The Sappington Neighborhood

The first attempt to settle this locality of Arrow Rock Township was by William McMahan in 1811. He had to return to Cooper's Fort for protection and later settled in the Big Bottom in 1816.

In 1810, Samuel McMahan and others located 6 miles south of Arrow Rock and built a strong block house or fort called Fort Anderson. The fort took the name from three families, Wm., Ambrose, and George Anderson. (Mr. McMahan's nearest neighbors)

Other settlers were David Jones, James Wolfskill, Stephen Turley and William Reid. These were driven back to Cooper's Fort during the War of 1812, and Fort Anderson was burned.

In 1819, Alexander Gilbraith, Asa Finley, Sanders Townsend, Richard Marshall, Rev. Peyton Nowlin, Dr. John Sappington, Andrew Brownlee, Joseph Robinson, John Bingham, Nathan Holloway, Bradford Lawless, Burton Lawless, _____ Reese, Judge Beverly Tucker, and M. M. Marmaduke (Later Governor of Missouri) settled here.

Arrow Rock, in 1820, was nothing more than a crossing place on the Missouri River. A ferry had been run at times by Jerry Lecky, and Frederick Hartgrove. In 1820, a Capt. Becknell set up a regular ferry. He lived in a log cabin on the river bank. This was called the ferry house.

Antioch Church was organized about the year 1851. The first members were J. Fulkerson, Thomas Miller, J. K. Farris, John Smith, Samuel Scott, John Dickerson, Zinc Maupin, and L. B. Williams. The frame church cost \$1200. and was built in 1866. It was dedicated by Rev. Birchfield, the Rev. Thompson preaching the dedicatory sermon. Grand Pass

History of Saline County, Mo., 1881-pages 431-433

The Grand Pass which gives its name the lakes near by and to the township and to the church at the Pass, is a narrow pass of high bluff land from one hundred to five hundred yards wide, between the waters of Salt Fork, on one side, and the lakes in the river bottoms on the other. In the early settlement of country the great thorough fare of emigration and traders to Santa Fe, ran through the Pass, and the name of Grand Pass was given to it by them.

In the early trading times, 1835, a hotel was built and kept on the pass by the Early Brothers, John and William, who were cousins to the Rev. John Early, a noted Methodist Bishop of Kentucky.

The first post office was kept at the home of Capt. John DeFloss, by himself. The east mail came once a week from Old Jefferson, now New Frankfort, and the west mail from Dover. In some of the mounds near the Pass have been found human skulls and other bones, and polished stone axes, and other instruments.

At the organization in 1832, of the Grand Pass Chapel, certainly the oldest Methodist Church in the county, there were present William De Moss, John De Moss, Mrs. Joe McReynolds, Mrs. Margaret Lewis and daughter; Mrs. L. S. Major, Mrs. Harriet Lewis, the wife of Gen. G. W. Lewis, and the

Rev. R. H. Lee, minister.

This house of worship, that was then built still stands, and has been continuously a place of worship for half a century.

This Methodist Church is still standing today, June 29, 1959. It has been remodeled twice on the inside. It stands as a Historical Marker beside the State Highway #65 in the little village of Grand Pass, Missouri. The cemetery is behind the church.
