OLD ALLEN MAY CELEBRATE ANNIVERSARY OF 100 YEARS BY GOING
INTO MOBERLY

MOBERLY, MO. (AP)--Old Allen may celebrate its 100th year by dissolving into Moberly.

The village was a forerunner and now is nearly surrounded by Moberly. A number of its citizens have signed a petition asking that it be disincorporated. They hope it will be the first step toward annexation by Moberly.

Their petition probably will come before the Randolph County Circuit Court on June 9. On June 11, Allen will officially be 100 years old.

When Moberly began to outgrow its city limits, Old Allen became a prosperous business area. Overcrowding in Moberly and increasing highway traffic brought more and more business to the village. Some of Moberly's largest businesses actually are in Old Allen.

The village originally was on a stage route between Hannibal and Glasgow and its beginnings go back to the 1840s. It was first platted in 1858.

Then in 1861 came the Chariton and Randolph County Railroad Co., a forerunner of the present day Wabash. It had a line from St. Louis to Iowa and unveiled plans to extend another west to Kansas City. The junction would be Moberly, a new town hard by Allen.

The railroad offered Allen's residents equal land in its new town. It offered to move houses and out-buildings.

Of Allen's 200 or so residents in 1860, only Patrick Lynch accepted. The Civil War put a spike in the railroad's elaborate plans and stopped the exodus from Allen.

The village was supposed to have been the rendezvous of guerillas and organized bands of Confederate Soldiers during the war. There was, indeed, one skirmish between Union troops and Bill Anderson's guerilla band. Jesse and Frank James were supposed to be with Anderson.

After the war, the railroad renewed its offer and many residents of Allen moved to Moberly. Moberly grew as the railroad expanded. Soon it was at Allen's edge and Allen was now Old Allen.

Old Allen operates on a \$1 yearly assessment on each business within its corporate limits, plus an annual payment of \$100 from the Missouri Power and Light Co. for franchise rights.

It buys water from Moberly and distributes it through a piping system installed several years ago. The State Highway Department maintains the main street, U. S. 63.

Old Allen is only 3,650 feet long by 1,750 feet wide and by the best available check has only 62 residents of voting age. Owners of most of its property live in Moberly.

It has a town board of five, at least three of whom have signed the petition to dissolve. A spokesman for the petition campaign says 50 of the 62 eligible voters have signed.

Old Allen has no fire protection of its own. Moberly has a good neighbor policy and fights the fires but insurance rates are high. There is no police protection except by courtesy of the Highway Patrol and the sheriff's office. The six-inch water main doesn't provide adequate pressure. Private septic tanks, the only sewage disposal, don't work too well.

These are the factors which brought about dissatisfaction and dulled the determination to maintain a separate identity. Moberly invited Old Allen to dissolve itself and be annexed.

The situation leaves the villagers in the unusual position of deserting a system where taxes nearly are non-existent to join a city which is paying off three issues.

MICBERLY, MO.--A RAILROAD TOWN BACKED BY LIVESTOCK, FARMING
ALSO HOME OF WORLD CHAMPION SADDLE MARE
CITY MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT IN OPERATION

MOBERLY, MO., June 28.--On a warm summer's day of 1861, Patrick Lynch, an Irishman living in the little northern Missouri town of Allen, spit on his hands, bent his broad back and with several neighbors helping, jacked his one-story frame house onto crude rollers fashioned from the wheels of an ox-cart.

It was moving day for the Lynches. They and other residents of Allen had been invited by the Chariton and Randolph County Railroad to change their residence one mile to the south where the city of Moberly now stands. The railroad wanted a settlement convenient to its proposed route. It offered each citizen of Allen as much land in the new community as he owned in the old.

The Lynches were the only ones to accept. And after Patrick Lynch cracked his rawhide whip and drove to the new town-site the 20 yoke of oxen hauling his home, he discovered that he and his family were its first and only citizens. As a civil war was getting under way and people of the United States were concerned with other matters than moving, the Lynches dwelt for five long years in neighborless seclusion on the lonely prairie site that was to become Moberly.

Railroad Changed Hands

In the meantime the Chariton and Randolph County Railroad was taken over by the North Missouri Railroad Company, predecessor of the present-day Wabash, and in 1866, after the North and South had settled their difficulties, the North Missouri Railroad carried out the plans for a lot sale in the new settlement.

Highlight of the occasion was the deeding to Patrick Lynch by Col. Isaac M. Sturgeon, president and general manager of the railroad, of two lots because he "had held the city during the war without the loss of a life or house." The new town was named Moberly after the first president of the Chariton and Randolph Railroad Company, Col. William E. Moberly.

Its site hand-picked by a pioneer road which invited in citizens to people it, Moberly has lived up to its railroad tradition. The Wabash, which maintains a division point and shops here, perhaps represents the largest single local industry. Its 1946 Moberly pay-roll figure, according to the local Chamber of Commerce, topped the \$3,000,000 mark. Nearly 1,000 men are on the pay roll.

The trim blue and white Wabash Diesel locomotives glide swiftly on their way between the state's two principal cities, St. Louis and Kansas City, with Moberly an approximate half-way point.

Another large railroad, the Katy, also serves Moberly with a branch line running between here and New Franklin,

and connecting with the main line at New Franklin. The Brown Shoe Company, employing some 850 workers locally, has a three-story brick plant in the south part of town.

Coal mining, livestock and farming are other principal local industries. There are 11 deep-shaft coal mines and a large strip mine in the vicinity of Moberly, with the strip mine working approximately 100 men. This is one of the state's principal coal belts.

Both milk cows, such as Holsteins, Guernseys and Jerseys, and meat cattle, the white-faced Herefords and the stocky Angus breed, help make up the local livestock population. Moberly goes all out for the American Royal Livestock Show held each fall in Kansas City. It is the home of the reigning queen of the show, black-haired, blue-eyed Connie Daniels, who won the honor last year from a field that included 33 contestants from eight states.

World Champion Mare

This town is also the home of Easter Serenade, the world champion five-gaited saddle mare. Owned by Temple Stevens, the grocery chain magnate, the 9-year-old golden chestnut mare was retired in a ceremony which was one of the features of the show last fall. Easter Serenade is now in the barns of Temple Wood, the Stevens home on South Williams street. Present plans are for the golden chestnut to be kept in pasture for a year and then be bred. Stevens is a nationally known horse show judge and travels about the

country indulging his avocation.

Moberly also is the home of another horse show judge of national renown. He is Charles W. Green, former secretary of the Missouri State Fair and past president of the International Fair Association. He is regarded by many as the country's No. 1 judge of fine horse flesh. Green is an annual fixture at the American Royal, having acted either as a judge or promoter of the horse show for more than two decades.

In September of 1944 the citizens of Moberly voted to adopt the city manager form of government. The city was considered a guinea pig for the operation of that form of government in smaller cities of the state.

City Manager Plan

On Jan. 1, 1945, Dean Van Ness was hired as city manager at an annual salary of \$7500. He came here from Atchison, Kan., where he had had five years' experience in his specialized field.

Under the city manager form of government the voters elected five Councilmen and the Councilmen then chose a Mayor from amongst their ranks and hired a city manager. Dr. F. L. McCormick is the present Mayor.

"This form of government," explains J. C. Patterson, secretary-manager of the local Chamber of Commerce, "is based upon the principle that the execution of public work is a business proposition and as such it should be taken out

of the reach of political controversy.

"It provides the means for long-range city planning over a term of years, which is necessary for orderly growth and development. Because of the business basis on which it functions it attracts the ablest business executives of the community to serve as councilmen. The City Manager plan means three things: Simplicity, efficiency and democracy in city government.

"It is objectively considered to be the most efficient, yet democratic style of government found applicable to the modern American community."

Home of 'State Mother'

A gray-haired, pleasant-faced woman of 80, Mrs. F. M. Stamper, who resides at Urbandale, a mile south of here, was chosen the Missouri Mother of 1947.

Moberly, whose 1940 census figure was listed at 12,290, has no less than three hospitals. They are the McCormick Hospital, the Woodland and the Wabash Hospital. The estimated city directory count gave the local population in 1944 as 14,257 while up-to-date estimates place it as 15,000.

The pioneer railroad men who selected the site for Moberly had an eye for beauty. The local citizenry has them to thank for the summer resort facilities here which are the envy of surrounding cities. The city has not one, but three, picturesque, fish-filled, easily accessible lakes.

The largest is Sugar Creek Lake, some five miles northwest of town, which has a 265-acre area. The Rothwell Park Lake is located in the park, where a herd of tame deer also is an attraction. The lake has a lighted beach and a gray stucco bathhouse. Waterworks Lake completes the trio.

One of the most popular forms of recreation here involves the pleasant sport of separating from the cool, blue depths of the water the schools of crappie, bass, bluegill and goggle-eye that abound there. The store windows on Reed street, the city's main thoroughfare, which feature intriguing spinners, bobbers, flies, fly rods and other fishing tackle, are a good index to the trend of thought of Moberly folk these warm, summer days.

Ardent Fisherman

An ardent local fisherman is F. W. (Ike) Smith. Ike operates the Merchants' Hotel here. He was graduated from Missouri University School of Engineering in 1923 and served in Army Intelligence in World War II with the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. He spends many of his recreation hours in a cottage on the banks of Sugar Creek Lake or on the blue waters of the lake.

Ike is an ardent protagonist of life in the smaller cities. "I operated hotels in Kansas City for a while," he declared. "But you can't beat our setup here. All the advantages of country life, and the state's two big cities are only a matter of a couple of hours distant by automobile."

There is a tone of longing in Ike's voice as he recalls the Randolph County coon hunts that used to be held here. "They'd last for two or three days," he relates. "One of the local dentists put a gold crown on a tooth of a coon captured beforehand, and the animal would be released. The hunter who captured the 'gold toothed' coon received a special prize.

"The hunts marked the beginning of a number of Missouri political careers. Politics was a favorite topic of discussion. Among those who attended was the late Jim Reed, former United States Senator from Missouri. The boys," says Ike wistfully, "were talking only the other day about reviving the old hunt."

Soldier From Moberly

Moberly was the home of another soldier of World War II. He was a baseball and track star on the Moberly High School teams. He married a Moberly girl, his high-school classmate, pretty, slender Mary Elizabeth Quayle, daughter of his Sunday school teacher. He is a soldiering man by the name of Omar Bradley, a four-star general, that is, who as the senior commander of the Twelfth Army Group in the European Theater, made one of the most remarkable records of World War II.

When Omar Bradley returned to Moberly following the close of the war the citizenry turned out for a local demonstration that will long be remembered. They named the

airport here, a \$400,000 project, after their soldier hero.

Missouri, it was recalled locally, has made a practice of furnishing outstanding military men for the country's wars. Only 55 miles from the farm, west of Clark, Mo., where Gen. Bradley was born, is the home of another Missouri soldier, Gen. John J. Pershing, of World War I fame. Then Gen. Ulysses S. Grant, who sold cord wood in St. Louis, did his part in the Civil War, as did Col. Alexander Doniphan in the Mexican war, when he led the Army of the West.

Missouri Writer

In a pleasant, tree-shaded house at 710 Benson street the writer encountered Mrs. John J. Gasparotti. She was picking up the local paper, the Moberly Monitor-Index, from the front porch. Mrs. Gasparotti is the former Elizabeth Seifert and the winner in 1938 of the Dodd-Mead Red Book prize of \$10,000 for her novel, "Young Dr. Galahad."

She is one of the three writing Seifert sisters, two of whom, Shirley and Adele, live in the St. Louis vicinity. Her latest literary venture, "Take Three Doctors." Mrs. Gasparotti revealed, is scheduled for fall release.

"One bit of Moberly matter you may have missed," Mrs. Gasparotti told us, "is the fact that this city owns the only statue of Lincoln in the State of Missouri. I know, because last year I was asked to get information about this. And was that an experience!"

"Not one out of 10 persons here knew there was a statue.

Many of the Southern contingent denied hotly that such a thing could be here in "Little Dixie."

"But it's here all right, in the Oakland Cemetery,
erected by the G. A. R. and its auxiliary."

MISSOURI NOTES

Lincoln in Little Dixie: The birthday anniversary of the great Abraham Lincoln is being observed again, a reminder to this column that the only out-door life-size statue of the Great Emancipator in Missouri is located in the city cemetery at Moberly, largest town in Randolph County. Lincoln received only a few votes in the Little Dixie area and none in Randolph County.

The Lincoln statue was erected and dedicated at Moberly in 1915 with appropriate ceremonies, financed by funds obtained in public subscriptions.

February 12 also is the birthday anniversary of Randolph County's most illustrious native son, General Omar N. Bradley, who was born on Lincoln's birthday anniversary in 1893. Both he and Mrs. Bradley are graduates of the Moberly high school, class of 1910.

THE SKINNERS DEVELOP AS A ROYAL FAMILY

From beginnings at Moberly, Mo., when that town was a pioneer railroad center and her maternal grandfather was station master, chief dispatcher, telegraph superintendent, and Moberly's first Mayor, Cornelia Otis Skinner follows through romance, pathos, comedy and adventure the development of a "Royal Family" in the American theater, herself the second of its dynastic stars.

Here are intimate pictures of the backstage world from the '90s to the new; presented with that discriminating comic sense in swift sure characterization which has made Miss Skinner so great a star whether in mono-drama recital or in the comedy of her time. Echoes of that skill which enabled her father, Otis Skinner, to create by gesture the perfect vulgarian while never for an instant being vulgar in himself. And of that which gave validity to the riotous fun when Miss Skinner collaborated with Emily Kimbrough in "Our Hearts Were Young and Gay."

But ther is also a discriminated pathos--near in sentiment to humor but never sentimental--as when she tells of the struggles of the Durbin family, of her mother's ambition, and how Modjeska gave Maud Durbin a hearing and a job which brought her into contact with Otis Skinner, the leading man for that great Polish actress. The portrait of that

mother in pursuit of culture is a masterpiece of character-gesture.

Rollicking humor, pointed wit, and gay and intimate gossip are in the volume. Only Miss Skinner's father and George Arliss have written so delightfully of the theatrical life of our time. A hundred anecdotes are crying for inclusion here. There isn't room, and what is more, Miss Skinner tells them better than this admirer ever could.

"MISSOURI WALTZ" LINK

Dick Hannah Popularized Song Years Ago.

Long Before State Adopted Song, Negro Pianist Was Playing
It At Moberly, Mo.

Moberly, Mo., Feb. 13.--Funeral services were held today in St. Louis for Walter (Dab) Hannah, 75, a Negro pianist who was credited with helping to popularize "The Missouri Waltz," now the official state song.

Three generations of Moberlyans danced to the music of Dab, for years one of the most popular pianists in Central Missouri. He died in St. Louis.

Made Waltz a Favorite

Music followers here credited Hannah with popularizing the Missouri Waltz in this area after the late Edgar Settle of New Franklin and Moberly brought it from the Southland.

The tune supposedly acquired its name through frequent requests for "that Missouri waltz." At one time many Missouri dancers credited Dab with authorship of the waltz since he played it so frequently.

Hannah, a Moberly native, had lived in St. Louis for sixteen years. He played frequently in St. Louis and East St. Louis night clubs and returned to Moberly occasionally to entertain old friends.

An Ovation in 1952

Dab came home in 1952 for a Democratic rally and re-

ceived an enthusiastic ovation as he played aboard a truck in the parade. Fans marveled at his dexterity, though Dab's fingers had lost some of their old time nimbleness.

He is survived by two sons, Willie Hannah of St. Louis and Harold Hannah, of Corpus Christi, Tex., veteran of seventeen years of navy service.

MOBERLY PRISON IS MODEL FOR OTHERS

MOBERLY, MO.--Missouri's new medium security prison south of Moberly is working so well it is becoming a model for other states.

The medium security institution is unique and still in the growth stage.

It opened in January, 1963, but its real beginnings were in the flaming prison riots at the main penitentiary in Jefferson City almost 10 years ago in the fall of 1954.

From those ashes came the idea for a new institution aimed at getting prisoners ready to return to society.

"This institution was projected back in 1955", says Col. James D. Carter, state corrections director. "It has been the work of a lot of people, not any one man.

"We developed the program before we built the buildings. The buildings were built around the program.

"Now we're beginning to get a few results. Things are beginning to jell".

Right now the institution has about 500 men. Its capacity with the present two housing units is about 700. Carter says the 1965 Legislature will be asked to authorize the construction of two more housing units to bring the capacity up to the planned 1,4000.

Each unit costs about \$1.25 million to build. Each has a central control area with four wings radiating outward. Each wing has rooms for 79 men and each man has his

own room key.

It's a long step forward from the crowded cell blocks at the main penitentiary but there's nothing plush about it. The rooms are tiny. Each has a bed, a chair and a table top desk. Clothes and personal belongings are stored in a compartment under the desk top.

Each man has his own radio headset and there is a television set in each of the four wings--used only at night. It's time to get up at 5:30 a.m. and lights are out at 10 p.m.

After breakfast, every man has a job, in the shops or elsewhere. Currently 89 attend elementary school classes during the day and 74 attend high school classes at night.

In the last six months, 46 were graduated from grade school.

In fact, the 310-acre tract on the flatland of Randolph County resembles a campus more than a prison. Eighty acres are enclosed by a high wire fence, but inside that area the men are allowed to move to their jobs, to the recreational areas or elsewhere on their own, unaccompanied by guards.

There is only one observation post, high atop the power plant, and few guards are in evidence. The guard ratio is one to 15 men, compared with one to nine at the penitentiary.

Yet escapes are at a minimum. In a 12-month period there was only one--last October. And parole violations have run only eight out of 100--a record which Supt. Edward

E. Haynes views with pride.

For each month with no escapes, every man get two extra days of "good time" on his sentence. If a whole year goes by without an escape, each man gets 12 days extra of good time.

Getting men ready for their return to "the outside" is the main goal of the institution, as Haynes sees it.

To that end, vocational training has been emphasized from the start and more of it is planned for the future.

The shops include a modern laundry with a capacity of 100,000 pounds a week. The medium security laundry now handles about 60,000 pounds a week for the University of Missouri, including the medical center there.

In the same building a separate area is being remodeled and wired to accomodate the print shop to be moved from the pententiary soon.

Another shop trains auto mechanics and one of their pieces of equipment is an engine donated by the Ford Motor Co.

A modern mechanical shop includes \$350,000 worth of government surplus machinery, including lathes, drills, presses and other production equipment.

A metal assembly plant is being moved from the penitentiary, although license tag production will remain in Jefferson City.

There is a woodworking shop and other maintenance shops and the power plant generating electricity with Missouri coal.
