History And Location

SHOBE - JAMISON - QUISENBERRY - CEMETERY

Copied December 11, 1952 by Miss Mamie McCormick
and Mrs. Ira A. Leiter.

This cemetery is located in Prairie Township,
NW NW 12 45 22 on West 16 th Road about

1 3/4 miles West of Pittsburg Corning Factory
on the South side of the road , property owned

by John Talbot, Walnut Hills , R.R. # 3, Sedalia, Mo.
At an early day a Christian Church was built at

this site . As members moved about the Church building
was abandoned and now the cemetery has not

received any care for years . Land owners have
maintained a fence . It is possible that many of

the earliest graves are unmarked. the earliest death
date found on a stone was 1859. Charles Lewis

donated the land for the Church and the Cemetery.
While the neighborhood for the Cemetery has been
^{name}

SHOBE, the majority of the names found are from
the Quisenberry family. Jackson Quisenberry and

his family from Clark County, Kentucky , were
in the area before 1840. Mary A. Jamison ,

wife of Harrison Jamison , was a sister of
Abel Shobe. They came from Warren County, Kentucky.

Jackson Quisenberry's sister, Rhoda, married
Peter Courtney. Courtney names belong to that family.

This Cemetery is located in Blackwater Township
SE NW Section 5 Township 47 Range 23., about

1 3/4 miles East and 1/2 mile South of Dunksburg in
North West part of the Pettis County., on the North
side of the road. (1 1/2 miles West of State Highway
127). All weather Roads either route.

The Methodist Episcopal Church was organized from
a meeting at John Rice's home. The grounds are
well maintained and burials are still made. There
are a few death dates before 1860. Most burials
were after 1880.

Some of the families in the North West part of
the County came from North Carolina.

William Winston, son of Jesse Winston , came to
Pettis County before 1860. K

George Stephens and Enoch Stephens were both born
in Guilford County, North Carolina.

Several family names are descendants of the pioneers
living in the area as early as 1830 and 1840.

Bartlett Fisher , Rodney Fisher , William E. Curnutt,
John M. Forbes, Adam C. Scott David S. Ramey,
represent a few of these families names .

Church Services are held at the Church on the First
and Third Sundays , the Pastor is
Reverend Eugene Winkler, 1966.

History and Location

Union Cemetery is located in Heath's Creek Township, SE SE Section 11 Township 47 Range 20.

The site of Union Church is about 18 miles North East of Sedalia, Missouri, on all weather road.

An 1918 History of Pettis County, Missouri indicates at that time, the building was used by both the Baptist and the Methodist denominations.

The Cemetery may have been referred to as Creel's Cemetery. Most of the burials with markers have been since 1900.

One of the earliest burials was that of Rev. Ezra Landon, who was born July 5, 1790 and died January 11, 1869. The 1850 Pettis County, Missouri Census gives his birth place as New York.

Martha A. Crabtree, wife of J.H. Crabtree, was the daughter of John and Henrietta (Carrington) Weathers. Her first husband, father of her children, was James Taylor, who was killed during the Civil War. Daniel P. Weathers was her brother.

Barbara Ann Kabler was a descendant of Jesse Swope and his wife, Polly Hedrick, pioneer settlers in the North East part of Pettis County, Missouri.

History And Location

LAKE CREEK CEMETERY

This cemetery was copied by Mrs. James Bass ~~WILFRED 1944~~
and Mrs Paul T. Culp , October 7, 1961.
Lake Creek Cemetery is located about 8 miles South of Smithton, Missouri. The cemetery may be reached by driving South from Smithton on County Road W, going in a Southerly direction until passing over the Lake Creek Bridge (This is a gravel road) about 1/8 mile , to first wire gate on the right. The tombstones are visible from the road.

Though the location of the German Lake Creek Methodist Church has changed twice in the 123 years since it's beginning , and the Campmeeting location has been moved from the spot of the first church , to the present church site , the cemetery remains unrelenting ly in it's original surrounding.

The earliest marked grave in the cemetery is that of a man named Hermann B--om-n, who died March 25, 1862. This stone is soft, and the letters in German Script, which have been scraatched on the stone, are all but illegible.

Other names appearing in the cemetery giving much toward the establishment of the church were Kahrns, Ringen, Tinken, Cordes, Rages, Demand, Ratje, Hinken, Schlusing, and Hoehns.

The early German settlers in the sparsely settled area were served by a Missionary ,named Walkenhorst as early as 1839.

Apparently ,the Methodists and the Lutherans Worshiped together , some what irregularly,until 1843, when we find that Dr. Ludwig Jacoby of the St. Louis conference commissioned Sebastian Barth to ride the circuit.

This circuit was called "Osage Mission " and later "Versailles Mission ". The territory included , extended from Lexington to the mouth of the Osage River, ThenSouth to include seven counties.

On this circuit there were 15 appointments the first year, which necessitated traveling 300 miles to make the circuit, or about three weeks.

These appointments included Lexington, Concordia, Pilot Grove ,Boonville ,Jamestown, California, Jefferson City, and the homes of a Mr. Meyer, Kahrns, at Lake Creek, Gerhard Ringen, Conrad Ringen, a Mr. Grohken, Schlotzhauer.

History and Location

DRESDEN CEMETERY

in 1965.

Dresden Cemetery is located in Dresden Township,
in Section 22, Township 46, Range 22.

The cemetery is located about one quarter of a
mile South of Dresden on United States Highway
No.50, about 6 miles West of the City limits
of Sedalia, Missouri.

The town of Dresden was laid out in the Spring
of 1863. The earliest burial date in the cemetery,
which is listed, is that of James A. Powell, son of
David and Elizabeth Walker Powell.

Joseph G. Donohue and his wife, Ellen Anderson
were married in Pettis County, Missouri,
October 10, 1837. They were early members of the
Christian Church in Dresden, Pettis County, Missouri.

Osage Chapter, Daughters of American Revolution,
has a memorial bronze marker, for their
organizing Regent, Mary Tuttle McCluney,
(Mrs. Thompson P. McCluney) who is buried in
this cemetery. Mrs. McCluney was accepted as
a member in DAR June 3, 1897.
Her National DAR Number is 19900.

Clymene Tuttle was the daughter of Reverend
Joseph King Tuttle and his wife Sarah Ann Reynolds.
Clymene Tuttle was born May 17, 1839, Jacksonville,
Tompkins County, New York.
Her first marriage was to Captain William O. Smally
of New York. He died September 15, 1868.
After coming to Pettis County, she married
June 24, 1874, Dr. Thompson P. McCluney, a widower
with two daughters, Mary Laura McCluney and
Maud Eliza McCluney. Maud Eliza McCluney
married Ernest W. Dugan.

Mary Tuttle McCluney died October 26, 1929 in
Sacramento, California. The remains were cremated
and were interred in the burial plot in
Dresden Cemetery.
