Carolina; Mr. Clint Ash of Brumley, Missouri; and August F. Barnhouse of Eldon, Missouri.

Mr. Ash told us that Mr. Albertsons burial site was the site of his grape orchard.

This cemetery is located in Miller County, Missouri. It is situated on the west side of Missouri Highway 42, about 1/2 mile east of the intersection with Highway 10. The cemetery is fenced with steel posts and barbed wire. It is not well tended... difficult to reach. It is south and east of A. O. Thornsberry home and on his property. It is at the top of a high knoll. The single stone lies on the west side of the road about 15 to 20 feet from the roadside in heavy brush.

Miller County, Missouri

Toward Brumley on Highway 42 and 134, go past the intersection where 134 leads to the State Park. Take the first road to the left. Cross Bear Creek (about 1.6 miles). Approximately .8 mile, a cattle chute is on the right side of the road. You will see an iron gate at the side of the chute. Go through the gate and take the first road left which leads up a hill. The cemetery is easy to get to, is well kept and fenced.

This cemetery is easily reached and easily seen from the road. On State Highway 134, go past the Kaiser road to the first road leading left or north. The road jogs right and then left again. Go to the second road leading off to the right. Two mailboxes sit in a short Y in the road. Go right, then left. The cemetery is easily seen.

The cemetery is well fenced and well kept. There are many sites marked by rough field stones with no inscriptions....many with flowers.

This cemetery is located on the north side of the Grand Glaize arm of the Lake of the Ozarks within the Lake of the Ozarks State Park.

Take Highway 134 into the Lake of the Ozarks State Park. Go past the entrance of the Lee Fine Memorial Airport, to the OZARK HOMESTEAD RIDING STABLE. This cemetery is located on the main bridle path, about one to one and one-half mile from the Ozark Homestead Stable.

In our search for this cemetery, we inquired of Mr. Ed Depperman as to its location. Mr. Depperman provided us with horses and his two granddaughters, Sally and Dawn Depperman of 8807 Stark Street, Kansas City, Missouri graciously guided us to the cemetery.

A local historian tells us that on October 13, 1861, a rebel army camp on the Wet Auglaize was attacked by the Union Army. Sixty-two Confederates were killed, 57 captured. Later that same day, eight horses wandered into the yard of the George Wright farm, each horse bearing the body of a soldier with hands and feet tied. The compassionate native gave the slain soldiers this resting place in this tiny cemetery on Mill Creek.

Neglected and forgotten for many years, the plot has been restored and the graves marked through the efforts of the Missouri Historical Society and the State Park Commission.

Inventoried this 24 June 1972 by Carl G. Kelsay of Rocky Mount, Mo.; Lynn Lupardus of Eldon, Missouri; and August F. Barnhouse of Eldon Missouri with Sally and Dawn Depperman.

This tiny cemetery is fenced with a rail fence on the side near the bridle path and is unfenced on the other three sides.
