This church is often referred to as the "Nolting" church, because a large number of its members were of that surname. Judge Herman Nolting resides near this church.

Services were discontinued here, several years ago. However the cemetery is kept mowed, and a strong fence and nice gate protect this burial spot.

North of Versailles, is the D highway, On D, turn west at the old Bethel rural School, and go west--- that is the way to go.

CUMBERLAND PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH CEMETERY  
OTTERVILLE, MO.

This cemetery is in Cooper County, Mo.  
The Bowling Green Congregation of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church, was organized Sept. 23, 1821.

In the year 1836, the place of holding camp meetings was changed to what was called, by consent, Pleasant Grove. The name of the congregation was also changed from Bowling Green to Pleasant Grove. Here, the Cumberland Presbyterians erected the first church of the community. It was of logs and stood near the old graveyard. It was built around 1836. For many years the Cumberland Presbyterians annually held their old fashioned camp meetings here, at which large numbers of the citizens were wont to congregate and here many of them would remain for days, or weeks, on the ground in camps and tents, engaged in earnest devotion.

On April 6, 1857 the name of the congregation was changed from Pleasant Grove to Otterville. The town of Otterville was incorporated by an act of the Legislature of Mo. on the 16th of Feb. 1857. This same year, 1857, the Cumberland Presbyterians, erected the first church in the town of Otterville. It was built by Milton Starke.

This cemetery is near the Wm. H. McKnight,  
Otterville, Mo. farm in Cooper Co. Mo. This  
cemetery is located Northwest of, and in view  
of the Otterville Mo. School.

I was told that there were some slaves buried in this cemetery. This cemetery is fenced, has grown up in weeds and trees, and is neglected. Burials in this area at present are made in the newer Odd Fellow Cemetery, north of Otterville, Mo. Cooper County.

I had been to Otterville, Mo. several times, but this is the first time I had heard of this cemetery.

I do not know if the plat of this cemetery is in existence or not; but it would be of great benefit, as there were many sunken graves marked only by a rock with no identification. I copied all markers that I could find in the dense brush and weeds.
