Genealogy

Morgan and Moniteau Historical Societies as well as the Niangua Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution have lost a devoted worker. Omega Charles Hutchison died Saturday, September 7, at the Charles E. Still Hospital in Jefferson City. She was born Jan. 22, 1911 near Fortuna in Moniteau County, the daughter of the late Samuel W. and Alpha Newkirk Charles.

She married the late Preston N. Hutchison on July 4, 1933. He preceded her in death on March 21, 1976.

During a visit to Ilene Yarnell, about twenty years ago, she mentioned her interest in family history. This was the start of partnership in touring the county to copy tombstone inscriptions. She started to collect family history by bits and pieces. Her greatest pleasure was visiting older family members and their friends to get

this information first hand. Many pictures of family members were copied as well as church and school pictures that were put in the books she was to write. Omega wrote two books, The Newkirk Book and The Hutchison Book and had almost completed The Wright Book before her death.

In the fall of 1984 she received honorable mention for her book about The Hutchison Family. This event was held by the Heart of America Genealogical Society in the Missouri Valley Room of the Kansas City Public Library. This is an annual event and a very great honor as many books are entered from all over the United States. There is no doubt that these books will be invaluable to the later generations in the coming years.

Naomi Woods, Omega's niece, helped her get her books in print. She typed the stencils and Omega would turn the printer, she had

put up in her bedroom, to copy the pages for her books. Many hours were spent in turning this old printer by hand.

Omega was a charter member of both the Morgan and Moniteau Historical Societies and with her great friend Sarah Nelson spent many an hour in the Morgan County Museum arranging the antiques donated by the people of the county to be put on display. She met many people who came by searching for family history and was always ready to help in any way she could. She answered many letters from people in need of help locating ancestors who had passed through Missouri. Omega, with her friendly help and ready smile will indeed be missed by those who had the pleasure of meeting her as well as those in the coming years who will find help in the books she wrote.

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Omega Charles Hutchison

Omega Charles Hutchison, 74, Versailles, died Saturday evening, Sept. 7, at Charles E. Still Osteopathic Hospital in Jefferson City. She was born Jan. 22, 1911 near Fortuna in Moniteau County, the daughter of the late Samuel W. and Alpha Nadine Newkirk Charles.

She married the late Preston N. Hutchison on July 4, 1933. He preceded her in death on March 21, 1976.

Mrs. Hutchison was very active in genealogical work, and was supervisor of the Morgan County Historical Society in Versailles for several years. She was a charter member of both the Morgan County Historical Society and the Moniteau County Historical Society. She was a member of the Niangua Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, and the United Methodist Church of Versailles. She joined the Fortuna Methodist Church on Oct. 18, 1925.



The Harrisons Honor Soldiers' Graves Here

Mr. and Mrs. Don Harrison, members of the Morgan County Post 104 of the American Legion and Auxiliary, have carried the responsibility of placing small flags on the graves of the fallen heroes of all wars in the Versailles cemetery each Memorial Day for the past twenty-five years.

The custom of placing flags on the graves of soldiers was started here at the close of World War I by the late W. T. (Turner)

Kidwell, who carried the mail on a rural route, stopping at cemeteries on his route to place flags on the graves of veterans of the war in which he also served. Mr. Kidwell died in 1939.

In 1940 Mrs. Harrison and a group of ten Junior Auxiliary girls took over the task of placing flags on the graves of veterans in the local cemetery. Their daughter, Beth, was one of the members of the group. At the end of four or five years, after the girls had graduated from high school and gone away to college, Mrs. Harrison assumed this responsibility with the help of her husband and others who offered their assistance.

This year the Harrisons, with the aid of their daughter, Mrs. Beth Love and her three children, of Warrensburg, placed some 150 flags on the graves of service men in the Versailles cemetery.

For a time the Harrisons attempted to place flags on the graves of the Civil War soldiers but, not having the information as to whether they were Union or Confederate soldiers, discontinued placing the flags. Now they provide the flags, which are called for by members of the families of departed Civil War soldiers. The late Leroy (Pete) Sullens started placing flags on the graves of the Spanish-American War veterans.

Mrs. Harrison was commended and presented a citation of appreciation by the American Legion Post at services at the local cemetery on Memorial Day.

The flags are left on the graves for about a week, after which they are removed and put away. This is done because the flags become faded and tattered and often blown on to the ground.

A talk made by Mrs. Ben F. Goodman at the Morgan County Historical Society on May 22, 1967. This meeting was the first one in our new quarters in the 'Martin Hotel', recently purchased by the Historical Society.

The original cemetery was laid out between 1835 and 1840, took in only the area west of the main driveway and extended westward to the hedge (then a wire fence). For many years a woven wire fence surrounded the old cemetery, and a wrought iron gate across the North entrance. This kept out the livestock, which was allowed to roam at will over the town.

The older residents remember when it was sadly neglected and the weeds and grass were allowed to grow waist high all over the cemetery. I remember when I was a young girl, my mother and I would walk out to the cemetery a few days before Decoration Day, and take a rake, a grass scythe, or reap hook and push a lawn mower across town, take a sack lunch and spend the day cutting grass and cleaning off our lot, and perhaps some friends too. My mother passed away in April 1907, and the horse drawn hearse stopped in the main dirt driveway, and the casket was carried to the grave, which was nearly to the West side of the cemetery, and at that time the weeds were so high they scraped the bottom of the casket.

The first addition to the original cemetery, was the section to the East of the main road, extending eastward to the dirt drive as the second drive was called in the early days.

Mrs. Mary Gibbs was the first to be interred in this addition in 1901.

The second addition, was the area South of the site of the old tool house and the section just East of the dirt drive, extending eastward to the Farris lot.

The section East & South of the old Cemetery was the Third Addition.

In 1939 the New Oak Park Addition, the western part & the area to the South was laid out by Clyde Henderson and Gene Bartram.

The first grave in this section was that of Mrs. Elizabeth K. Huffman. Then the grounds were extended as far west as the cemetery land laid, and

a new road built from north to south along the western border. The cemetery then had grown at an alarming rate, in the past 25 Yrs., leaving a limited amount of land yet to be laid out into lots. Tentative plans were to develop the rolling land in the extreme Eastern part of the cemetery when the need arose. In contrast to the old days when people purchased cemetery lots only, when a death occurred in the family, many people today have purchased choice lots in advance of need and some have had monuments erected on these lots.

Some City people who, after visiting it and observing its well kept condition, expressed a desire to be buried here. Many times, through the years, civic minded citizens attempted to form an organization which would be responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of the City Cemetery.

The first Cemetery Association was organized in April 1906. At this time the Directors were: D. C. Hardy Jr., Paul Spurlock, J. A. Petty, J. B. Lumpee, Chas. E. Willson & H. K. Enloe. Mr. Hardy was president, and Mr. Enloe was Secretary. Meetings of the association were held only once a year, on the first Wednesday evening in April, in the Courthouse. Dues were \$1.00 per year and donations were few, so it was impossible to protect, preserve, and beautify the cemetery, as the bylaws stipulated.

For many years the families of the dead took care of their own lots and graves and the rest of the cemetery was left to grow up in weeds, making it impossible during the summer to locate many of the graves. Lack of funds made it impossible to carry on any organized maintenance work and it was not until 1927 that a cemetery association was organized, which actually made progress toward perpetual care for the silent city of the dead.

The official board of this cemetery association was composed of: Mrs. Lucy Browne, Mrs. W. A. Buell, Mrs. L. L. Barbour, Mrs. B. F. Goodman, Mrs. J. A. Petty, Mrs. C. E. Willson, Mrs. F. G. Woods, Mrs. F. A. White, Mrs. F. C. Thorpe, Mr. W. B. Todd, A. G. Baker, B. L. Rickard, John M. Earp, W. S. Washburn, C. H. Long, and Mrs. George Bohling.

One of the first things done by this association was the removal of the wire fence encloser and graveling of the main driveway. There were 43 loads of gravel, donated for the driveways to put them in shape. The foot stones

were removed from the mounded graves so the mowers could do better work in mowing. In 1928 local people were urged to donate work toward the upkeep of the cemetery, but although many people were unemployed at that time, work without pay had no intrigue and it was left undone.

In 1928, Walter Crafton, Walter Ross, and Sid Sousley were hired to keep the cemetery grounds clean, with Mrs. J. A. Petty, and Mrs. Lucy Browne as overseers. These dedicated ladies spent many days in the cemetery seeing that the work was done as it should be. Mr. Crafton was hired as Chief Caretaker at a salary of \$50.00 per month. Lawn mowers were purchased at the Joachimi store for \$12.67 and from Curtis Store for \$10.70., according to old records. At first the caretaker had the responsibility of opening the graves, but later the association appointed Wm. F. Kidwell, the undertaker, to have charge of opening the graves and removing the rock and dirt from excavations.

In 1930 the Cemetery Association voted against allowing any more concrete curbing to be placed around lots or graves. An old drilled well, which stood midway on the main drive, furnished water for watering flowers and for drinking water; although many people would not drink it, fearing contamination. Water hydrants replaced this old landmark of the early 1920's.

< The late Mrs. A. J. Gunn served as president of the cemetery association from 1932 until her death in 1951. A pine tree grows in her memory in the west part of the cemetery, planted by the cemetery association.

The old tile tool house, which stood at the South end of the original Cemetery, was torn down in the summer of 1959, and two new Memorial Buildings, one of which is a tool house, were erected in the Oak Park addition. These buildings constructed of Camdenton stone, are an attraction to the Cemetery. The building to the East, which contains, rest room facilities and maintenance equipment storage, was given by the cemetery association. The one to the West was erected through the donations of friends of the late Wm. F. Kidwell. The names of the honored war dead of World War, I & II, and the Korean Conflict, are inscribed on Marble Tablets on the inside walls of both buildings. On the West wall of the West buildings is a granite slab inscribed to the memory of Mr. Kidwell, who was untiring in his efforts in behalf of the cemetery and who, at his death, left a share of the Kidwell Funeral Home, to the Cemetery Association.

There are 2 charter members still active members, those are: Mrs. C. E. Willson and Mrs. Ben. F. Goodman.

The board seeing that our grave spaces were very few, thought it advisable to buy more ground for the future, so a tract of land, west of our present cemetery was bought from Carol Ayers. Water lines have been laid, a hedge fence is growing nicely, many trees planted, and it, too, is beginning to show much care.

I, for one, hold the interest of the cemetery very dear to my heart.

The Cemetery Association buys, from time to time, equipment of power mowers, hedge trimmers, edge trimmers, and any necessary machines to make it easier to keep the beautiful cemetery neatly trimmed.

The perpetual care of the cemetery is made possible only through the donations of the towns people and non-resident families of those buried in the cemetery. The caretakers are to be commended for the excellent job they do.

Members of the executive board of the then, cemetery association were: Mrs. C. E. Willson, president, Mrs. Roy Otten, Vice Pres., Mrs. August Heineman, Secretary; and Ira Wilson, Treasurer. Charter members still serving on the board at that time; were -- Mrs. B. F. Goodman, Mrs. C. E. Willson, Mrs. George Bohling (honorary) and B. L. Rickard.

The price of a grave space in the early days of the cemetery was \$3.75 for each grave space.

In former years, Memorial Day observances were conducted in a small way, by organizations, such as the G.A.R., who honored only the war dead, making the rounds of the cemeteries in this part of the county, holding brief services.

For several years now, the American Legion Post IO4, The Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, and the High School Band, march, in order to the cemetery and conduct Memorial Day services.

Through the years we go to the cemetery to pay tribute to the honored war dead, with eulagy and militant music, and place flowers in loving memory on the graves of those members of our families whom we have loved long since, and lost awhile; let us compare the beautiful decorated and well kept cemetery of today with the unsightly place it used to be, and contribute generously to the volunteer solicitors for the continued up keep of our cemetery.

Today it is, "The Vepsailles Cemetery Association Incorporated" and the present officers and board members, number 20 active & 1 inactive member. Mrs. C. E. This cemetery, the largest in Morgan County, consists of 3 parts the first of which is known as the original section and adjacent thereto, on the West, is the second addition known as the Oak Lawn portion while a third portion is located West of and adjacent to the Oak Lawn portion and is known as the Fire Clay addition.

More than 36 man hours was required to take the field notes of the inventory. The cemetery is located at the Southern Edge of the City of Versailles and South Monroe Street terminates at one of the several entrances to the cemetery. This inventory was made by, Ilene Sims Yarnell, Omega Hutchison and the late Rose Moness in the year 1969.
