News paper will deteriorate if not treated with preservatives, the following ingredients combine to form an alkaline formula that combats the natural acidity of newsprint and ink:

Mix two milk of magnesia tablets (or one ounce of liquid) with a quart of club soda. Use a large container because mixture will foam. Allow the mixture to stand overnight for better results. Pour mixture into a large flat pan, such as a jelly-roll pan. Lay each clipping or section individually in the pan, allowing to soak at least 30 minutes. To dry, cover a flat stack of several pages of newspaper with paper towels or clean absorbent rags. Allow to dry in flat position. When dry, seal or wrap in plastic to store, protected from light.

ITEMS FROM 1908 HOPKINS JOURNALS:

- Country residence of Jacob SHEARER destroyed by fire Feb. 1 ...
- Mrs. Nancy McFARLAND, wife of Samuel McFARLAND, died Mar. 30.  
The McFarlands arrived at Old Xenia Sept. 11, 1861, moving to Hopkins soon afterwards. Mr. McFarland died Dec. 24, 1900 . . .
- At a double wedding May 5, Sam HAVENER and Miss Laura STRINGER, and Bert WARREN and Miss Ethel STRINGER were united in marriage . . . Charlie STRINGER and Miss Maude HOPPLE wed April 25 . .
- 1908 grads of HHS were Glen C. SHINABARGAR, Frances Edna BROWN, George Ralph HARMAN, and Bessie Pearl CRAVEN . . .
- J. A. AIKEN supervised work on the new Christian Church edifice. While construction work was underway, services were held in building south of Bank of Hopkins. Corner stone for new church was laid Thursday, August 27. Address was given by Elder CHILTON of St. Joseph and the stone was donated by C. L. VAN NORTRAND of Bedford . . .
- City bought new cemetery that adjoined Hopkins cemetery on the north and combined the two. In August an ordinance was passed creating an improvement fund for Hopkins cemetery. One half the proceeds of the sale of each lot was put in fund and interest on the fund so created used for perpetual care. . .
- Olin PISTOLE bought the Jess LEE 40-acre farm four miles south of town in August . . .
- Dr. LARGE reported daughters in the homes of Mr. and Mrs. Joe ANDREWS and Mr. and Mrs. Loren GILLESPIE . . .
- Harvey MOREHOUSE, who settled on a farm near what was to become Hopkins in 1859, died Nov. 21 . . .
- Four members of the SPARKS family, including an infant baby, were quarantined with diphtheria in December . . .
- Al BURCH leased his livery barn to Ira GRAY Dec. 1. Mr. Gray had recently moved here from Clearmont.

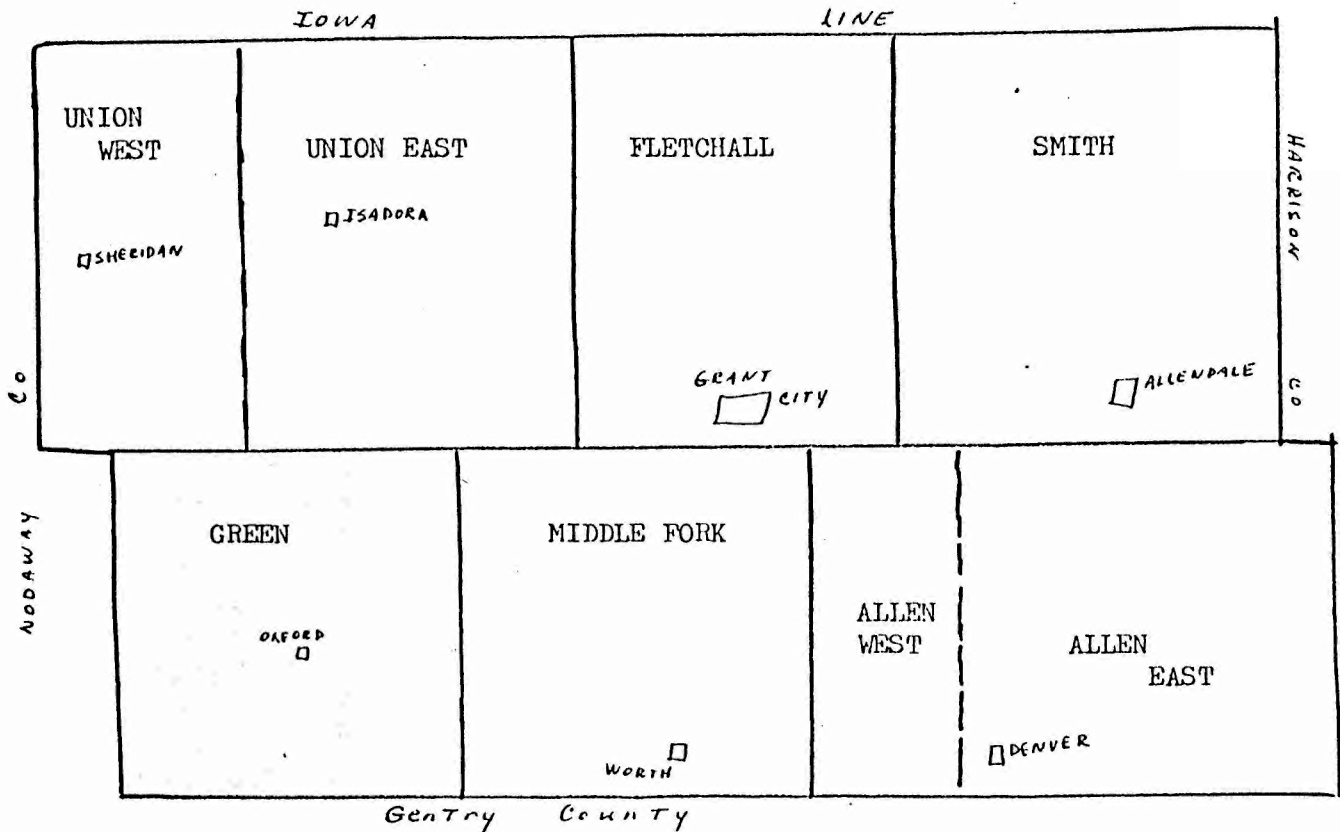
