This cemetery is located in Section 25 of Hartford Township, T.51N. R.3W., inside of a hog pen. All of the stones have been rooted over and buried. The inscriptions were copied in September of 1984 by Bill and Mollie Price.

James Grimmatt passed away Friday morning at the county farm being at the time of death 62 years of age. He had been ill for some time and death was not unexpected. He was the last surviving member of his immediate family. He was the son of Thomas & Mary Elizabeth Grimmatt. Burial was in the Old Grimmatt Cemetery north of Corso, Mo. Brief graveside services were held on Saturday.

Church of God Colored Cemetery
