Altenburg, Missouri. History of the Lutheran congregation at Altenburg. The Lutheran congregation of Altenburg, Perry County, Missouri, was founded by members of a colony of Saxon Lutherans, who emigrated in 1839 to Perry County, Missouri, in order to carry out certain church ideas of their leader, Martin Stephan. He was accompanied by a number of devout pastors and followers, who sincerely believed that they were following a divine call in leaving their old homes for conscience's sake. During these 75 years nine pastors have filled its pastorate, G. H. Loeber, G. A. Schiefer-decker, J. P. Beyer, J. F. Koestering, A. Grimm, P. Koesener, A. A. Schormann, H. Schmidt and Adolph Vogel. From the beginning the congregation has maintained and supported a parochial school. The following have served in the capacity as teachers, F. F. Winter, Tho. Zacharias, G. M. Beyer, J. Abraham, Werner Asche, Edward Mueller, Paul Mueller, B. Henmann and H. Fiehler. A college for higher education was opened in 1840, J. J. Goenner being its first director. This humble beginning, the college being a mere one-room log hut, which is today fairly well preserved, was the origin of the splendid array of seminaries and colleges now owned by the Missouri Synod. Divine services were first held in the parsonage built in 1839. In 1844 the first church building was erected. After the completion of the second church edifice, built in 1867, this first church building was converted into a school building, which is still in use. The first school building erected in 1841 was razed in 1887 and a more modern one put in its place. At present the congregation owns one church edifice, two school buildings, one parsonage and two residences for its teachers. Communicating members 650, voting members 138, pupils enrolled 118.

Friedenberg Evangelical Lutheran Church. The Evangelical Lutheran Congregation at Friesland, Mo., four miles east of Perryville is the mother congregation of those at Perryville, Longtown and Crosstown. It was founded 70 years ago. Only one of its original members is still living. This is Mr. Michael Ochs, who for many years was an elder and trustee of the congregation and who is one of the wisest known citizens of Perry County. Since 1844 eight pastors served the congregation. Of these Rev. Henry Gummier served for more than 26 years from 1886 to 1912. Since then Rev. J. W. Schoech is pastor of the congregation. The Lutheran congregation at Friesland owns a substantial brick church, built 29 years ago, a brick school, a teacher's dwelling and a parsonage. It has at present a membership of 170. The parochial school is attended by 45 pupils. The officers of the congregation are at present: Messrs. Martin Thieret, Adolf Ochs and Theo. Gammmer, elders and Messrs. Martin Meekes, Theo. Bergmann and Martin Bergmann, trustees. Services are regularly held both in the German and the English languages.

Frohna Evangelical Lutheran Congregation was founded by Saxon immigrants—about twelve families, who followed their pastor, the Rev. E. G. W. Keyl, and with him settled at Frohna because of religious opinions in their old home—in the year of our Lord 1839. From the very beginning its members were bent upon instructing the young as well as the old in Scripture truths and morals and therefore established a Christian day school as soon as there were children old enough to attend it. Both church and school have prospered ever since. The congregation numbers in the year 1914, 132 voting male members, 370 communicant members and 548 souls. The school has 80 pupils and two male teachers, Professors J. H. Weip and M. Waksch, the latter having been with the school 42 years and the former 32 years. The name of the present pastor is Rev. F. Wenger; lector August Luellers. Those of the elders: Claus Stueve, Theodore Kramer and Charles Luellers, of the trustees: Theodore Bachmann, Benjamin Mueller and Gottfried Bergt. Most of the church work is still conducted in the German language, but in the school the English language has been given equal attention with the German for over 30 years. It is a well established fact that the members of this congregation have been and are law abiding and helpful citizens of Perry County. The congregation owns a cemetery about one and a half acres in size and two plots of ground, one of four acres and the other of ten. On the four acre piece
