Col. 3 "Old Settlers--A number of Them in Jackson Township. We are indebted to Cooper Gooden for the following sketch of old settlers of Jackson Township: Allen Rhodes was born in Ohio, December, 1828. He has lived here thirty-seven years. He owns 287 acres of land, but is a retired farmer--a Democrat in politics.

Benton Smith was born in Indiana, February 27, 1841. He came to Missouri in 1845, and to this county 51 years ago. He owns 415 acres of land. Democrat in politics.

Lyman Hunt was born in New York in 1827. He came to this county 37 years ago. He recently sold most of his land, but owns forty acres yet. He is a retired farmer--Republican in politics.

Capt. A. B. Bentley was born in Brookfield, Ohio, December 26, 1822 and moved to Iowa in 1853, and from there to Missouri in 1857. He has resided in Jackson Township thirty-one years. Owns 80 acres of land. He was a law partner of Judge Lafe Dawson at one time. He is a Democrat in politics.

Peter Hawk was born in Virginia in 1827, lived in Indiana nineteen years, and in Illinois one year, and here forty-three years. He owns 552 acres of land and considerable Ravenwood property. He is a retired farmer. Republican in politics.

Adelma Stingley was born in Ohio, April 29, 1823. Came to this state fifty-three years ago, and has lived in Nodaway County 42 years. He owns 280 acres. Is a retired farmer--Democrat in politics. It is said that he never voted for anyone not a Democrat but once, and that was a justice of the peace.

Moses Spier was born in Ohio, May 4, 1834, and is 63 years old. He came to Jackson Township in 1855, and settled on the farm he now lives on. Part of Ravenwood was built on his farm. He owns now 162 acres. He is a Republican.

Said Mr. Gooden to a Democrat reporter: 'I came from Delaware to this county in 1864, and settled in Jackson Township. At that time I never expected to live to see our prairies settled up. When we look around for those early pioneers who wrought many of these changes and blazed the way for those that came after them, we find them few and far between, and those few will soon have rounded out their allotted time, with ripe and honorable old age, and then the old landmarks will all have been moved away. Time is hastening on and we are hastening with it. Sometimes we rise with the billows; sometimes in the trough of the sea of time; but too soon the tide recedes and we are stranded on the shores of perhaps forgetfulness.'"

Col. 3 "An Honored Old Settler. John Stundon was in town Saturday and spent a few moments in our sanctum. We found out in conversation with him, that he is in his 78th year. He came to this country in 1845, and came to Nodaway County in 1867, settling in the same vicinity, in Grant township, where he now lives, where he owns a good farm. Mr. Stundon, in 1849, crossed the plains with the Fremont party to California. He was gone about two years, but it took about three-fourths of that time to go and come. They used mule teams. Now the trip can be made in three or four days by railroad. A great change in mode of traveling. Mr. Stundon is very vigorous for a man of his years, and the Democrat hopes he may live long yet and ever be prosperous and happy."

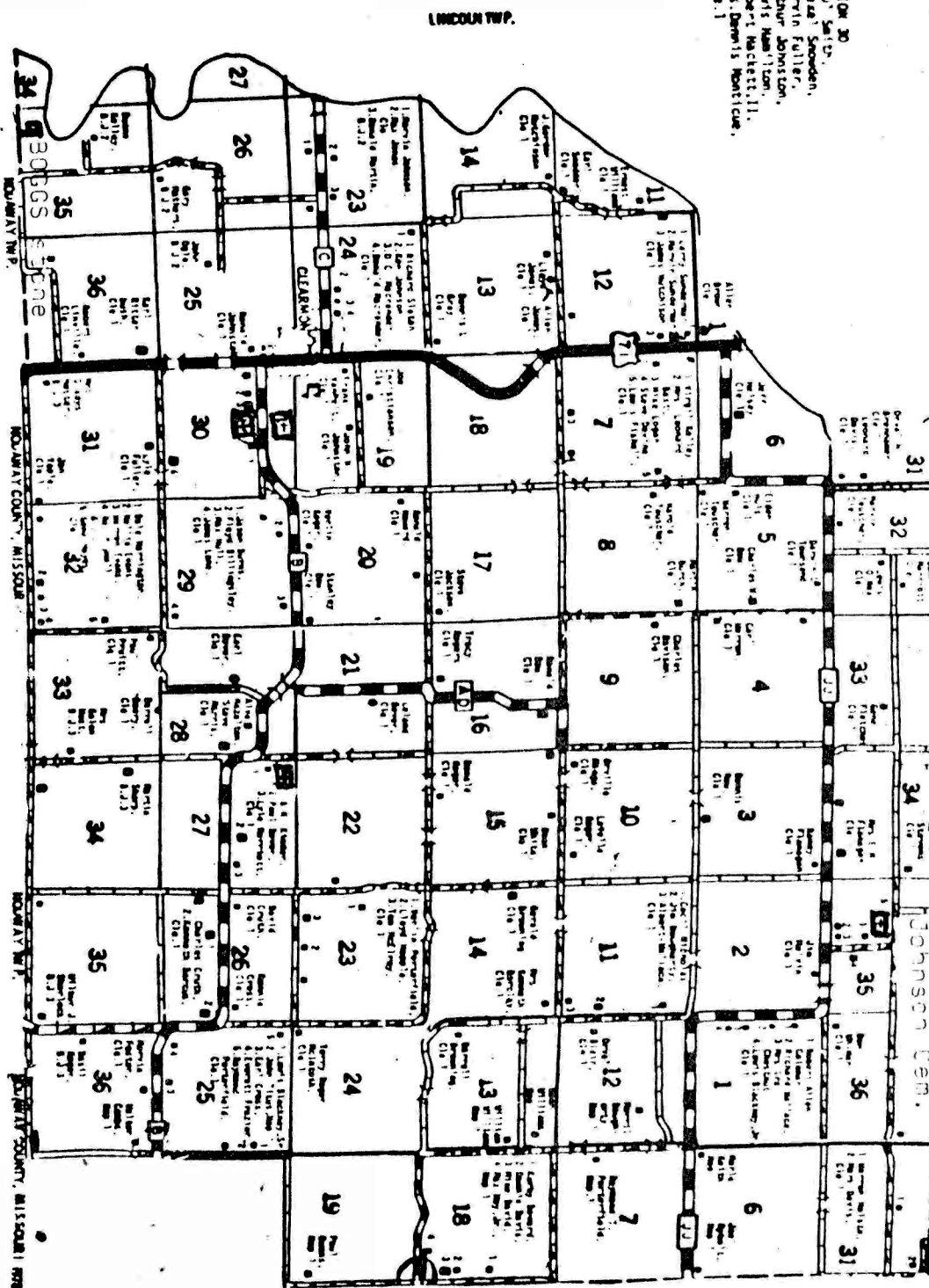
