Van Meter

Located just on pinnacle west from original brick house in Van Meter State Park. (Original house just a short distance west and a little north from caretaker's house was located in Uncle Abel's garden spot, just behind the old frame house.)

Family came to Missouri in 1834 and first graves were of David A. Prosser (1845), Rebecca J. Prosser (1855), and John W. Prosser; children of Rebecca Van Meter Prosser and J. D. Prosser. (Rebecca was a daughter of Abraham and Elizabeth (Parsons) Van Meter, and a sister of my grandfather's.)

My grandmother originally had an iron fence around the graves of her husband, David Parsons Van Meter, and their eldest son, George A. Van Meter, who died when one year old in 1877. Around the entire cemetery plot was a high iron-fence, which Aunt Annie Van Meter (Uncle Abel's second wife) had taken down, and in September 11, 1925, she had a concrete wall placed around the burial spot.

There are fifteen graves in the cemetery, lying seven on each side as you walk over the stile entrance.

Ann Sales was a Negro retainer of Elizabeth Parsons Van Meter.

Outside of the cemetery wall is a grave of a man who was probably a worker on the farm.
