

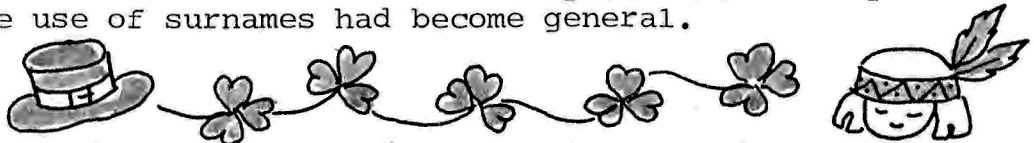

Now is the time to go "rooting" in old cemeteries, before the weeds and snakes take over. Looking forward to Memorial Day, when visiting cemeteries, do plan to record information - written or by camera. Be sure to take all vital information needed with you. Most cemeteries will be in their best shape for that day. If you have relatives living near ancestor's graves, write early and ask them to copy or photograph information for you. On any trip, take information on any branch of your family tree that might possibly have connections in the areas through which you will be traveling.

"Quitman's Original Masons. Quitman Lodge, No. 196 A.F. & A.M. was organized June 14, 1860. The following were the officers elected: Samuel T. Kennedy, W.M.; T. J. McQuiddy, S.W.; Samuel Noffsinger, J.W.; Wm. R. Holt, Treasurer; Martin Hayden, Secretary; Samuel F. Guthrie, S.D.; W. O. Smith, J.D.; William H. Griffith, Steward; N. B. Moore, Tyler.

Visiting brethren present from other lodges at that meeting were: From Maryville Lodge No. 165, H. S. Marble, B. F. Rols, H. McKensie, J. H. and L. J. Hedgepeth, N. L. Bickett, C. L. Cane. From Blandinsville, Ill., Lodge No. 22, A. M. Coston, John Grandany. Round Prairie, MO., Lodge No. 138, S. D. Ren, Rising Sun, MO. Lodge No. 13, J. A. Aljoe. Confidence, Kentucky, Lodge No. 52, E. J. Ross.

Different lodges from this parent lodge are: Lamar Station, Skidmore, Burlington Jct., and Clearmont.

Sam Kennedy served five terms as W.M. from 1860 to 1866, and never missed a meeting.

Their first lodge room was the second story of the corner brick building which burned last fall.

The first death was F. M. Carpenter and the last was the late W. H. Holt who died May 16, 1896.

In the early days of the Quitman lodge, there was need of active and prompt members. The record of Judge Kennedy's attendance shows how well this want was filled. The lodge moved into its present commodious and pleasant quarters over the bank in September, 1897. Among the oldest members are D. G. Porter, J. W. Weddle, Sr., and Wm. Kraft--Quitman Record."

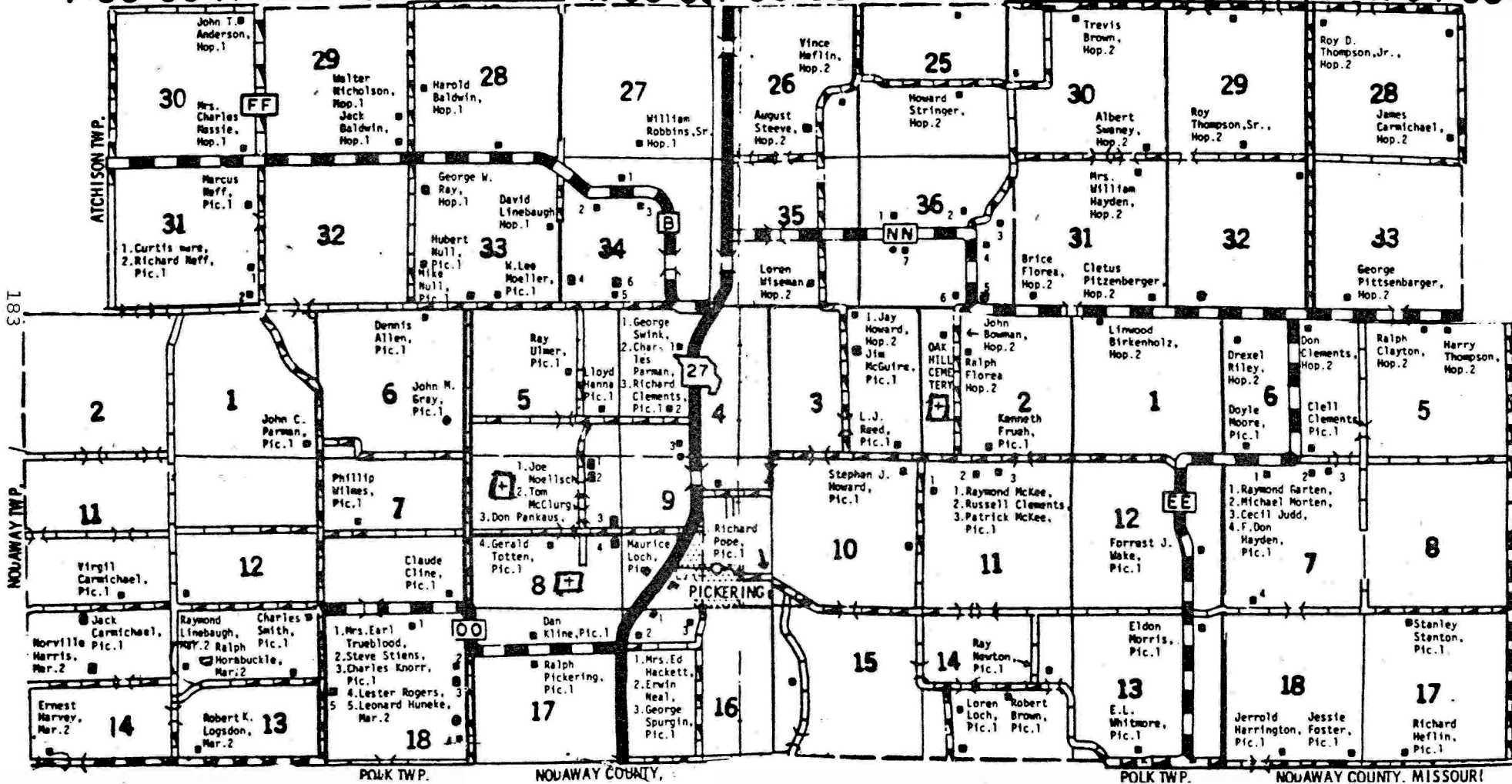
