OBITUARY OF HARVEY MOREHOUSE (condensed)

While in his feedlot last Friday, Harvey Morehouse, one of our best known farmers, was stricken with paralysis and died the following day (Nov. 21, 1908).

The funeral was conducted at the family residence on Tuesday by Rev. Wood, of Hopkins, and burial took place in the Hopkins cemetery.

James Harvey Morehouse was born July 28, 1831, in Morrow county, Ohio. He was married to Adeline Wood, Dec. 31, 1855, and came to Nodaway Co., Mo., in the following year. To this union were born eight children, 4 boys and 4 girls. He united with the Christian church 13 years ago.

He was stricken with paralysis on Friday the 20th instant and died at 11:05 p. m. Saturday, being 77 years, 3 months and 23 days old. He leaves wife, six children and one sister of Ohio to mourn his loss. Two of the daughters, Mrs. Lina Butts, and Mrs. Allie Ann Cox, passed to the great beyond several years ago. The surviving children, were summoned by wire and all but two, Mrs. Effie Edwards, Oklahoma, and Mrs. Lily White, Washington, were able to be present at the funeral. Charles coming from Tyrone, Ok., Bert from Foreston, Minn., Timothy, who resides near his father's home and Leman who lives on the old homestead with his parents and has most tenderly cared for them during declining years.

He emigrated from Ohio 50 years ago in company with Wm. Morehouse, Smith Morehouse, John Worth, Sam Lower, and Luther Riley, braving the perils and privations of pioneer life. Mr. Morehouse and his most estimable wife have resided on the farm, which they purchased from the government for \$1.30 per acre, and for a half century have nobly contributed to the development and building up of the neighborhood.

OBITUARY OF ADALINE WOOD MOREHOUSE (condensed)

Adaline Tamer Wood was born near Buffalo, N. Y., March 17, 1831, and died Jan. 18, 1915, at her home five miles southwest of Hopkins, Mo., being 83 years, 10 months and 1 day old.

She moved with her parents to Morrow county, Ohio, while yet a child, but returned to New York when about 16 and lived with her grandparents about seven years and during this time her education was finished. Then she returned to her parental home in Ohio and taught school two years.

Dec. 31, 1855, she married Harvey Morehouse of Morrow county, Ohio. In 1858, they moved to a farm in Nodaway Co., Mo. To this union were born four sons and four daughters. Two daughters passed away several years ago. The other children living are: Mrs. Lillie White, Washington; Charley, Tyrone, Okla.; Bert, Foreston, Minn.; Mrs. Joe Edwards, Watonga, Okla.; Tim and Leman, near Hopkins. She has 22 grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Morehouse's husband died Nov. 21, 1908, and left her in the care of her youngest son, Leman, and his most estimable wife who have so lovingly and tenderly administered to all her wants in her declining years. She was a member of the M. E. church until 1893, when she united with the Church of Christ with her husband at Highland.

The funeral was conducted in her home by her pastor, Rev. W. R. Brown. The remains were laid to rest in the Hopkins cemetery.
