



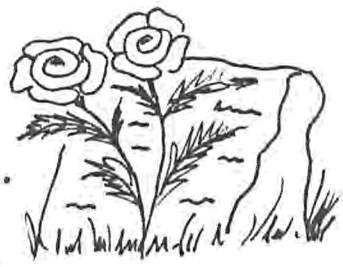

Memorial Day is always a good time to photograph cemetery stones or copy inscriptions, since the grass is usually well-trimmed. You might plan next year to ask a relative who lives near a distant cemetery, to take pictures or copy inscriptions for you. You might consider having old stones repaired or reset since most cemeteries don't have funds to take care of fallen or broken stones. Many times stones that were set at the death of a person have only the spouse's birth-date, since the death date was not added when the spouse died later. Tombstones are an important part of our genealogical heritage. It would be a gift to future generations if you could have the final date put on an ancestor's stone.
