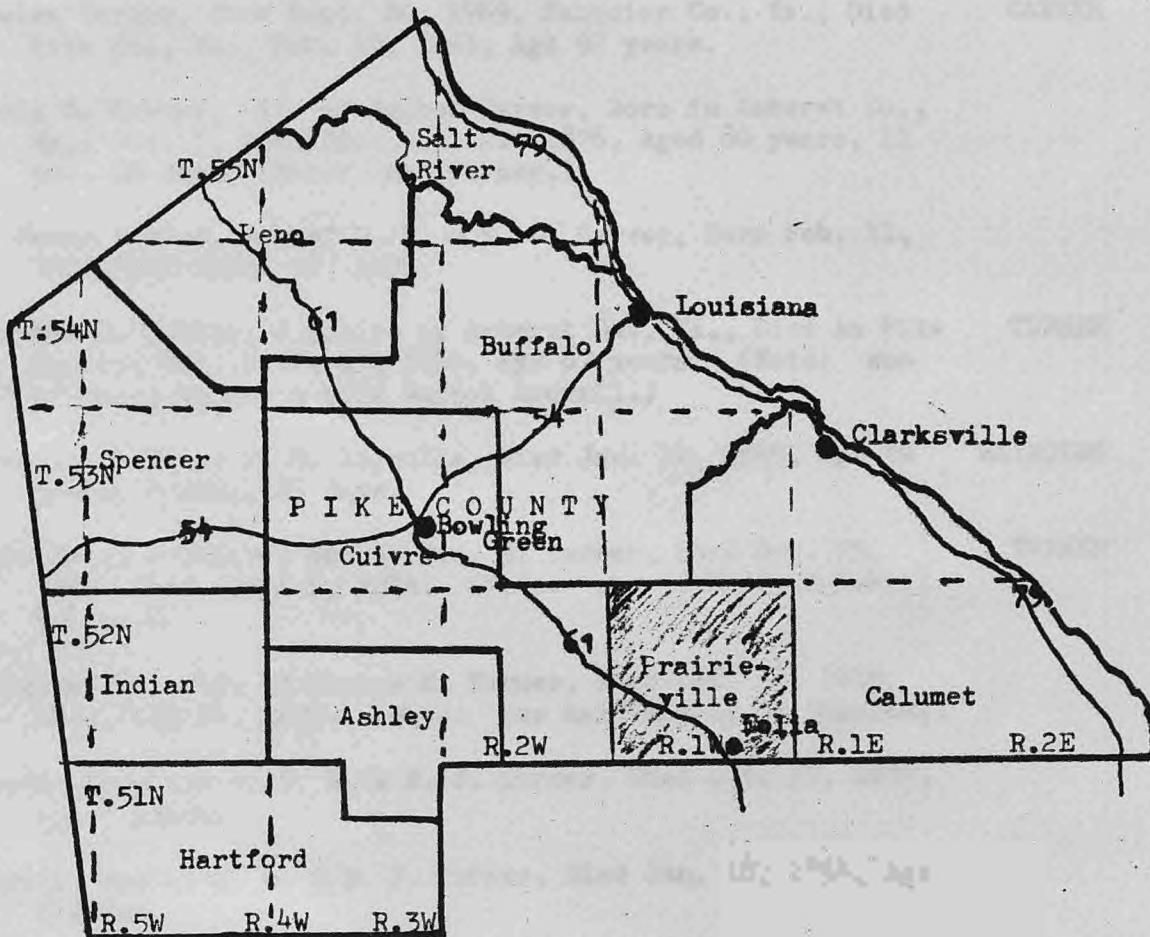

Mt. Ayre (Buffalo Knob) Cemetery

Buffalo-Knob Cemetery is next to what used to be known as Buffalo-Knob Church but is now known as Mount Ayre Church. The cemetery is located 3/10 of a mile off county road WW and the turnoff is located approximately 12.1 miles from Clarksville. To reach the cemetery from Clarksville, travel county road W until you come to the junction of county road WW where you turn right and follow WW for approximately 6.6 miles until you see a small sign for Mt. Ayre Church on a fence post on the righthand side of the road that points up a gravel road to the right. You go approximately 3/10 of a mile to the top of the hill where the church and cemetery are located on the left. About half of the graves in the cemetery are either marked with creek rocks or unmarked. The graves that are marked with tombstones are in bad shape. Several of the graves are marked by temporary metal and paper markers, mostly from the Gooch Funeral Home, and are unreadable. All rows read from the church back down the hill and the first row is the row nearest to the road. The inscriptions were copied in February 1972 by John M. and Sharleen M. Helenthal.
