From will of James A. R. ADKINS:

. . . I give, devise and bequeth to my nephew, William Shepherd, all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real and personal to be by him owned absolutely. I hereby stating that I have no child or children or descendants of a child or children living to inherit my property and being thus childless I do hereby constitute my said nephew William Shepherd my sole heir to receive my estate real and personal after the payments of my debts as before provided for . . . .

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Items from the February 28, 1883 issue of the Maryville Times:

D. P. Wallingford, an old citizen of the Platte Purchase, having filled several offices of honor and trust in Platte county, died at his home in St. Joseph last Thursday.

Miss Mollie McPecker closed her school at the Blackman school house last week with an exhibition that was a credit to both pupils and teacher.

FOUND! two 1867 Nodaway County deeds in an old desk. Anyone interested in either document may have it by mentioning one of the names on the document desired and by sending a large SASE to Nodaway County Genealogical Society, Box 412, Maryville, MO 64468.

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Dated 20 May 1867 a General Warranty Deed in Nodaway County, MO. from M.R. Chauiness and C. J. Chauiness, his wife (Clarinda J.) parties of First Part and McMillan & Davis parties of second part. North half of certain block in the town of Maryville bound as follows: On the East by Vine Street on the South by 6th Street on the West by Market and on the North by Seventh Street.

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Dated 4th of March 1867 a Deed in Nodaway County, MO. from John Chandler & wife (Mary) to William Manela of Nodaway County, Mo. Lots 2 & 3 in Block No. 24 of the town of Guilford in Nodaway Co., Mo. (Fee paid by Wm. Swinford)

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Have you ever wondered about the system of measurements used by the early surveyors? Perhaps the following explanation will be of help.

The basis of measurement used by the early surveyors was the Gunther chain invented by Edmund Gunther in 1620. Gunther's chain was 66 ft. long, consisting of 100 links of 7 92/100 inches each. It was made of #6 or #9 wire.

Our rod is 16 1/2 ft. or 1/4 of a chain. A mile is 80 chains. An acre is 10 sq. chains or 43,560 sq. ft. The rod was also known as a pole. Streets were laid out one chain wide.

The old linear measure, often called the surveyors' measure was;

7 92/100 inches	make 1 LINE
25 links	make 1 POLE
100 links, 4 poles (or 66 feet)	make 1 CHAIN
10 chains	make 1 FURLONG
8 furlongs or 80 chains	make 1 MILE

One will find on land grants the names of the CHAIN carriers. Male chain carriers must have been 14 yrs. old or older, and usually were sons or brothers of the grantee. If there were no males of that age the chain carrier was possibly a member of the wife's family. (Jan. 86 CCGS News).

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Item from the Feb. 28, 1883 issue of the Maryville Times:

--The year 1883 has so far been a year unequalled in the annals of history for great disasters, both on land and sea. And now right in the face of all the suffering from the severe storms of a hard winter, untold agonies that have been produced from numerous holacusts, and the terrible loss of life on the high seas, Gentry county comes to the front with another new town, called Garfield. That progressive paper, the Albany Ledger, stopped the press last week to announce this item of news to its readers.

--Prof. Proctor says a comet will go whizzing through the air sometime in the spring which will heat us all up. That comet would have been appreciated if it had whizzed through the air a few weeks ago.

--One hundred worsted suits at Nusbaum's, from \$10 to \$25.

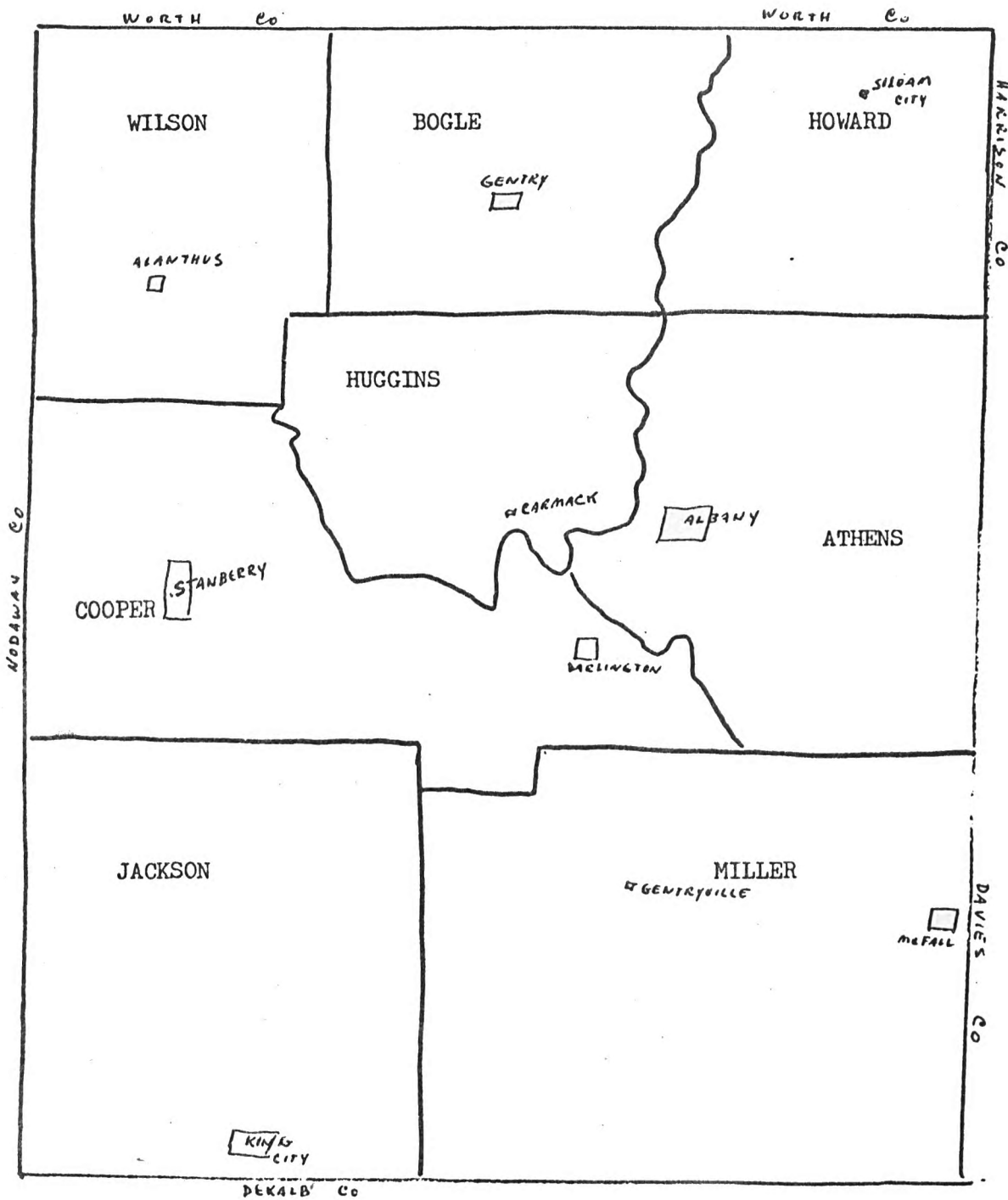
