Wm. A. Robertson died at the home of his son, Edward, on Cedar Fork, November 30, 1903, at the age of 86 years, 8 months and 4 days. Deceased was born in South Carolina and moved with his parents when he was 8 years old to Alabama, where he grew up to manhood. About the year 1837-38 he started with his father-in-law and their families on an overland trip to the then far west to seek their fortunes.
