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ITEMS FROM THE MARYVILLE TIMES - Feb. 28, 1883:

COUNTY COURT

County Court met pursuant to adjournment Monday, Feb. 26th, 1883. Judges, clerk, and sheriff all present.

Following is the proceedings:

- Kinney and Coleman allowed \$378, balance due for building three bridges on McKee road in Atchison township.
  - S. M. Cady allowed \$11.25 for wood for paupers.
  - J. F. Burk allowed \$10.00 for medicines for paupers.
  - Armstrong & Feurst allowed \$15.00 for coal and wood for jail.
  - J. B. Kildow allowed \$50.00 for insurance on jail. Hyslop & Rowley allowed \$50.00 for same. W. H. Herbert allowed \$50.00 for same.
  - Montgomery, Jones & Co., allowed \$35.00 for mds. for paupers.
  - T. J. Alexander allowed \$4.75 for cleaning probate office.
  - J. W. Herren allowed \$4.50 for conveying paupers.
  - Hawkins & Craig allowed \$1.50 for lamp for recorder's office.
- Court adjourned to March 12th, 1883.

Dr. Theodore Blenkner - Conception  
Rev. Thomas Bennett, M. D. - located on section 31, Braddyville, Iowa P.O., born near London, England, April 1808. Also minister of Christian denomination. Was a ship's surgeon.  
Dr. Charles D. Black, son of a minister in Va. About 1870, because of failing health, practically abandoned practice of medicine. He became a resident of Mo., owning half a section of land in Nodaway Co., besides 200 acres in Iowa. He engaged in stock farming. Member of Christian Church, voted Republican.  
Dr. J. P. Barron, physician & surgeon, born Ky. 1844. Served in Second Ky. Regiment with Gen. Sherman on the "March to the Sea". Came to Mo. in 1871. Settled at Graham in 1878 and began the practice of medicine. He graduated from Keokuk (Iowa) Medical College. He was the father of three sons.  
Dr. W. E. Burtch, born Oxford Co. Canada 1842. In 1866 settled in Fillmore, Andrew Co. In 1881 settled in Maitland, Holt Co., practiced in Nodaway and Holt counties. Studied medicine in Woodstock, Canada.  
Dr. H. M. Carver - Guilford, 1866, later moved to Maryville & died there.  
Dr. S. Collins - Elmo.  
Dr. S. V. Campbell - Maryville.  
Dr. Josiah Coleman - Pickering. Married 3 times, father of 20 children. In 1874 moved to St. Joseph, was not a regular medical graduate.  
Dr. Spencer Collings - Elmo, born Shelby Co., Ky. 1828. In 1848 began to practice medicine in Mercer Co., Mo. In 1873 came to Nodaway Co. - Lamar Station. In 1880 located in Lincoln Township. Belonged to Church of God. Medical College, Keokuk, IA.  
Dr. J. M. Cadwallader - Gaynor City, born Va. 1851. He studied medicine at Magadore, Ohio and Cleveland Ohio Medical College. Practiced in Taylor Co., Ia. & in 1881 moved to Gaynor City, Mo.  
Dr. F. M. Davis - Quitman.  
Dr. G. A. Dawes - Hopkins.  
Dr. S. M. Dunn - Maryville, born Jasper Co., Ind. Graduated Rush Medical College, Chicago. In 1863 moved to Maryville. He was elected to the faculty of Northwestern Medical College in St. J.

Dr. Joseph Dunn - Maryville.

Regt., Vicksburg, Miss. Came to Maryville in 1868. Was a member of the First Methodist Episcopal Church.

Dr. Thomas C. Ellis, born Kentucky 1821. Came to Buchanan Co., Mo. 1843. Graduated from Eclectic Medical College of Cinn., Ohio, 1853. In 1855 came to White Cloud, Nodaway Co.
